horror fiction in the global south cultures narratives and representations believes that the experiences of horror are not just individual but also simultaneously cultural within this understanding literary productions become rather potent sites for the relation of such experiences both on the individual and the cultural front it s not coincidental then that either william blatty s the exorcist or gabriel garcia marquez s one hundred years of solitude become archetypes of the re presentations of the way horror affects individuals placed inside different cultures such an affectation though is but a beginning of the ways in which the supernatural interacts with the human and gives rise to horror considering that almost all aspects of what we now designate as the global north and its concomitant the global south political historical social economic cultural and so on function as different paradigms the experiences of horror and their telling in stories become functionally different as well added to this are the variations that one nation or culture of the east has from another the present anthology of essays in such a scheme of things seeks to examine and demonstrate these cultural differences embedded in the impact that figures of horror and specters of the night have on the narrative imagination of storytellers from the global south if horror has an everyday presence in the phenomenal reality that southern cultures subscribe to it demands alternative phenomenology the anthology allows scholars and connoisseurs of horror to explore theoretical possibilities that may help address precisely such a need

in this thing called the world debjani ganguly theorizes the contemporary global novel and the social and historical conditions that shaped it ganguly contends that global literature coalesced into its current form in 1989 an event marked by the convergence of three major trends the consolidation of the information age the arrival of a perpetual state of global war and the expanding focus on humanitarianism ganguly analyzes a trove of novels from authors including salman rushdie don delillo michael ondaatje and art spiegelman who address wars in iraq afghanistan and sri lanka the palestinian and kashmiri crises the rwandan genocide and post9 11 terrorism these novels exist in a context in which suffering s presence in everyday life is mediated through digital images and where authors integrate visual forms into their storytelling in showing how the evolution of the contemporary global novel is analogous to the european novel s emergence in the eighteenth century when society and the development of capitalism faced similar monumental ruptures ganguly provides both a theory of the contemporary moment and a reminder of the novel s power

this book discusses the complex ways in which the novel offers a vibrant arena for critically engaging with our contemporary world and scrutinises the genre's political ethical and aesthetic value far reaching cultural political and technological changes during the past two decades have created new contexts for the novel which have yet to be accounted for in literary studies addressing the need for fresh transdisciplinary approaches that explore these developments the book focuses on the multifaceted responses of the novel to key global challenges including migration and cosmopolitanism posthumanism and ecosickness human and animal rights affect and biopolitics human cognition and anxieties of inattention and the transculturality of terror by doing so it testifies to the ongoing cultural relevance of the genre lastly it examines a range of 21st century anglophone novels to encourage new critical discourses in literary studies

the book intends to present a critique of some select 21st century hard science fiction novels in order to explicate the various ways in which the elements of posthumanism transhumanism techno singularity intersect and interact with other such ideas as monstrosity animality machinicity post anthropocentrism and anthropocene the study divides its analysis into seven different chapters and attempts to present an elaborate study on various aspects of posthumanism transhumanism and singularity the book despite being a collection of miscellaneous essays actually intends to show how a technologically mediated transhuman posthuman culture will normally be defined by a total dissolution of binaries such as digital and real animal and human and machine and man the book also wants to describe through its analysis of some select hard science fiction novels that man machine merger and creation of hyper immersive virtual reality can function as two of the most effective agents for catalyzing a radically transformative posthuman post scarcity and techno utopian culture the analysis presented in the book is not totally oriented to the discussion of far future implications of accelerated technological progress which is imperative for arriving at a transhuman or posthuman stage rather the book is equally concerned with the implications of rapid technological advancements in our present times and so the study also posits that before ascending to the heights of posthuman status mankind has to cope with the good and bad aspects of the anthropocene which is the next stage in our collective evolution and journey towards the trans posthuman state the first chapter of this study attempts to bring to focus the phenomenon of a technologically mediated dissolution of the binaries between man animal human nonhuman and subject object which will be extremely important in the analysis of the emergence of a posthuman culture later in the study technological advancements can be seen here as either conducive towards creating a harmonious relationship between man and animal or through systematic denigration of the agency of the animal it can pave the way for the emergence of monstrosity in chapter 2 of the book we shall delve deep into the analysis of horror as illustrated in the novels and video games of the dead space series here through a multi theoretical perspective we shall find how horrors and monstrosity can manifest themselves in both written as well as digital virtual media in chapter 3 we shall delve into the discussion of the power of simulation in the construction of an immersive and hyperreal post transhuman culture where the

distinction between real and virtual and material and immaterial vanishes altogether in chapter 4 we dedicate the entire chapter to the study of kim stanley robinson s systems novel the ministry for the future 2020 to attempt a critique of the elements of good and bad anthropocene though not directly and intimately related to the study of posthumanism and transhumanism yet a discussion of the elements of the anthropocene will be of immense contemporary relevance to us the next chapter i e chapter 5 will attempt to present an explication of the role of machines in the realization of posthuman culture chapter 6 is primarily concerned with an analysis of stephen baxter s novels to see how posthuman culture is constructed around the agency of the autopoietic machines the final chapter attempts to present a brief analysis of three of iain m banks culture novels namely matter surface detail and hydrogen sonata to elaborate on the employment of posthuman transhuman tropes in these works

provides an extensive chronology and an introduction which explains the nature of gothic and shows how it has evolved includes entries on major writers and works of geographical variants like irish scottish or russian gothic and female gothic queer gothic and science fiction

looking at a wide selection of pakistani novels in english this book explores how literary texts imaginatively probe the past convey the present and project a future in terms that facilitate a sense of collective belonging the novels discussed cover a range of historical movements and developments including pre 20th century islamic history the 1947 partition the 1971 pakistani war the zia years and post 9 11 pakistan as well as pervasive themes including ethnonationalist tensions the zamindari system and conspiracy thinking the book offers a range of representations of how and whether collective belonging takes shape and illustrates how the pakistani novel in english often overshadowed by the proliferation of the indian novel in english complements pakistani multi lingual literary imaginaries by presenting alternatives to standard versions of history and by highlighting the issues english language literary production bring to the fore in a broader pakistani context it goes on to look at the literary devices and themes used to portray idea nation and state as a foundation for collective belonging the book illustrates the distinct contributions the pakistani novel in english makes to the larger fields of postcolonial and south asian literary and cultural studies

this book discusses british novels published during the 1970s which feature terrorists either as main characters or a major plot points the focus on terrorism s literary depiction provides insight into the politics of the decade the book analyses texts from gerald seymour anthony burgess v s naipaul graham greene doris lessing b s johnson tom sharpe and eric ambler among others in order to engage with the ira the end of empire counterculture and environmentalism the book provides a brief history of terrorism as a concept and tactic before discussing british literature s relationship with terrorism it presents a standard terrorist morphology by which to analyse terrorist narratives along with other insights into the british post war imagination writing and extremism

partition is an enduring subject of indian writers in english the event was an unparalleled catastrophe of recent history which ravaged indian and pakistani and affected the sikhs sindhis hindus punjabis and bengal is in particular many hart rending stories and accounts of partition continue to be written and discussed and the blame game is still not over it has been a favourite topic of many authors artists journalists film makers and even writers of memoirs the present book discusses the highly complex subject of partition which deals with politics of greed the abdication of the authorities and the sufferings of males and females during and after partition numerous books have been written on the subject in regional and english language for the purposes of present book entitled only four novels written in different decades say 50s 70s 80s and 90s have been taken up and the novels like train to pakistan azadi the ice candy man and what the body remembers have been taken up for serious critical discussion in order to highlight the similarities and dissimilarities of approach and view points from both male and female points of view
