in the spring of 1976 i had the privilege of serving on a stanford research institute team engaged in examining various facets of the mexican economy that study provided the opportunity to visit many government ministries and talk with some of mexico s leading economists these professional experiences stimulated me to undertake full scale research on the growth potential of the mexican economy a subject in which i had long been interested and on which i had written from time to time beginning with my book income distribution policies and economic growth in semi industrialized countries a comparative study of iran mexico brazil and south korea 1 the present volume might be regarded as the culmination of this endeavor the methodological approach here is partly descriptive and partly empirical illustrative formal models are built on both qualitative and theoretical foundations to sharpen the issue and put the mexican economy in perspective international comparisons are made through out

castro's cuba is isolated the guerrillas who once spread havoc through uruguay and argentina are dead dispersed or running for office as moderates and in 1990 nicaragua's sandinistas were rejected at the polls by their own constituents are these symptoms of the fall of the latin american left or are they merely temporary lulls in an ongoing revolution that may yet transform our hemisphere this perceptive and richly eventful study by one of mexico's most distinguished political scientists tells the story behind the failed movements of the past thirty years while suggesting that the left has a continuing relevance in a continent that suffers from destitution and social inequality combining insider's accounts of intrigue and armed struggle with a clear sighted analysis of the mechanisms of day to day power utopia unarmed is an indispensable work of scholarship reportage and political prognosis

this book examines a sophisticated effort by radical economic reformers to change the ideology of nationalism in mexico from 1988 94 and so reinvent the country in a way that was more friendly to their market policies and responses to this by opposition parties

this study reveals how the social pact formalized during the armed stage of the mexican revolution 1910 20 and implemented during the second stage 1920 40 was upset during the third or arrested stage 1940 70 when the bureaucrat professionals at the helm opted for intensive economic development by taking the capitalist road although momentarily revived during yet a fourth stage of revolution 1970 82 this social pact was subsequently betrayed from within by the official party of the revolution and undermined from without by the operation of economic forces behind the scenes in this first book on the complete history of the mexican revolution hodges and gandy reveal that along with the end of its social pact mexico passed out of its former nationalist and capitalist orbit to enter the new professional societies and global order fathered by the transnationals from 1920 to 1970 mexico s bureaucrat professionals hung onto political power while native capitalists continued to flourish in response mexico s workers and peasants staged strikes against the nationalized sector and fomented guerrilla wars concessions were then made to this group until beginning in 1982 the social pact was again eroded at the expense not only of the popular sectors but also of the capitalists the economic surplus was redistributed away from owners and into the pockets of professionals that was the revolution s last gasp before it was officially put to rest in 2000 with the official party s defeat at the polls hodges and gandy challenge the current belief that mexico s economic system is still capitalist by presenting statistical evidence that shows how the chief beneficiaries of the economy are no longer the providers of capital but instead the providers of professional services

the political and social upheavals that have transformed the economies of eastern europe and the former soviet union during the past ten years have sparked considerable interest and speculation on the part of western observers less noted though hardly less dramatic has been the revolutionary spread of free market capitalism throughout much of latin america during the same period in a wide ranging survey that illuminates both the history and present business climate of the region paul roberts and karen araujo describe the economic transformation currently taking place in latin

america and as they do so they also reexamine many of the prevailing orthodoxies concerning international development and the regulation of markets and point to the success of privatization and free enterprise in mexico argentina and chile as harbingers of the economic future for both hemispheres the potential strength of the economies of central and south america has always been obvious the authors point out abundant natural resources combined with vast expanses of fertile land and a sophisticated and relatively cohesive social culture are found throughout the region but the authors show that the latin american nations were slow to discard the economic and social climate that they had inherited from their spanish colonial masters who had ruled by selling government jobs creating a network of privilege and by suppressing through over regulation the development of markets for goods services and capital the prevalent cultural attitude in latin america was hostile to commerce trade and work indeed it was more socially acceptable to court government privilege than to compete in markets the authors further show that u s aid packages to the region actually reinforced this culture of privilege and further hampered the growth of a free economy not until the 1980s did the picture begin to change largely in response to the economic crises brought on through catastrophic national debts and hyperinflation the book describes the efforts of the salinas pinochet and menem governments to combat the established interests of the local elites and the international development agencies to privatized state industries and to established independent markets in this new climate private capitalists and entrepreneurs are feted and celebrated and productivity has risen to levels unimagined only a few years before but this dramatic economic turnaround the authors show is a mixed blessing for the u s for if it provides us with a vast new market for our goods it has also created a powerful new competitor for capital investment to keep american and foreign capitalists investing in america the government needs to make changes which the authors outline in a provocative conclusion central and south america have a combined population of 460 million people a potential market greater than the united states and canada combined or the european community thus the rise of free market capitalism in latin america is of vital interest to the united states the capitalist revolution in latin america provides an insightful portrait of this dramatic economic turn around illuminating the economic consequences for our own society
