two gulf wars and the continuing arab israeli conflict have highlighted the salience of military factors in the middle east this book argues however that many of the most serious security challenges to arab states and societies are rooted not in external military threats but in the imperatives of

socio economic development contributors examine the regional security environment the social and political impact of regional militarization and underdevelopment as a source of regional insecurity
