 properly ibn ezra combined a passion for the plain sense of the verse with a reverence  
 for the rabbis as transmitters of reliable tradition his most widely used works are his  
 commentaries on the torah which are admired for their depth and penetration into the  
 mysteries of the hebrew language the text of the torah and the meaning of the mitzvot

throughout the centuries translations of the bible have steadily improved in general each new translation inherits from previous ones and opens the way for later ones while a new translation derives help from its predecessors it should go further the recovery version of the new testament following the precedent set by the major authoritative english versions and taking these versions as reference not only incorporates lessons learned from an examination of others practices but also attempts to avoid biases and inaccurate judgments this version frequently guided by other versions attempts to provide the best utterance for the revelation in the divine word that it may be expressed in the english language with the greatest accuracy translating the bible depends not only on an adequate comprehension of the original language but also on a proper understanding of the divine revelation in the holy word throughout the centuries the understanding of the divine revelation possessed by the saints has always been based upon the light they received and this understanding has progressed steadily the consummation of this understanding forms the basis of this translation and its footnotes hence this translation and the accompanying footnotes could be called the crystallization of the understanding of the divine revelation which the saints everywhere have attained to in the past two thousand years it is our hope that the recovery version will carry on the heritage that it has received and will pave the way for future generations as with any new testament translation the determination of the original greek text based upon the available manuscripts forms the basis for the text of the recovery version of the new testament the recovery version follows for the most part the nestle aland greek text as found in novum testamentum graece 26th edition however in determining the original form of any verse the translators of the recovery version gave careful consideration to the larger context of chapter and book and to similar portions of the new testament the most recently discovered manuscripts or the manuscripts of oldest date are not necessarily the most accurate or reliable hence the determination of the text for this

version was based largely upon the principle stated above departures from the nestle aland text are sometimes indicated in the footnotes italicized words in the verses indicate supplied words not found in the greek text quotation marks are used to indicate close quotation from the old testament the recovery version embodies extensive research into the meaning of the original text and attempts to express this meaning with english that is to the point easy to understand and readable in those places where it is difficult to express the exact meaning of the original greek explanatory footnotes have been supplied the subject provided at the beginning of each book and the outline of each book take the historical facts as their base and express the spiritual meaning in each book the footnotes stress the revelation of the truth the spiritual light and the supply of life more than history geography and persons the cross references lead not only to other verses with the same expressions and facts but also to other matters related to the spiritual revelation in the divine word

in the mid 3<sup>rd</sup> century bc king ptolemy ii philadelphus of egypt ordered a translation of the ancient hebrew scriptures for the library of alexandria which resulted in the creation of the septuagint the original version published circa 250 bc only included the torah or in greek terms the pentateuch the torah is the five books traditionally credited to moises circa 1500 bc cosmic genesis exodus leviticus numbers and deuteronomy the first edition was followed by the second around 225 bc which added the books of joshua judges and ruth which was later known as the octateuch this version of the septuagint was later carried south into the kingdom of kush by the jews fleeing egypt in 200 bc when judea was in revolt and the ptolemy's attempted to exterminate the jews in egypt the octateuch later became the torah of the beta israel community in sudan and ethiopia known as the orit a number of stories exist to explain the origin of the beta israel community the ethiopian jews indigenous to ethiopia eritrea and sudan the recorded story of the origin of the ethiopian jews was reported by eldad ha dani in the late 800s ad eldad ha dani was a dark skinned jew from a country south of kush modern northern sudan who was captured by pagan ethiopians and ultimately sold on the coast of what might be modern kenya or tanzania to a jew from the parthian empire who took him back to modern iran he later traveled through the middle east and the mediterranean sea he claimed that he was from a country of jews south of kush who were the descendants of the tribes of dan gad naphtali and asher who had left israel during the civil war that split the kingdom into judea and samaria modern secular scholars doubt there was a united kingdom of israel however if the civil war did happen it would have happened in 922 bc when jero-boam i and rehoboam split the kingdom of solomon if true this would make the ethiopian jews neither jews nor samaritans but a third branch of the judeo samaritan religions and arguably older than the others the christian text kebra nagast claims that judaism entered into ethiopia slightly earlier when the ethiopian queen of sheba traveled to israel and was impregnated by king solomon her son menelik i led a group of jews to ethiopia when he stole the ark of the

covenant other than the ethiopian orthodox christians few consider the kebra nagast historically valid some members of the beta israel community claim the ethiopian jews were originally members of the jewish tribes led by moses that chose not to enter into canaan with joshua and instead traveled south and settled in the land of moses ethiopian wife mentioned in numbers chapter 12 a third story of the origin of the ethiopian jews took place shortly after the greeks had taken control over egypt and judea when king ptolemy i resettled judeans in southern nubia this would have taken place between 305 and 282 bc and later the jews migrated south for various reasons however they ended up in ethiopia they have traditionally used a variation of the octateuch which they call the orit the octateuch is documented as being the version of the septuagint that was published around 225 bc like the ethiopian christian bible the orit appears to have had sections updated from hebrew and arabic sources over the past two thousand years octateuch the original orit is a 21st century translation aimed at restoring the original orit
