in towards a reformed enlightenment salomon van til 1643 1713 and the cartesio cocceian debates in the early modern dutch republic matthias mangold offers the first in depth investigation into the theological and philosophical convictions of an influential yet hitherto much neglected dutch theologian working around the turn of the eighteenth century with its strong contextual approach this analysis of van til s thought sheds new light on various intellectual dynamics at the time most notably the long standing conflict between the voetian and cocceian factions within the dutch reformed church and the reception of cartesian philosophy in the face of emerging radical enlightenment ideas

one of the most pertinent questions facing students of mormon studies is gaining further understanding of the function the bible played in the composition of joseph smith s primary compositions the book of mormon and the doctrine and covenants with a few notable exceptions such as philip barlow s mormons and the bible and grant hardy s understanding the book of mormon full length monographs devoted to this topic have been lacking this manuscript attempts to remedy this through a close analysis of how mormon scripture specifically the book of mormon and the doctrine and covenants integrates the writings of new testament into its own text this manuscript takes up the argument that through the rhetoric of allusivity the allusion to one text by another joseph smith was able to bestow upon his works an authority they would have lacked without the incorporation of biblical language in order to provide a thorough analysis focused on how smith incorporated the biblical text into his own texts this work will limit itself only to those passages in mormon scripture that allude to the prologue of john s gospel john 1 1 18 the choice of the prologue of john is due to its frequent appearance throughout smith s corpus as well as its recognizable language this study further argues that the manner in which smith incorporates the johannine prologue is by no means uniform but actually quite creative taking at least four different forms echo allusion expansion and inversion the methodology used in this work is based primarily upon recent developments in intertextual studies of the bible an analytical method that has proved to be quite effective in studying later author s use of earlier texts

this study presents the religious factor in the development of a separatistic group identity among the forebears of the afrikaners during the dutch colonial period of south african history dutch reformed covenant theology and baptism practice

rooted in the thousand generation covenant theory helped to shape this self understanding it traces the basic developments of covenant theology in the netherlands during the period and demonstrates how these concepts were conveyed to colonial south africa the dominant strain of covenantal thought treated the entire community as redeemed and called to be separate it was presented through a variety of means through which virtually every colonist was exposed this study offers a balanced historical approach to the role of theological concepts in the colonial roots of afrikaner group identity it answers traditional scholarship in the field which either directly identify the concepts behind the development of apartheid with calvinist theology or more recently deny that the reformed faith had any role in the development of apartheid ideology until the twentieth century

revelation is so central to mormonism that one might presume that the study of original texts is an exhausted field the remarkable truth is that little has yet been done in this area an analysis of the earliest manuscripts and first printed versions often in newspapers helps establish the original setting and often the intention of the revelations many of which have been greatly changed by later textual modifications by knowing more of the history of the early church marquardt hopes to reveal new and important vistas concerning both early mormonism and the concept of revelation itself

the covenant of redemption pactum salutis the eternal intra trinitarian covenant was a common staple within early modern reformed theology yet there are very few historical works that examine this doctrine j v fesko s study the covenant of redemption origins development and reception seeks to address this lacuna in the contemporary period the covenant of redemption has been derided as speculative mythological a declension from trinitarianism or erroneously derived from one or two biblical proof texts yet seldom have critics carefully engaged the primary sources to examine the different formulations supporting exegesis and ways in which the doctrine was employed far from speculation sub trinitarian or a cold business transaction proponents of the covenant of redemption constructed this doctrine based upon a web of interconnected biblical texts and were very sensitive to maintaining a robust doctrine of the trinity as they employed this doctrine as a bulwark against the anti trinitarian claims of socinian theologians proponents of the doctrine also saw this pre temporal covenant as the embodiment of intra trinitarian love that overflows unto those chosen in christ for their salvation and ultimate fellowship with the triune god john v fesko explores the historical origins of the doctrine and then surveys its development in the seventeenth through nineteenth centuries examining key advocates of the doctrine including david dickson herman witsius johannes cocceius francis turretin patrick gillespie john gill jonathan edwards charles hodge and a a hodge he then examines the contemporary reception of the doctrine in the twentieth century with a survey of the doctrine s critics including karl barth herman hoeksema klaas schilder and john murray after exploring the claims of the critics the study moves to examine the views of twentieth century proponents including geerhardus vos herman bavinck abraham kuyper louis berkhof and g c berkouwer
