most recent golden age of tv as well as a critical look at the relationship between entertainment media and collective memory

the concept of history reflects on the presuppositions behind the contemporary understanding of history that often remain implicit and not spelled out it is a critique of the modern understanding of history that presents it as universal and teleological progressively moving forward to an end although few contemporary philosophers and historians maintain the view that there is strict universality and teleology in history the remnants of these positions still affect our understanding of history but if history is not universal and singular evolving toward an objective universal end it should be possible to admit of multiple histories some of which we appropriate as our own an another important aspect of this book is that it provides an account of history that is itself both historical and rooted in attempts to narrate and explain history from its inception in antiquity the book seeks to establish features or constituents of history that might be found in any historical account and might themselves be considered historical invariants in history

this volume reveals the extraordinary range of daniel defoe s intellectual interests three volumes are devoted to major historical writings by defoe his memoirs of the church of scotland and history of the union of great britain are included here

cassius dio described his own age as one of iron and rust this study which is the first of its kind in english examines the decline and decay that cassius dio diagnosed in this period 180 229 ce through an analysis of the author s historiographic method and narrative construction it shows that the final books were a crucial part of dio s work and it explains how dio approached a period that he considered unworthy of history in view of his larger historiographic project

in recent years the remote kingdom of bhutan has increasingly attracted the attention of the world in 2008 it emerged as the world s youngest democracy and in the same year crowned the world s youngest monarch this was followed by the new king s colourful wedding in 2011 today it continues to enchant the rest of the world with its policy of gross national happiness and has become a very popular destination for travel but despite its growing popularity and the rising scholarly interest in the country bhutan remains one of the most poorly studied places on earth karma phuntsho s the history of bhutan is the first ever attempt to cover the entire history of bhutan in some detail in english combining both traditional perspectives and modern academic analysis written by a leading expert on the country the book tells the story of bhutan in a narrative style interspersed with some analytical and topical discussion and numerous citations and translations from earlier writings it is primarily a historical account but it also includes substantive discussions of bhutan s geography culture and society to give the

in the half century before walter scott's waverley dozens of popular novelists produced historical fictions for circulating libraries this book examines eighty five popular historical novels published between 1762 and 1813 looking at how the conventions of the genre developed through a process of imitation and experimentation

anthony hoekema brings to the study of biblical prophecy and eschatology a maturity that is rare among contemporary works on the subject free of sensationalism he evinces a reverence for the scriptures and a measured scholarship one of the best studies on eschatology available christianity today

in september 1952 john lukacs then a young and unknown historian wrote george kennan 1904 2005 the u s ambassador to the soviet union asking one of the nation's best known diplomats what he thought of lukacs's own views on kennan's widely debated idea of containing rather than militarily confronting the soviet union a month later to lukacs's surprise he received a personal reply from kennan so began an exchange of letters that would continue for more than fifty years lukacs would go on to become one of america's most distinguished and prolific diplomatic historians while kennan who would retire from public life to begin a new career as pulitzer prize winning author would become revered as the man whose strategy of containment led to a peaceful end to the cold war their letters collected here for the first time capture the writing and thinking of two of the country's most important voices on america's role and place in world affairs from the division of europe into east and west after world war ii to its unification as the soviet union disintegrated and from the war in vietnam to the threat of nuclear annihilation and the fate of democracy in america and the world this book provides an insider's tour of the issues and pivotal events that defined the cold war the correspondence also charts the growth and development of an intellectual and personal friendship that was intense devoted and honest as kennan later wrote lukacs in letter perceptive understanding and constructive criticism is as i see it in itself a form of creative philosophical thought it is a belief to which both men subscribed and that they both practiced presented with an introduction by lukacs the letters in through the history of the cold war reveal new dimensions to kennan's thinking about america and its

future and illuminate the political and spiritual philosophies that the two authors shared as they wrote about a world transformed by war and by the clash of ideologies that defined the twentieth century

this study reevaluates the work of the scientist and radical poet and dramatist and english exile in germany thomas lovell beddoes 1803 1849 while his writing has elicited high praise from poets ranging from robert browning through ezra pound to john ashbery scholars have frequently neglected it on grounds of its purportedly morbid and opaque eccentricity countering this scholarly perception this book deftly relocates beddoes s poetry drama and prose at the centre of anglo german debates on aesthetics and life science politics and theatre in an early nineteenth century european context aided by his letters from germany the book re creates the intercultural discursive universe in which beddoes easily moves from shakespeare s plays or the aesthetic experiments of shelley and his circle to goethe and to topics debated among heinrich heine and the jungdeutschen from the most advanced contemporary scientific research to the post napoleonic politics of the german radical students organisations and from byron baillie and london s illegitimate theatre to schiller s and tieck s highly charged reflections on male male friendship the study combines historicist strategies with theories of performance performativity and visibility as it focuses in particular on beddoes s major and defining work death s jest book first completed in 1829 and published posthumously after much revision in 1850 this study shows how death s jest book as both drama and poetry devises complex perspectives on scientifically inspired notions of life and history how it forges a radical vision for post napoleonic europe and how it links this vision to a daring conception of desiring gendered selves the book pays close attention to the dialogue beddoes s writing maintains with

early modern literature and it highlights the proto modernist features that link his work to that of b chner grabbe and a european theatre avant garde this innovative study of beddoes s work cutting across current investigations into politics gender and science in intercultural romantic studies should be of interest to scholars and students of british romantic and victorian studies as well as of german vorm rz studies and to students and scholars of drama and theatre as well as queer studies
