the deceiver knows the hungarian the wise man keeps twenty six ghosts in his library and the widow carries the words of the dead this is the final cryptic entry scrawled in the journal belonging to the late john chapel a journal that detailed his obsession with finding a woman who didn t exist hers was just one of several faces that he insisted he saw there in the rain and one of the many voices that called to him every night drawing him further into madness despite his wife s unwavering faith and tireless determination she could only watch helplessly as the man she loved slowly faded away like a fingerprint on a window being washed away by the rain now months after his death new information has surfaced that sheds new light on her husband s bizarre case and renews gwenn chapel s search for the truth her only allies in this crusade are her husband s old mentor and eccentric history professor dr campbell and his former best friend and her old flame jeremy connelly as she uncovers her husband s dark past however she begins to question their motivations behind helping her and suspects that one of them is hiding a dark secret of his own can she trust either of them to help her discover the truth or will it only be found in the cryptic pages of that journal john left behind only gwenn chapel can decide where the truth lies as she embarks on a journey that will challenge her faith the limits of her sanity and even her love for her husband will she be able to put all of those pieces together that her husband left for her to unlock the mystery behind the girl in the rain or be pushed over the edge and dragged down into that abyss with him this is the first in the epic forgotten series which is a gigantically proportioned tale about the three kinds of love we seek out in our lifetimes the depths of loss suffering friendship and faith told through the eyes of a widow a history professor and the cryptic words of a long dead crusader so take your seat beside dr campbell s fire have a glass of

through the arc of the rain forest is a burlesque of comic strip adventures and apocalyptic portents that stretches familiar truths to their logical extreme in a future world that is just recognizable enough to be frightening in the author s note karen tei yamashita writes that her book is like a brazilian soap opera called a novela the novela's story is completely changeable according to the whims of the public psyche and approval although most likely the unhappy find happiness the bad are punished true love reigns a popular actor is saved from death an idyll striking innocence boundless nostalgia and terrible ruthlessness the stage is a vast mysterious field of impenetrable plastic in the brazilian rain forest set against a backdrop of rampant environmental destruction commercialization poverty and religious rapture through the arc of the rainforest is narrated by a small satellite hovering permanently around the head of an innocent character named kazumasa through no fault of his own kazumasa seems to draw strange and significant people into his orbit and to find himself at the center of cataclysmic events that involve carrier pigeons religious pilgrims industrial espionage magic feathers big money miracles epidemics true love and the virtual end of the world this book is simultaneously entertaining and depressing with all the rollicking pessimism you d expect of a good soap opera or a good political satire kirsten backstrom 500 great books by women

preparing for the rain on iwo jima isle follows the life and military service of marion frank walker who was born and raised in a peaceful small town in southern indiana during the depression years frank was just 16 years old when america received that now legendary wake up call on december 7th 1941 as planes from japanese aircraft carriers bombed and torpedoed the u s naval fleet stationed at pearl harbor in hawaii in frank s words the world as we knew it changed overnight thus began the u s military involvement in world war ii eager to serve his country frank managed to graduate from high school mid term of his senior year and at 17 years old became a proud member of the u s marine corps the desire to serve and protect his beloved country would soon send him to the bloody battlefield of iwo jima at 19 years old he crawled through the volcanic ash that had turned purple from the blood of his fallen comrades and saw gruesome sights that no person should ever have to witness frank is in the posed picture of the flag raising at iwo jima as photographed by joe rosenthal he went on from there to become a part of the occupation force at fukuoka japan after reading of his experiences during this deeply troubling time in history frank and his surviving comrades only ask that the people of america remember the sacrifices that have been made for their freedom and that their fallen comrades be remembered
