it is a collection of autobiographical stories and essays by american author f scott fitzgerald it consists of previously unpublished letters notes and also three essays originally written for and published first in the esquire magazine during 1936 table of contents my lost city the crack up pasting it together handle with care afternoon of an author early success my generation francis scott key fitzgerald 1896 1940 was an american author of novels and short stories whose works are the paradigmatic writings of the jazz age a term he coined he is widely regarded as one of the greatest american writers of the 20th century

as emily considers how shell spend her time on this years summer vacation her father presents her with a very interesting prospect mr witherspoon a very important man is on his way and he may have a surprise in store for her al though he doesnt look very important when he arrives mr witherspoon offers emily the chance to embark on the adventure of a lifetime her mother agrees that is unsure at first emily finally summons her courage and sets off on a voyage of mystery danger and discovery with mr witherspoon to uncover the hidden secrets of arabias ancient ruins their journey leads them to the lost egyptian city of urguphome to an ancient pyramid with inner chambers full of jeweled statues and lost history but she and her companions are not alone on their search a band of shady thieves is out to claim the riches of lost city and they will stop at nothing to learn the whereabouts of her discovery

ashera clutched her worn lute against her chest her weathered knuckles white against the smooth wood rain hammered on the thatched roof of the tavern its rhythm blending with the raucous laughter and clinking mugs inside around her faces blurred under the dim oil lamps a tapestry of weathered fishermen braggart hunters and merchants with eyes sharp as their knives but even the merriment couldn't drown out the gnawing emptiness in ashera's heart
