from his gold medal at the 1960 olympic games to his defeat of sonny liston to claim the world heavyweight championship
in 1964 the unforgettable thrilla in manila against joe frazier and the rumble in the jungle against george foreman the
greatest of all time muhammad ali has captured the attention of the world his conversion to islam his refusal to serve in
the in the vietnam war i ain t got no quarrel with them vietcong and his speaking tours in the 1960s have all contributed to
his status as one of the most revered sporting figures ever here drawn from books specialist periodicals newspapers
college magazines covering his speaking tours and the work of major literary figures such as thomas hauser is the biggest
and best collection ever of writing on the greatest

muhammad ali and howard cosell were must see tv long before that phrase became ubiquitous individually interesting
together they were mesmerizing they were profoundly different young and old black and white a muslim and a jew ali
barely literate and cosell an editor of his university s law review yet they had in common forces that made them
unforgettable both were above all performers who covered up their deep personal insecurities by demanding loudly and

often public acclaim theirs was an extraordinary alliance that produced drama comedy controversy and a mutual respect that helped shape both men's lives Dave Kindred uniquely equipped to tell the Ali-Cosell story after a decades long intimate working relationship with both men re-creates their unlikely connection in ways never before attempted from their first meeting in 1962 through Ali's controversial conversion to Islam and refusal to be inducted into the U.S. Army the right for him to do both was publicly defended by Cosell Kindred explores both the heroics that created the men's upward trajectories and the demons that brought them to sadness in their later lives Kindred draws on his experiences with Ali and Cosell fresh reporting and interviews with scores of key personalities including the families of both in the process Kindred breaks new ground in our understanding of these two unique men the book presents Ali not as a mythological character but as a man in whole and it shows Cosell not in caricature but in faithful scale with vivid scenes poignant dialogue and new interpretations of historical events this is a biography that is novelistically engrossing a richly evocative portrait of the friendship that shaped two giants and changed sports and television forever

beast monster savage psycho the glowering menace of Mike Tyson has spooked us for almost two decades and still we remain fascinated why Ellis Cashmore's answer is disturbing white society has created Tyson as vengeance for the loss of privilege produced by civil rights Cashmore's eviscerating analysis of Tyson's life and the culture in which he grew up rose to prominence and descended into disgrace provokes the reader into re-thinking the role of one of the most controversial and infamous figures of recent history told as an odyssey style homeward journey to Tyson's multi-pathological origins in the racially explosive ghettos of the 1960s Tyson's story is part biography part tragedy and part exposition his associations with people like Al Sharpton Don King and Tupac Shakur shaped his life and events such as the O.J. Simpson trial and the Rodney King riots formed a turbulent background for the Tyson psychodrama over the course of an epic boxing career Tyson was transformed from the most celebrated athlete on earth to a primal malevolent hate figure yet even

after being condemned as a brute tyson retained a power a power to captivate cashmore reveals that the sources of that power lie as much in us as in tyson himself

more than any other sport boxing has a history of being easy to rig there are only two athletes and one or both may be induced to accept a bribe if not the fighters then the judges or referee might be swayed in such inviting circumstances the mob moved into boxing in the 1930s and profited by corrupting a sport ripe for exploitation in boxing and the mob the notorious history of the sweet science jeffrey sussman tells the story of the coercive and criminal underside of boxing covering nearly the entire twentieth century he profiles some of its most infamous characters such as owney madden frankie carbo and frank palermo and details many of the fixed matches in boxing's storied history in addition sussman examines the influence of the mob on legendary boxers including primo carnera sugar ray robinson max baer carmen basilio sonny liston and jake lamotta and whether they caved to the mobsters threats or refused to throw their fights boxing and the mob is the first book to cover a century of fixed fights paid off referees greedy managers misused boxers

and the mobsters who controlled it all true crime and the world of boxing are intertwined with absorbing detail in this notorious piece of american history

the two bouts between cassius clay and sonny liston are widely considered the most anticipated and controversial fights in heavyweight boxing cassius clay won the first bout in miami beach in february 1964 when liston refused to come out for the seventh round the second fight took place in lewiston maine fifteen months later in may 1965 halfway through the first round ali countered a left from liston with a fast right knocking liston down he did not get up ali s right was so fast many spectators never even saw it it was quickly dubbed the phantom punch and rumors began to swirl that liston had thrown the fight many who believed liston a brutal fighter who picked up boxing in prison had also thrown the first fight the year before in miami were now vindicated journalist and sports historian rob sneddon takes a fresh look at the infamous muhammad ali sonny liston fight of may 25 1965 which ended in chaos at a high school hockey rink in lewiston maine sneddon digs deep into the fight s background and comes up with fascinating new takes on boxing promotion in the 1960s on ali s rapid rise and liston s sudden fall on how the bout ended up in lewiston and of course on ali s phantom punch that single lightning quick blow triggered a complex chain reaction of events that few people understood either then or now even if you ve seen films of the fight and think you know what happened this book will change your perspective on boxing s greatest controversy

based on more than 500 interviews including muhammad ali s closest associates and enhanced by access to thousands of pages of newly released fbi records this is a thrilling story of a man who became one of the great figures of the twentieth century

everything that he has done was against this country joe frazier on muhammad ali part man part myth and all american muhammad ali is history s most beloved most revered athlete but though he was the greatest inside the ring outside he was a hulking mass of contradictions this book is the first comprehensive pull no punches account of america s least likely icon jack cashill explores the changing mores and racial dynamics of the sixties alongside ali s epic battles in the ring what ali did great or otherwise was to channel the spirit of his age he captured the ethos of that decade all too well it wasn t pretty i was there and i know what i saw cashill reveals how elijah muhammad seduced ali and how that seduction spelled the betrayal of dr king s dream the death of malcolm x the humiliation of joe frazier the rise of don king and the tragic undoing of mike tyson and proves that ali was an unapologetic sexist and unabashed racist calling for the lynching of interracial couples and an american apartheid as late as 1975 ali routinely denigrated black heroes who did not share his point of view including joe louis jackie robinson thurgood marshall and especially joe frazier ali shamelessly courted some of the most brutal dictators on the planet qadaffi idi amin papa doc duvalier nkrumah mobutu and ferdinand marcos with unusual sympathy and unflinching insight cashill assesses ali s boxing conquests and political influence he shows how the

very figure who could have brought america s diverse people together when it mattered instead tore them apart jack cashill has written and directed the holocaust through our own eyes the soul of the west and the emmy award winning the royal years among other documentaries for regional pbs and national cable channels cashill has a ph d in american studies from purdue and has been published in the wall street journal washington post fortune weekly standard worldnetdaily and ingram s where he serves as executive editor he is also the author of first strike ron brown s body and hoodwinked how intellectual hucksters have hijacked american culture

with an introduction by salman rushdie and an afterword by the author it was the night of february 25 1964 a cloud of cigar smoke drifted through the ring lights cassius clay threw punches into the gray floating haze and waited for the bell when cassius clay burst onto the sports scene in the 1950s he broke the mould he changed the world of sports and went on to change the world itself from his early fights as cassius clay the young wiry man from louisville unwilling to play the noble and grateful warrior in a white world to becoming muhammad ali the voice of black america and the most recognized face on the planet king of the world is the story of an incredible rise to power a book of battles fought inside the ring and out with grace and power pulitzer prize winning writer david remnick tells of a transcendent athlete and entertainer a rapper before rap was born ali was a mirror of his era a dynamic figure in the racial and cultural clashes of his time and king of the world is a classic piece of non fiction and a book worthy of america s most dynamic modern hero

a unique and powerful look at a new zealand experiment in social welfare gone wrong from the late 1950s to the mid 1980s when most of them were closed down the new zealand government maintained 26 residences for children and teenagers some of those children had the bad fortune to come from families with large numbers of children and who couldn t cope financially plucking a child out and putting him in a home to ease the burden was seen as a solution other children in came from profoundly dysfunctional backgrounds or were profoundly dysfunctional themselves could putting them all together in close quarters supervised by staff with mostly inadequate training ever deliver a positive outcome in this powerfully written book david cohen who himself spent time at epuni boy s home in the 1970s argues not he tracks down former

residents and staff members many of whom argue that boys home stints led boys to rather than away from lives of crime it also led some into abuse evocatively and originally written cohen s research takes him back to the era of moral panic about juvenile delinquency that drove the creation of the homes and traces the sea change in ideas about the care of troubled adolescents especially maori who were hugely over represented in the muster that spelled their eventual demise totally gripping it is a unique insider account of a failed experiment
