13 papers by 16 leading archaeologists and historians of late antiquity and the early middle ages break new ground in their discussion analysis and criticism of present interpretations of early medieval rituals and their material correlates some deal with rituals relating to death life cycles and the circulation in other contexts of objects otherwise used in the burial ritual others are concerned with the symbolism and ideology of royal power the formation of a political ideology east of the rhine from the mid 5th century onwards and penance rituals in relation to carolingian episcopal discourse on ecclesiastical power and morale all deal with the creation of new identities cultures norms and values and their expression in new rituals and ideas from the period of the great migrations through the later roman empire down to the society of beowulf and the later carolingians

from handshakes and toasts to chant and genuflection ritual pervades our social interactions and religious practices still few of us could identify all of our daily and festal ritual behaviors much less explain them to an outsider similarly because of the variety of activities that qualify as ritual and their many contradictory yet in many ways equally legitimate interpretations ritual seems to elude any systematic historical and comparative scrutiny in this book catherine bell offers a practical introduction to ritual practice and its study she surveys the most influential theories of religion and ritual the major categories of ritual activity and the key debates that have shaped our understanding of ritualism bell refuses to nail down ritual with any one definition or understanding instead her purpose is to reveal how definitions emerge and evolve and to help us become more familiar with the interplay of tradition exigency and self expression that goes into constructing this complex social medium

this book explores modern european religious and non religious rituals and their main features by focusing on music as a key element required for the full expression of beliefs it specifically examines the relationship between religious non religious pagan cultural celebratory and traditional rituals in doing so this text focuses on the extent to which the rituals overlap replace or feed religious or pseudo religious beliefs to create alternative beliefs individual or collective that systematically ignore any religion the book further analyses the relationship between daily habits holidays sports politics culture and other pagan rituals as forms that represent social feelings by identifying enjoying or impersonating emotions and transversally it explores how music facilitates and fosters those emotions the volume also investigates how rituals coexist and mutually influence each other through a representation of religious and non religious rituals and how music plays a central role in that phenomenology the author argues that music is a key part of various types of rituals e g rites of passage and that music supports and enriches the meaning of the ritual to ultimately strengthen the bond of communication with the individual and the group this monograph appeals to students and researchers working in religious studies and in music theory

ritual is one of the most pervasive religious phenomena in the tibetan cultural world despite its ubiquity and importance to tibetan cultural life however only in recent years has tibetan ritual been given the attention it deserves this is the first scholarly collection to focus on this important subject unique in its historical geographical and disciplinary breadth this book brings together eleven essays by an international cast of scholars working on ritual texts institutions and practices in the greater tibetan cultural world tibet nepal bhutan and mongolia while most of the chapters focus on buddhism two deal with ritual in tibet s indigenous bon religion all of the essays are original to this volume an extensive introduction by the editor provides a broad overview of tibetan ritual and contextualizes the chapters within the field of

buddhist and tibetan studies the book should find use in advanced undergraduate courses and graduate seminars on tibetan religion it will also be of interest to students and scholars of ritual generally

temporalities in mesoamerican ritual practices examines the time based dimensions of ritual activities in past and present mesoamerican societies including the prehispanic colonial and modern periods the authors explore ritual around three principal categories of action creating transforming and destroying as significant cultural manifestations of the temporal dimension of transition processes based on specific case studies new analysis of fieldwork data and long term collaboration between authors chapters engage empirically and theoretically with the multiple temporalities of ritual in relation to both the unfolding of ritual performance and its external and symbolic anchors taking rituals as a series of specific formalized actions that produce transitory changes within an initial context the authors examine activities that generate change linked to artifact production life cycles healing conflict resolution crisis management the enthronement of rulers and transfers of responsibilities and practices relating to the occupation abandonment reuse or conversion of socialized spaces adopting a multidisciplinary approach in archaeology ethnohistory anthropology and linguistic anthropology temporalities in mesoamerican ritual practices offers new insights into ritual time approached through multi semiotic material sensorial and pragmatic perspectives that encourage further interdisciplinary dialogue

this edited volume addresses the environmental and cultural underpinnings of the kind of social conflict that spawned the origins and elaboration of ritualized human and animal sacrifice in mesoamerica the chapters variously document the place of cultural evolution and social complexity in the origins and elaboration of ritual human sacrifice cannibalism and trophy taking across a broad spectrum of mesoamerican cultural and social contexts that first saw the light of day before 2600 bce and rapidly developed and proliferated across the mesoamerican world in the centuries to follow they study the developments in sacrifice rituals through the centuries into the first millennium ce when the mexica aztec and their allies had elevated ritual human sacrifice such that they produced a plethora of sacrificial acts modes and manners of death and associated deities to articulate the necro cultures and blood tribute of the times the chapters further study present day rites of amerindian communities from throughout mesoamerica that include paying homage to the deities of earth and sky through sacrifice and consumption of animal surrogates the interdisciplinary effort undertaken by this international cadre of scientists including anthropologists bioarchaeologists art historians ethnohistorians iconographers and religious studies experts provides a particularly rich forum for launching an interrogation into the role of conflict environment and social complexity in the emergence and persistence of ritual violence and human sacrifice in the mesoamerican world

addressing problems of objectivity and authenticity sabine maccormack reconstructs how andean religion was understood by the spanish in light of seventeenth century european theological and philosophical movements and by andean writers trying to find in it antecedents to their new christian faith

viewing a variety of narratives through the lens of inebriation imagery this book explores how such imagery emerges in colonial peru as articulator of notions of the self and difference resulting in a new social hierarchy and exploitation reading inebriation evaluates the discursive and geo political relevance of representations of drinking and drunkenness in the crucial period for the consolidation of colonial power in the viceroyalty of peru and the resisting rhetoric of a hispanicized native andean writer interested in changing stereotypes fighting inequality and promoting tolerance at imperial level in one of the main centers of spanish colonial economic activity in the americas in recognizing and addressing this imagery mónica morales restores an element of colonial discourse that hitherto has been overlooked in the critical readings dealing with the history of sixteenth and early seventeenth century andes she presents drinking as the metaphorical site where western culture and the new world collide and define themselves on the grounds of differing drinking rituals and ideas of moderation and excess narratives such as dictionaries legal documents conversion manuals historical writings literary accounts and chronicles frame her context of analysis

contributions in this volume demonstrate how across the ancient mediterranean and over hundreds of years women s rituals intersected with the political economic cultural or religious spheres of their communities in a way that has only recently started to gain sustained academic attention the volume aims to tease out a number of different approaches and contexts and to expand existing studies of women in the ancient world as well as scholarship on religious and social history the contributors face a famously difficult task ancient authors rarely recorded aspects of women s lives including their songs prophecies and prayers many of the objects women made and used in ritual were perishable and have not survived certain kinds of ritual objects lowly undecorated pots for example tend not even to be recorded in archaeological reports however the broad range of contributions in this volume demonstrates the multiplicity of materials that can be used as evidence including inscriptions textiles ceramics figurative art and written sources and the range of methodologies that can be used from analysis of texts images and material evidence to cognitive and comparative approaches

this book is the first in a series of volumes which form the published proceedings of the 9th meeting of the international council of archaeozoology icaz held in durham in 2002 the 35 papers present a series of case studies from around the world they stretch beyond the standard zooarchaeological topics of economy and ecology and consider how zooarchaeological research can contribute to our understanding of human behaviour and social systems the volume is divided into two parts part 1 beyond calories focuses on the zooarchaeology of ritual and religion contributors discuss ways to approach questions of ritual and religion through the faunal record and consider how material culture depicting and or associated with animals can provides clues about ideology religious practices and the role of animals within spiritual systems part 2 equations for inequality looks at questions of identity status and other forms of social differentiation in former human societies contributors discuss how differences in food consumption nutrition and food procurement strategies can be related to various forms of social differentiation among individuals and groups

located between mexico city and veracruz puebla has been a political hub since its founding as puebla de los Ángeles in 1531 frances l ramos s dynamic and meticulously researched study exposes and explains the many and often surprising ways that politics and political culture were forged tested and demonstrated through public ceremonies in eighteenth century puebla colonial mexico s second city with ramos as a guide we are not only dazzled by the trappings of power the silk canopies brocaded robes and exploding fireworks but are also witnesses to the public spectacles through which municipal councilmen consolidated local and imperial rule by sponsoring a wide variety of carefully choreographed rituals the municipal council made locals into audience participants and judges of the city s tumultuous political life public rituals encouraged residents to identify with the roman catholic church their respective corporations the spanish empire and their city but also provided arenas where individuals and groups could vie for power as ramos portrays the royal oath ceremonies funerary rites feast day celebrations viceregal entrance ceremonies and holy week processions we have to wonder who paid for these elaborate rituals and why ramos discovers and decodes the intense debates over expenditures for public rituals and finds them to be a central part of ongoing efforts of councilmen to negotiate political relationships even with the spanish crown s increasing disapproval of costly public ritual and a worsening economy puebla s councilmen consistently defied all attempts to diminish their importance ramos innovatively employs a wealth of source materials including council minutes judicial cases official correspondence and printed sermons to illustrate how public rituals became pivotal in the shaping of puebla s complex political culture

through cross cultural comparisons archaeological data and ethnographic insights joel w palka addresses central questions about maya pilgrimage practice and

discusses the broad importance of maya ritual landscapes and pilgrimage for mesoamerica as a whole

the gitanos of el rastro carry an ontology of simultaneity as self employed traders and pentecostal practitioners in madrid this makes the spanish romani be considered as both a part of and apart from mainstream society this book is an anthropological account of a group of middle and upper class gitanos and their ways of creating a

society within society based upon distinct cultural moral and ideological values notions and practices the study renders a comprehensive perspective on social processes of classification stratification othering and the role of strangers in society and how these processes unfold in the interface between social ritual and economic life on a local to global scale

a fascinating exploration of the role that magic has played in the history of buddhism as far back as we can see in the historical record buddhist monks and nuns have offered services including healing divination rain making aggressive magic and love magic to local clients studying this history scholar sam van schaik concludes that magic and healing have played a key role in buddhism s flourishing yet they have rarely been studied in academic circles or by western practitioners the exclusion of magical practices and powers from most discussions of buddhism in the modern era can be seen as part of the appropriation of buddhism by westerners as well as an effect of modernization movements within asian buddhism however if we are to understand the way buddhism has worked in the past the way it still works now in many societies and the way it can work in the future we need to examine these overlooked aspects of buddhist practice in buddhist magic van schaik takes a book of spells and rituals one of the earliest that has survived from the silk road site of dunhuang as the key reference point for discussing buddhist magic in tibet and beyond after situating buddhist magic within a cross cultural history of world magic he discusses sources of magic in buddhist scripture early buddhist rituals of protection medicine and the spread of buddhism and magic users including material from across the vast array of buddhist traditions van schaik offers readers a fascinating nuanced view of a topic that has too long been ignored

the bioarchaeology of ritual and religion is the first volume dedicated to exploring ritual and religious practice in past societies from a variety of environmental remains building on recent debates surrounding for instance performance materiality and the false dichotomy between ritualistic and secular behavior this book investigates notions of ritual and religion through the lens of perishable material culture research centering on bioarchaeological evidence and drawing on methods from archaeological science has traditionally focused on functional questions surrounding environment and economy however recent years have seen an increased recognition of the under exploited potential for scientific data to provide detailed information relating to ritual and religious practice this volume explores the diverse roles of plant animal and other organic remains in ritual and religion as foods offerings sensory or healing mediums grave goods and worked artifacts it also provides insights into how archaeological science can shed light on the reconstruction of ritual processes and the framing of rituals the 14 papers showcase current and new approaches in the investigation of bioarchaeological evidence for elucidating complex social issues and worldviews the case studies are intentionally broad encompassing a range of sub disciplines of bioarchaeology including archaeobotany anthracology palynology micromorphology geoarchaeology zooarchaeology including avian and worked bone studies archaeomalacology and organic residue analysis the temporal and geographical coverage is equally wide extending across europe from the mediterranean and aegean to the baltic and north atlantic regions and from the mesolithic to the medieval period the volume also includes a discursive paper by prof brian hayden who suggests a different interpretative framework of archaeological contexts and rituals
