Ten-year-old Arturo Velázquez was born and raised in a farm labor camp in Soledad, California. He was bright and gregarious, but he didn't speak English when he started first grade. When he entered third grade in 1968, the psychologist at Soledad Elementary School gave him an English language IQ test. Based on the results, he was placed in a class for the educable mentally retarded. Arturo wasn't the only Spanish-speaking child in the room; all but one were from farmworker families. All were devastated by the stigma and lack of opportunity to learn. In 1969, attorneys at California Rural Legal Assistance (CRLA) discovered that California public schools were misusing English language culturally biased IQ tests by asking questions like "Who wrote Romeo and Juliet?" to place Spanish-speaking students into EMR classes. Additionally, Mexican American children were not the only minorities impacted. While African American and Mexican American students made up 21.5% of the state population,

they were 48 of special education programs written by two of the attorneys who led the charge against the unjust denial of an education to mexican american youth the soledad children the fight to end discriminatory iq tests recounts the history of both the crla and the class action suit filed in 1970 diana v the state board of education on behalf of 13 000 hispanic kids already placed in emr classes and another 100 000 at risk of being relegated to a virtual purgatory from securing removal from emr classes for the misplaced to ensuring revised appropriate testing for students throughout the state this engrossing book recounts the historic struggle by lawyers parents psychologists and legislators to guarantee all affected young people in california received equitable access to education

upon the thought of 20th century german émigré political scientist eric voegelin the book argues that we cannot understand the globalized world in which we live unless we appreciate the lasting influence of the various end of history speculators specifically g w f hegel alexandre kojève and francis fukuyama through a voegelinian lens he dissects the relationship between these three thinkers also claiming that while voegelin may have misunderstood hegel his critiques of the hegelian approach to history offer fresh and important perspectives on the contemporary world this makes a forceful argument that the idea of history as a teleological path leading toward some goal whether perfect harmony between nations a technocratic utopia a return to some romanticized idyllic state of nature or what kojève and fukuyama called the universal and homogenous state has vast and perverse implications for the trajectory of american foreign and domestic policy

a vivid and unforgettable word picture of the destruction of nazi germany the new york times a radio broadcaster and journalist for edward r murrow at cbs william l shirer was new to the world of broadcast journalism when he began keeping a diary while on assignment in europe during the 1930s it was in 1940 when he was still virtually unknown that shirer wondered whether his eyewitness account of the collapse of the world around nazi germany could be of any interest or value as a book shirer's berlin diary which is considered the first full record of what was happening in germany during the rise of the third reich appeared in 1941 the book was an instant success and would not be the last of his expert observations on europe shirer returned to the european front in 1944 to cover the end of the war as the smoke cleared shirer who watched the birth of a monster that threatened to engulf the world now stood witness to the death of the third reich end of a berlin diary chronicles this year long study of germany after hitler through a combination of shirer's lucid honest reporting along with passages on the nuremberg trials copies of captured nazi documents and an eyewitness account of hitler's last days shirer provides insight into the unrest the weariness and the tentative steps world leaders took towards peace
