xing lu examines language art persuasion and argumentation in ancient china and offers a detailed and authentic account of ancient chinese rhetorical theories and practices within the society s philosophical political cultural and linguistic contexts she focuses on the works of five schools of thought and ten well known chinese thinkers from confucius to han feizi to the the later mohists lu identifies

seven key chinese terms pertaining to speech language persuasion and argumentation as they appeared in these original texts selecting ming bian as the linchpin for the chinese conceptual term of rhetorical studies lu compares chinese rhetorical perspectives with those of the ancient greeks illustrating that the greeks and the chinese shared a view of rhetoric as an ethical enterprise and of speech as a rational and psychological activity the two traditions differed however in their rhetorical education sense of rationality perceptions of the role of language approach to the treatment and study of rhetoric and expression of emotions lu also links ancient chinese rhetorical perspectives with contemporary chinese interpersonal and political communication behavior and offers suggestions for a multicultural rhetoric that recognizes both culturally specific and transcultural elements of human communication

why would china jeopardize its relationship with the united states the former soviet union vietnam and much of southeast asia to sustain the khmer rouge and provide hundreds of millions of dollars to postwar cambodia why would china invest so much in small states such as those at the china africa forum that offer such small political economic and strategic return some scholars assume pragmatic or material concerns drive china s foreign policy while others believe the government was once and still is guided by marxist ideology conducting rare interviews with the actual policy makers involved in these decisions sophie richardson locates the true principles driving china s foreign policy since 1954 s geneva conference though they may not be right in a moral sense china s ideals are based on a clear view of the world and the interaction of the people within it a philosophy that even in an era of unprecedented state power remains tied to the origins of the prc as an impoverished undeveloped state the five principles of peaceful coexistence mutual respect for territorial integrity and sovereignty nonaggression noninterference equality and mutual benefit and peaceful coexistence live at the heart of chinese foreign policy and set the parameters for international action in this model of state to state relations the practices of extensive diplomatic communication mutual benefit and restraint in domestic affairs become crucial to achieving national security and global stability

china has emerged as a member of the elite club of nations who are powerful at both global poles polar states are global giants strong in military scientific and economic terms the concept of a polar great power is relatively unknown in international relations studies yet china a rising power globally is now widely using this term to categorize its aspirations and emphasize the significance of the polar regions to their national interests china's focus on becoming a polar great power represents a fundamental re-orientation a completely new way of imagining the world china's push into these regions encompasses maritime and nuclear security the frontlines of climate change research and the possibility of a resources bonanza as shown in this book china's growing strength at the poles will be a game changer for a number of strategic vulnerabilities that could shift the global balance of power in significant and unexpected ways

this book shows how international trade was a key part of the classic western policy of containment towards the soviet union in the cold war in the late 1970s trade and containment may summarise the new relation that communist china moulded with the capitalistic west in the late 1970s ideology had become less important and a rapprochement between the prc people's republic of china and the western powers over trade with the purpose of isolating and weakening the common russian rival was practically unavoidable within a relatively short span of time the balance of power in the indo pacific area had been reversed simply put beijing's market was too big to be ignored and the atlantic allies collaborated sometimes even competing with each other to allow china access to the centres of world finance however the western powers had not realised that beijing would never pursue alignment with them on the contrary the

increased trading and financial linkage with capitalistic countries gave china room to manoeuvre enabling it to play the western states off against each other this book will be of much interest to students of cold war studies chinese history foreign policy and international relations

this edited volume provides an overview of inequality and stratification in contemporary china a rare and timely resource it presents key research on the topic published in chinese sociological review from 2011 to 2023 using one or multiple waves of chinese general social survey cgss data reflecting the advancement of the field over the past decade the cgss launched in 2003 and modelled after the us general social survey is an annual or biennial cross sectional survey of a nationally representative sample of the population from all provinces except for tibet certain waves of cgss data e g 2003 and 2008 contain detailed retrospective information about education and job history which can be analysed to address various issues related to educational stratification and career mobility in both the pre reform and reform eras at the junction of the 20th anniversary of the cgss 2003 2023 this volume draws on cgss data to uncover dynamic and evolving inequality in china by examining topics such as education stratification income inequality career and intergeneration mobility and how they are shaped by the socialist post socialist institutional structure such as the household registration hukou system the work unit danwei system this collection significantly advances the understanding of chinese social stratification extending far beyond scholars initial interests in the social consequences of the market transition this volume invites social scientists to

think more deeply about how politics and economics interplay with other social and demographic trends in shaping the pattern of inequality and provides a rich source and foundation for understanding inequality dynamics in contemporary china

light on more richly textured nuanced and inspiring insights into the interconnection between contemporary chinese urban youth and media power in an increasingly multicultural multilingual and multiracial world

the book explores developments in russia china relations in the aftermath of the global economic crisis arguing that the crisis transformed their bilateral affairs regional liaisons and crucially altered the roles both states play on the international arena discussing how russo chinese cooperation has accelerated in energy trade arms sales and in the russian far east the focus is on how the still mutually advantageous relationship has become more asymmetric than ever reflecting china s meteoric rise and russia s decline these dynamics are explored through three perspectives domestic regional and global domestically the book traces the role of political coalitions and key interest groups involved in how the two states shape their reciprocal policies changes in the regional dimension are
