does the withdrawal of armies from direct rule in most countries herald an end to their role as actors in domestic politics has political intervention by the military been superseded this comparative examination of the politicized armed forces looks at the consequences of military rule for nation building and economic development the effects of the passing of the cold war and the rise of globalization on the political role of the military the role of political armies in the consolidation of civil politics and democratic governance the lessons for policy makers in global governance and post conflict reconstruction the contributors build on successive theories about the role of the military in politics and look to the future the most threatening scenario may be a proliferation of armed actors and the rise of privatized forces of law and order

the genre of political memoir has a long history from its origins in classical times through its popularity in the age of courts and cabinets to its ubiquity in modern mass cultures where retired politicians increasingly attract large and eager readerships for their revelations yet there is virtually no scholarly criticism which treats this complex form of literature as a distinct genre fusing autobiographical historical and political elements the essays in this book draw together the collaborative findings of a team of british european american and canadian scholars to present a pioneering historical and critical study of the genre of political memoir analysing the development of its distinct functions and assessing leading memoirists in european american canadian indian and japanese societies the editor george egerton introduces the volume and surveys the principal features of the genre over its long history otto pflanze analyses the memoirs of bismarck robert young milton israel joshua mostow and robert bothwell study the memoir literature of france india japan and canada respectively barry gough and tim travers look at naval and military memoirists while zara steiner b j c mckercher and valerie cromwell assess the memoirs of diplomats and their families leonidas hill examines the memoirs of leading nazis john munro francis heller and robert ferrell convey inside information on the making of memoirs notably by the canadian prime ministers diefenbaker and pearson and the american president truman stephen ambrose assays nixon as memoirist while janos bak portrays the status of memoirists under totalitarian regimes wesley wark and john naylor analyse theproliferation of intelligence memoirs and government efforts to protect official secrets from the revelations of the candid memoirist the principal findings reached by the contributors in their study of this problematic but influential genre are set out by the editor in the concluding chapter

what determines the size and form of redistributive programs the extent and type of public goods provision the burden of taxation across alternative tax bases the size of government deficits and the stance of monetary policy during the course of business and electoral cycles a large and rapidly growing literature in political economics attempts to answer these questions but so far there is little consensus on the answers and disagreement on the appropriate mode of analysis combining the best of three separate traditions the theory of macroeconomic policy public choice and rational choice in political science torsten persson and guido tabellini suggest a unified approach to the field as in modern macroeconomics individual citizens behave rationally their preferences over economic outcomes inducing preferences over policy as in public choice the delegation of policy decisions to elected representatives may give rise to agency problems between voters and politicians and as in rational choice political institutions shape the procedures for setting policy and electing politicians the authors outline a common method of

analysis establish several new results and identify the main outstanding problems

this title was first published in 2003 this work provides a clearer understanding of the eu s approach towards security in the mediterranean after examining the eu s interests and the potential threats to security in the region it analyzes eu security policy towards the region as a whole through the euro mediterranean partnership and towards all disputes and conflicts in the area it recommends opening up the european security and defence policy to mediterranean participation in order to establish a deep and equitable security partnership between both shores the book argues that this way the eu could implement its innovative comprehensive and co operative approach to security rather than focusing on the military aspect alone this approach takes into account all dimensions of security political socio economic cultural and ecological and is based on partnership rather than confrontation it therefore contrasts quite sharply with the policies advocated in the us national security strategy

the euro mediterranean partnership was formed in 1995 in barcelona in this volume concepts of democracy civil society human rights and dialogue among civilizations in the mediterranean region are addressed in the context of the new euro mediterranean partnership

the rapid evolution of events in the european middle eastern and north african spheres has reinvigorated the debate on euro mediterranean relations since 1995 these relations have operated under the auspices of the barcelona process which laid the foundations for three initiatives that define european policy towards neighbouring states the euro mediterranean partnership the european neighbourhood policy and the union for the mediterranean this book scrutinises these initiatives through a socioeconomic prism adam yousef reviews how appropriate these initiatives have been in promoting socioeconomic development in north african states projects the long term implications of these policies and investigates whether they can reduce the gap in social outcomes across the mediterranean basin over time

using morocco as a case study this book employs a mixed methods approach combining qualitative and quantitative data as well as economic theory it reveals not only that the barcelona process has had a limited impact on promoting social outcomes in morocco but crucially that it is also unlikely to do so in the future suggesting a new approach may be required

this book purports to examine the international dimensions of the democratization process in egypt in the post cold war era a theme which acquired significance at the academic and policy oriented levels in light of the growing internationalization of reform arrangements in the arab world in post 9 11 and the greater involvement of external powers in arab politics following the arab spring uprisings during the second half of the twentieth century the mainstream scholarship presented the democratization process as the outcome of domestic conditions not significantly influenced by actors outside the nation state with the end of the cold war this perspective was challenged as a result of the third wave of democratization and the subsequent growth of the good governance discourse on the agenda of the international development establishment the new perspective attached a more significant role to external factors in the democratization process than was originally conceptualized

this book examines the interplay between the national and the european levels in eu foreign policymaking focusing on the middle east european engagement in peacemaking in the middle east dates back to foreign policy cooperation in the early 1970s following the launch of the peace process in 1991 the eu and its member states further stepped up their involvement in conflict resolution focusing on one central area of eu engagement the israeli palestinian conflict this book covers the period from the beginning of the peace process in 1991 until 2008 and focuses on the actions of the big three member states germany france and the uk using the europeanization concept as framework of analysis the book examines the problematic dynamics between these member states national foreign policy models and the construction of a common european conflict resolution policy it also provides interesting new insights into the eu s international role and potential addressing the often neglected question of how europeanization effects help to mitigate some of the classical limitations of european foreign policymaking the book will be of great interest to students of eu policy middle eastern politics peace and conflict resolution security studies and ir

represents the output of an innovative collaborative project focused on the euro mediterranean partnership emp this book sets out to show that regional security and stability may be achieved through a cultural approach based on the concept of regional identity construction

this work is the second in the 10 volume series early responses to hume which is an edited and annotated collection of eighteenth and nineteenth century critical reactions to scottish philosopher david hume 1711 1776 both a philosopher and historian he was infamous in his day for his skeptical views on human nature knowledge metaphysics and religion

european security concerns have focused increasingly on the potential for instability on europe s southern flank in 1995 the european union developed a framework for cooperation with the southern mediterranean nations in the aftermath of 9 11 the goal of encouraging the development of middle east democracy has acquired greater urgency not least in the eyes of the u s which has bolstered its own efforts to spur democratic reform it will be important to assess the effectiveness of other democracy promotion activities including those undertaken by european counterparts this report seeks to inform discussion in u s policymaking circles by offering an assessment of multilateral european democracy promotion efforts in the middle east

european governments have re discovered labour migration but are eager to be perceived as controlling unsolicited forms of migration especially through asylum and family reunion the emerging paradigm of managed migration combines the construction of more permissive channels for desirable and actively recruited labour migrants with ever more restrictive approaches towards asylum seekers non state actors especially employer organizations trade unions and humanitarian non

governmental organisations attempt to shape regulatory measures but their success varies depending on organizational characteristics labour market interest associations lobbying strategies regarding quantities and skill profile of labour migrants will be influenced by the respective system of political economy they are embedded in trade unions are generally supportive of well managed labour recruitment strategies but migration policy making also proceeds at the european union eu level while national actors seek to upload their national model as a blueprint for future eu policy to avoid costly adaptation top down europeanization is re casting national regulation in important ways notwithstanding highly divergent national regulatory philosophies based on field work in and analysis of primary documents from six european countries france italy united kingdom ireland germany and poland this book makes an important contribution to the study of a rapidly europeanized policy domain combining insights from the literature on comparative political economy europeanization and migration studies the book makes important contributions to all three while demonstrating how migration policy can be fruitfully studied by employing tools from mainstream political science rather than treating it as a distinct subfield

this title was first published in 2003 in this study ricardo gomez traces the origins of the external mediterranean policy of the european union eu and examines in detail the negotiations that shaped the policy and its impact combining historical analysis with case studies of the euro med partnership initiative eu policy on algeria and the eu s involvement in the middle east peace process he covers a diverse array of issues that will appeal to scholars across a variety of sub disciplines of political science and international relations

taking a comparative approach this book considers the ways in which political regimes have changed since the arab spring it addresses a series of questions about political change in the context of the revolutions upheavals and protests that have taken place in north africa and the arab middle east since december 2010 and looks at the various processes have been underway in the region democratisation tunisia failed democratic transitions egypt libya and yemen political liberalisation

morocco and increased authoritarianism bahrain kuwait syria in other countries in contrast to these changes the authoritarian regimes remain intact saudi arabia qatar arab united emirates

this festschrift is published in honour of annalisa rosselli a political economist and historian of economic thought whose academic activity has promoted unconventional ways of thinking throughout her career a renowned list of scholars articulate and respond to this vision through a series of essays leading to an advocacy of pluralism and critical thinking in political economy the book is split into five parts opening with a section on new topics for the history of economic thought including new perspectives in gender studies and an illustration of the fecundity of the link with economic history this is followed by sections that address relevant perspectives on the classical approach to distribution and accumulation ricardo interpretation of sraffa and the legacy of keynes this book will appeal to students interested in reforming economics as well as academics and economists interested in political economy and the history of economic thought

political and socio economic change in the middle east and north africa examines the shortcomings of the economic development policies in the region before and after the arab uprisings many mena countries tried to pursue neoliberal policies to boost economic growth however the outcome was associated with rising and disproportionate unemployment among the youth and women the focal point of the book is the role of gender and the ways in which policies translate into economic outcomes particular attention is paid to women s entrepreneurship especially as owners of small and medium enterprises which as the authors argue can potentially reduce unemployment and poverty for the population as a whole the book offers perspectives on wholesome policies that take account of issues concerning gender and youth and thus contribute to lower unemployment and reduced poverty and inequity

for two decades bruce robbins has been a theorist of and participant in the movement for a new cosmopolitanism an appreciation of the varieties of multiple

belonging that emerge as peoples and cultures interact in perpetual war he takes stock of this movement rethinking his own commitment and reflecting on the responsibilities of american intellectuals today in this era of seemingly endless u s warfare robbins contends that the declining economic and political hegemony of the united states will tempt it into blaming other nations for its problems and lashing out against them under these conditions cosmopolitanism in the traditional sense primary loyalty to the good of humanity as a whole even if it conflicts with loyalty to the interests of one s own nation becomes a necessary resource in the struggle against military aggression to what extent does the new cosmopolitanism also include or support this old cosmopolitanism in an attempt to answer this question robbins engages with such thinkers as noam chomsky edward said anthony appiah immanuel wallerstein louis menand w g sebald and slavoj zizek the paradoxes of detachment and belonging they embody he argues can help define the tasks of american intellectuals in an era when the first duty of the cosmopolitan is to resist the military aggression perpetrated by his or her own country

analysis of north african revolt against authoritarianism known as the arab spring embraced reductionist explanations such as the social media youth unemployment and citizens agitations to regain dignity in societies humiliated by oppressive regimes this book illustrates that reductionist approaches can only elucidate some symptoms of a social problem while leaving unexplained the economic and political structures which contributed to it one outcome of quiescence resource based ethnic and sectarian conflicts and faulty development paradigm is deepened inequality and a wedge between winners and losers or affluence wealth and power vis à vis poverty and hunger among humiliated jobless and hope less masses the book blends theories of development and transition to explain the complex factors which contributed to north africans revolt against authoritarianism and its long term consequences for political development in the arab world this timely book is of great interest to researchers and students in development studies economics and middle eastern studies as well as policy makers and democracy human rights and social justice activists in the arab world the creation of the euro mediterranean partnership in 1995 was seen at the time as a forward thinking foreign policy which would strengthen ties between europe and the mediterranean arab states since that time however almost none of this initial ambition has been translated into positive successful policy twenty years on from the creation of the euro mediterranean partnership now the union for the mediterranean this book collects some of the most influential articles published in the mediterranean politics journal since 1995 and suggests what these articles tell us about the state of relations between europe and the middle east the selection of articles gives a sense of the way in which analytical debate has changed in the journal s lifetime a lifetime which has seen the journal at the forefront of academic study on a variety of issues in the mediterranean region as such the selection is naturally a reflection of the different periods from which the articles are taken and taken together they paint a picture of how the euro mediterranean partnership has been reshaped over time

european foreign policy in an evolving international system provides the reader with an updated assessment of european foreign policy fifteen years after maastricht the contributions analyze the level of policy convergence achieved by eu member states in crucial areas and regions of the world

though the media frequently cover tensions surrounding radical muslim communities within western countries coverage and understanding of similar tensions within muslim nations themselves are far more limited this study of the netherlands scientific council for government policy analyzes developments in islamic beliefs political activism society and law in twelve islamic countries since the 1970s dynamism in islamic activism is a penetrating timely study that helps citizens and policy makers look beyond simplistic stereotypical understandings of islamic societies

of the 54african states only south africa is categorised by the united nations industrial development organization unido amongst industrialised countries the economic activities in africa are still dominated by the production and trade of agricultural and mineral commodities this situation is in spite of the longstanding africa european

union eu co operation which intends among other things to support africa s industrialisation endeavours imperatively a long road to substantive levels of industrialisation still lies ahead of most african countries this raises the question as to what role the international community could and should play in the twenty first century to provide the support needed to expedite africa s industrial transformation this book argues that to supplement the initiatives of each african country international partnerships of both a north south and south south nature will serve better purposes if they are leveraged to develop productive capacities in african economies in order to enable the african countries to leverage their traditional partnership with the eu for industrialisation a paradigm shift is obligatory a feasible model should emulate the japanese led flying geese model and the chinese led bamboo capitalism model

the time is ripe for the european union its institutions and member states to undertake an explicit review of its current policy of benign neglect towards the broad collection of muslim democrat parties in the mediterranean arab states the group of experts assembled to produce this new book adduces mounting evidence that this policy may lead to unintended consequences such as the reinforcement of anti democratic regimes and radical islamism their arguments favour a broad inclusion of muslim democrats in eu initiatives aiming at the reform of governance and the development of civil society without extending to them any singular exclusive or unsolicited privileges

the council of the european union is the institutional heart of eu policy making but who gets what when and how in the council what are the dimensions of political conflict and which countries form coalitions in the intense negotiations to achieve their desired policy outcomes focussing on collective decision making in the council between 1998 and 2007 this book provides a comprehensive account of these salient issues that lie at the heart of political accountability and legitimacy in the european union based on a novel and unique dataset of estimates of government policy positions salience and power in influencing deliberations an explanatory model approximating the nash bargaining solution is employed to predict the policy outcomes on ten policy domains of central importance to this institution the book

s analyses comprise investigations into the determinants of decision making success the architecture of the political space and the governments coalition behavior

in the time span of a two term us presidency poland went from an authoritarian one party state with a faltering centrally planned economy to become a relatively stable multiparty democracy and a market economy with one of the highest gdp growth rates in europe a central feature of these economic and political reforms is a high rate of entry of new domestically owned firms this book uses detailed economic and political data to examine how these new firms contributed to the polish transition the authors test propositions about why some regions have more new firms than others and how the success of these new firms contributed to political constituencies that supported economically liberal parties the book concludes by contrasting the polish with the experiences of other transitional countries

the war in iraq seemed to bring to a head underlying differences between the united states and the vast majority of european countries regarding the best means to maintain international peace and stability the unilateralism of the united states as opposed to the multilateralism of the european union is seen as a very significant source of potential rivalry between the two actors this volume examines in detail whether the policies of the united states and the eu are truly diverging with respect to the most pressing issues facing north africa or whether in fact they are converging in terms of objectives to be achieved and strategies for their implementation through a number of papers that include both comparative and case specific studies this book enables a better understanding of the differences and similarities in eu and us foreign policies and security strategies for the region a clearer analysis of their respective democracy promotion policies and a better examination of their respective approach to the islamist question in light of the continued success of such movements this book was originally published as a special issue of the journal of north african studies

the book examines skill systems and vocational training in a number of coordinated market economies analysing historical origins and contemporary developments
