skeleton body in a white enamel shell and made the scale flush with the counter for ease of use while retaining its basic function bel geddess major innovation was the redesign of the standard gas stove from a stylized furniture form to a single unit encased in clean white enamel rethinking the stove as a skyscraper grid hung with steel plates he simplified the manufacturing process by creating twelve interchangeable components to form sixteen different models source norman bel geddes horizons
