- Closure under Addition:** The sum of any two rational numbers is always another rational number. For example, $1/2 + 1/3 = 5/6$, which is still a rational number.
- Closure under Subtraction:** Similarly, the difference between two rational numbers is always rational. $1/2 - 1/3 = 1/6$.
- Closure under Multiplication:** The product of two rational numbers is always a rational number. $(1/2) (1/3) = 1/6$.
- Closure under Division:** The quotient of two rational numbers (where the divisor is not zero) is always a rational number. $(1/2) / (1/3) = 3/2$.
- Density:** Between any two distinct rational numbers, there exists another rational number. This means you can always find a rational number in between any two given rational numbers, no matter how close they are. This property implies an infinite number of rational numbers between any two distinct rational numbers.

3. Representing Rational Numbers: Fractions and Decimals

Rational numbers can be expressed in two primary ways: as fractions (as defined above) and as decimals. When a rational number is expressed as a decimal, it will either terminate (end) or repeat infinitely. Terminating Decimals: These decimals have a finite number of digits after the decimal point. Examples include 0.5 ($1/2$), 0.75 ($3/4$), and 0.125 ($1/8$). Repeating Decimals (Recurring Decimals): These decimals have a sequence of digits that repeats infinitely. Examples include 0.333... ($1/3$), 0.666... ($2/3$), and 0.142857142857... ($1/7$). The repeating sequence is often indicated with a bar over the repeating digits (e.g., $0.\overline{333}$ or $0.\overline{3}$).

4. Distinguishing Rational Numbers from Irrational Numbers

It is crucial to understand that not all numbers are rational. Irrational numbers cannot be expressed as a ratio of two integers. Their decimal representations are neither terminating nor repeating; they continue infinitely without any repeating pattern. Famous examples of irrational numbers include π (π) $\approx 3.14159...$ and $\sqrt{2} \approx 1.41421...$
