history and evolution of aircraft reviews the history of aviation from early history to the present day including the evolution milestones of military aircraft civil aircraft helicopters drones balloons airships and their engines it also provides the background and development of different types of aircraft including manned and unmanned vehicles aircraft carriers fixed or rotary wings air sea and amphibian flight vehicles covering current and developing applications of unmanned aerial vehicles uavs the book highlights the prospects of future flying vehicles including automotives and jetpacks it follows the transition from piston to jet engines that include shaft based engines turboprop turboshaft and propfan turbine based engines turbojet and turbofan and athodyd engines ramjet turbo ramjet and scramjet the book explores flight vehicles technological advancements and evolution including their geometrical features and performance parameters it will also include nine appendices resembling databases for all types of aircraft the book will be a useful reference for academic researchers and aviation aerospace and mechanical engineering students taking aerodynamics aircraft structures aircraft engines and propulsion courses aviation history enthusiasts will be interested in the scope of the content as well instructors can utilize a solutions manual for their course

for the central powers 1916 was a year of trial and error of successes and failures of innovation and of drastic changes tactics developed while war aims mutated to suit the inertia of trench warfare advances were effectively countered with the development of new weaponry or indeed aided by their inclusion across all fronts whether at home or in poland citizens and soldiers alike stood fast against entente forces on the western front bitter fighting continued apace to the east the armies of austro hungary germany and bulgaria battled entente forces meanwhile at sea the german high seas fleet ambushed the royal navy off the coast of denmark on the home front the poor harvest of 1916 coupled with a lack of transport led to a winter of stark deprivation as a consequence the german government introduced what was effectively a system of rationing entitled sharing scarcity while to the south ottoman forces fought allied soldiers for control of kut and erzurum a fortified trading port in eastern turkey germany in the great war verdun somme is the third publication in a five part series in addition to the author s introduction and a chronology of events five hundred

contemporary photographs many of which have never before been published in this country are included

the full story of the american aeroplane building programme in book form for the first time comprehensively illustrated including some previously unpublished photographs rich in detail this will be of interest to aviation and military historians as well as modellers soon after entering the war in april 1917 american propaganda promised that the country would darken the skies over europe by sending over the greatest aerial armada ever seen encouraged by the french government america promised to build no fewer than 22 000 aeroplanes within a year and to field and maintain a force of 4 000 machines all of the latest type over the western front during 1918 this was to provide adequate air support for her own troops as well as a way of using her industrial strength to bypass the squalor of the war in the trenches and so bring an end to the stalemate of attrition into which the war had descended however by the time of the armistice more than eighteen months later just a few hundred american built aeroplanes had reached the war fronts and several investigations into the causes of the failure of the project were already in progress undarkened skies the american aircraft building programme of the first world war examines the fascinating history of american aircraft manufacturing during the latter years of the first world war in addition to investigating the causal factors of america's lack of progress in the air

on december 17 1903 on the windswept beaches of kitty hawk north carolina orville wright piloted the world's first powered flight in one of the most famous moments in history within a few short years airplanes of various designs were lifting into the air over europe and america soon the entire world was caught up in the fevered advance of flight and airplanes zeppelins autogyros and helicopters were making the world a much smaller place to celebrate the first full century of powered flight premier aviation historian christopher chant and world famous illustrator john batchelor have joined forces to showcase an astonishing march of progress from the early experiments of gliderman otto lilienthal to the moon walk of neil armstrong it has indeed been a century of triumph from the golden age of zeppelins to the extreme design experiments of world war ii to the fierce modernism of supersonic fighter jets a century of triumph demonstrates the full richness of mankind's flying craft in addition to batchelor's illustrations the book features never before published vintage watercolour posters of pre world war i aviation races and a treasure trove of

photographs and text combines full histories of the planes themselves with biographical essays on some of the great figures of the twentieth century the barnstormers igor sikorsky amelia earhart chuck yeager and the apollo xvii astronauts among others a century of triumph is a visual and factual feast for anyone who marvels at the majesty of flying

as noted in volume i the beginning of futility after the allies had induced italy to join them against the central powers the italian army used the lives of its illiterate peasant fanti as coin advancing to finally endanger austro hungarian defenses by august 1917 viennas generals were convinced that with german help they had to counterattack while gen eric ludendorff was wary of giving assistance finally he was won over after hearing a bold and daring plan later known as blitzkrieg italian intelligence warnings of an enemy offensive were discarded as it was too late in the year on october 24 1917 austro german forces unleashed the first blitzkrieg battle of the century which the italian army as the anglo french in france in may 1940 could not handle using the four commandments of blitzkrieg deception infiltration isolation annihilation they quickly advanced 100 miles through the confused italian defenses halting at the piave river and adjacent mountains unable to handle the assault many disheartened troops had fled but later with heroic deeds halted the enemy advance notwithstanding the great victory vienna was negotiating a separate peace with lloyd george and president woodrow wilson both of whom who did not believe the allies could win

a look at the transformation of aerial combat during world war i and the pilots of every country who were celebrated for shooting down enemy aircraft by the time of the outbreak of the first world war aviation was only eleven years old the daddy of battlefield warfare until that point in time had been the cavalry a position it maintained even as war was declared on the western front aircraft were not initially seen as an offensive weapon and were instead used by both sides as observation platforms or to take aerial photographs even when they were eventually used in an offensive capacity they did not have machine guns attached to them if the crew wanted to open fire then they had to use a pistol or rifle as the war progressed so the use of aircraft changed from being an observational tool to that of a fighter and bomber aircraft something that had never been foreseen at the outbreak of the war this book looks at the fighter aces from all sides these were pilots who had been credited with shooting or forcing down a minimum of

five enemy aircraft of which there were hundreds while some of these aces survived many of them were killed the most famous fighter ace of all is without doubt the german pilot known as the red baron manfred von richthofen it s the legendary stuff i was brought up on reading about first world war dogfights stephen wynn and tanya wynn weave a good tale between them absolutely enthralling books monthly

austria hungary did not have an overseas empire its empire lay within its own boundaries and the primary purpose of its navy until the beginning of the twentieth century was the defense of its coastline as its merchant marine dramatically grew admirals believed that the navy should take a more proactive policy of defense the 1890s saw the beginning of a series of naval building programs that would create a well balanced modern fleet cruisers were constructed for the protection of overseas trade and for showing the flag but the decisive projection of austria hungary s commitment to control the adriatic was the construction of a force of modern battleships despite the naval arms race throughout europe at the time the navy had difficulty obtaining funds for new ships the difficulties experienced in battleship funding and construction mirrored the political difficulties and ethnic rivalries within the empire nevertheless by august of 1914 the austro hungarian had a fleet of battleships this book details the five classes of austro hungarian battleships in service during world war i

disputes between ecuador and peru are nearly 200 years old and revolve around the question of ecuador s territory extending beyond the andes and into the amazonian basin or not based on diverse interpretations of the real cédulas royal proclamations spain used to define its colonial territories in the americas they became the source of the longest running international armed
