the critical companion to his works includes an expanded biographical chapter featuring king's return to writing after his accident and his groundbreaking experiments in publishing a full chapter is devoted to each of his eight most recently published works of fiction offering thorough critical treatments of *desperation* 1996 *the green mile* 1997 *the regulators* 1996 *dark tower iv wizard and glass* 1997 *bag of bones* 1998 *the girl who loved tom gordon* 1999 *hearts in atlantis* 1999 *dreamcatcher* 2001 discussions of character development thematic concerns and issues of style and symbolism follow concise plot synopses an alternate critical perspective is offered for each work king's achievements and placement in the horror genre are reconsidered especially in light of his more recent forays into suspense fiction science fiction fantasy and other areas of writing the volume includes a selective list of further suggested readings includes biographical sources general criticism and reviews

during the 1980s university based intellectuals came under heavy fire from both radicals and conservatives they were accused by the former of betraying their public duty as general critics of society and by the latter of promulgating radical ideologies and corrupting the young in this work the author counters both left and right arguing that the professionalization of literary study was inevitable and fortuitous robbins undertakes close studies of such figures as edward said fredric jameson and raymond williams while considering the major trends in contemporary cultural studies and giving significant attention to relevant developments in such disciplines as ethnology and sociology secular vocations ranges over materials from britain france and the us knitting them together in a synthesis that places in bold relief many of the major controversies in contemporary intellectual life it concludes with a plea for what robbins calls comparative cosmopolitanism to displace the more militantly particularist projects that have come to dominate the human sciences

busby berkeley's big production numbers are emblematic of the hollywood dream factory exploring the tensions between escapism and ideological over coding in the warner bros musical this book tracks the ways in which berkeley created spectacles that are both critical and complacent in relation to the society that produced and received them berkeley carried into his images of utopia the assembly plant the misogyny the fascism and racism of his day but his collaboration with the filmmakers enrigh bacon and leroy into whose narratives his numbers were spliced likewise involved taking care to draw a line between spectacle and the everyday the book makes the case that the warner bros musical with its attention to the specificity and containment of the aesthetic dimension has corrective lessons to impart for the aestheticized politics not only of the 1930s but also of the current age

transgression and its limits is a long overdue collection that reads the complex relationship between artistic transgressions and the limits of law and the subject in mid twentieth century theoretical understandings of transgressive culture it is the existence of the limit that guarantees the possibility and success of the transgression while the limit calls for obedience it also tempts with the possibility of violation to breach the limits of the acceptable is to simultaneously define them however this classical understanding of transgression may no longer apply under the conditions of post modernity late capitalism and the simulated or empty transgressions that this period of the simulacra encourages context becomes paramount in reading the myriad forms of transgression that encompass politics aesthetics and the ethics of the obscene while a range of theoretical perspectives are employed in order to elucidate the economies at work underneath the seemingly transgressive act the essays selected include explorations of transgression in cinema photography art law music philosophy technology and both classical and contemporary literature and drama professor fred botting s co author of bataille and the tarantinian ethics analysis of transgression from bataille to baudrillard and ballard compliments the collection s concerns about the status of transgression aside from fourteen critical essays on topics such as early modern drama george bataille j g ballard the female necrophilic torture porn cinema and the art of robert mapplethorpe and salvador dali there is also a new discussion of transgression between novelist iain banks and professor roderick watson emeritus at the university of stirling with its focus on the paradoxical nature of the impulse to transgress as well at its wide ranging historical and artistic concerns transgression and its limits is a landmark book in a rapidly developing scholarly field

many fans of robin hardy s the wicker man 1973 may know that this classic is considered a fine sample of folk horror few will consider that it s also a prime example of holiday horror holiday horror draws its energy from the featured festive day here may day sergeant neil howie edward woodward a christian copper is lured to the remote scottish island summerisle where hidden from the eyes of all a thriving celtic pagan religion holds sway his arrival at the start of the may day celebration is no accident the clash between religions fought on the landscape of the holiday drives the story to its famous conclusion in this devil s advocate steve a wiggins delineates what holiday horror is and surveys various aspects of the citizen kane of horror movies that utilize the holiday beginning with a brief overview of beltane and how may day has been celebrated this study considers the role of sexuality and fertility in the film conflicting with howie s christian principles this leads to an exploration of his theology as contrasted with that of lord summerisle christopher lee and his tenants such differences in belief make the fiery ending practically inevitable

the alliance of critical theory between frankfurt and paris adorno foucault and the critique of the west argues that critical theory continues to offer valuable resources for critique and contestation during this turbulent period to assess these resources it examines the work of two of the twentieth century s more prominent social theorists theodor w adorno and michel foucault although adorno was situated squarely in the marxist tradition that foucault would occasionally challenge deborah cook demonstrates that their critiques of our current predicament are complementary in important respects among other things these critiques converge in their focus on the historical conditions economic in adorno and political in foucault that gave rise to the racist and authoritarian tendencies that continue to blight the west cook also shows that when adorno and foucault plumb the economic and political forces that have shaped our identities they offer remarkably similar answers to the perennial question what is to be done
