in search of soul explores the meaning of soul in sacred and profane incarnations from its biblical origins to its central place in the rich traditions of black and latin history surveying the work of writers artists poets musicians philosophers and theologians alejandro nava shows how their understandings of the soul revolve around narratives of justice liberation and spiritual redemption he contends that biblical traditions and hip hop emerged out of experiences of dispossession and oppression whether born in the ghettos of america or of the roman empire hip hop and christianity have endured by giving voice to the persecuted this book offers a view of soul in living color as a breathing suffering dreaming thing

in lorca s legacy jonathan mayhew explores multiple aspects of the creative and critical afterlife of federico garcía lorca the most internationally recognized spanish poet and playwright of the twentieth century lorca is an iconic and charismatic figure who has evoked the admiration and fascination of musicians poets painters and playwrights across the world since his tragic assassination by right wing forces in 1936 at the onset of the spanish civil war this volume ranges widely discussing his influence on american theater his much debated lecture on the duende his delayed encounter with queer theory his influence on contemporary spanish poetry and other relevant topics the critical literature on lorca is vast and original contributions are comparatively rare but mayhew has found a way to shed fresh light on his legacy by looking with a critical eye at the creative transformations of his life and work both in spain and abroad lorca s legacy celebrates the wealth of material inspired by lorca bringing to bear a sophisticated theoretically informed critical perspective this book will be of enormous interest to anyone interested in the international projection of spanish literature or anyone who has felt the fascination of lorca s duende

nick cave is now widely recognized as a songwriter musician novelist screenwriter curator critic actor and performer from the band the boys

next door 1976 1980 to the spoken word recording the secret life of the love song 1998 to the recently acclaimed screenplay of the proposition 2005 and the grinderman project 2008 cave s career spans thirty years and has produced a comprehensive and sometimes controversial body of work that has shaped contemporary alternative culture despite intense media interest in cave there have been remarkably few comprehensive appraisals of his work its significance and its impact on understandings of popular culture in addressing this absence the present volume is both timely and necessary cultural seeds brings together an international range of scholars and practitioners each of whom is uniquely placed to comment on an aspect of cave s career the essays collected here not only generate new ways of seeing and understanding cave s contributions to contemporary culture but set up a dialogue between fields all too often separated in the academy and in the media topics include cave and the presley myth the aberrant masculinity projected by the birthday party the postcolonial australianness of his humour his interventions in film and his erotics of the sacred these essays offer compelling insights and provocative arguments about the fluidity of contemporary artistic practice

erin byrne captures the essence of france through unique and authentic experiences in wings from victory her collection of stories about travel in one of the world s most alluring countries some of her experiences come through serendipity others via good fortune still others by accident but each time erin takes the experience digs deeper and discovers meaning from it each story demonstrates in a different way this idea put forth by joseph campbell the passage of the mythological hero may be overground incidentally fundamentally it is inward into the depths where obscure resistances are overcome and long lost powers are revived from cézanne s studio in aix en provence to a tiny village in the jura mountains from a cozy bistro on the left bank of paris to a plain high above the normandy beaches erin travels through france collecting stories characters tastes and secrets that act as ingredients for change she learns to trust her intuition after listening to henri cartier bresson s advice after gazing at van gogh s self portrait erin finds a way to be more honest this book is about the gifts we all glean from our travels and will inspire readers to unwrap their own images and impressions in a new way

at the core we are all vibrations musical compositions in motion and that is why we resonate in communion with the world of music the human voice is the only instrument that sounds from within and our singing voice is deeply connected to heart and soul in the timbre and tonal nuances of the voice we can perceive subtle soul messages way beyond words the sound of the voice mirrors the movements in the depths of psyche and this touches us profoundly to liberate the voice is to liberate psyche to free the sound is to free the soul singing requires deep listening instinctual attention pure vocal presence and the song is a musical alchemical vessel for psychospiritual transformation music is a

magical magnet a sacred gift from the muses so that our songs may sound the mana of the mysterion lena mândotter's lifelong voyage with soul and song can inspire us all to reclaim our instinctual singing voice c g jung wrote that music should be an essential part of every analysis this book shows why and is a testament to the healing power of song

examining hamish henderson s search for the radical voice of the people in modern scotlandhow might the alienation of the artist in modern scotland be overcome how do you incite a popular folk revival can a poet truly speak with the voice of the people and what happens to the writer who rejects print culture in favour of becoming anon the life and times of polymath scholar author and folk hero hamish henderson 1919 2002 poses and helps us to answer these questions this book examines his life long commitment to finding a form of artistic expression suitable for post war europe though henderson is a major figure in scottish cultural history his reputation is largely maintained through anecdotes and radical folk songs this study explores his ideas in their intellectual cultural and political contexts it describes how all of his works in war poetry song collection folklore scholarship folksong revivalism literary translation and vicious public debates reflect this desire to see the artist fully reintegrated in society key features reclaims hamish henderson from the marginalia of scottish literary historyprovides a hitherto unexplored perspective on twentieth century scottish cultural historysituates scottish literary and cultural debates in the broader context of intellectual and cultural developments in twentieth century europe and the usdirectly tackles the question of national identity in twentieth century scotland

sexuality diaspora and race using theories espoused by jack halberstam josé esteban muñoz elizabeth grosz sara ahmed and rinaldo walcott as foundations for his arguments bancroft demonstrates that queering translation offers more expansive ways of imagining the relationship between translation and the identities cultures and societies that produce them intervening in new modernist studies and translation studies queering modernist translation furthers contemporary conversations regarding modernism and its lasting importance in the twenty first century

from the early years when he morphed from celebrated poet to provocative singer songwriter to his induction into the rock and roll hall of fame leonard cohen has endured as one of the most enigmatic and profound figures with a uniquely compelling voice and unparalleled depth of artistic vision in all of popular music the aesthetic quality and intellectual merit of cohen s work are above dispute here for the first time a team of philosophers takes an in depth look at its real significance want to know what cohen and kierkegaard have in common or whether cohen rivals the great philosophical pessimist schopenhauer then this book is for you it provides the first thorough analysis of cohen from various philosophical positions it is intended not only for cohen fans but also undergraduates in philosophy and other areas it explores important neglected aspects of cohen s work without attempting to reduce them to academic tropes yet nonetheless will also be useful to academics or anyone beguiled by the enigma that is leonard cohen

the second volume in the buenaventura series and the sequel to the brujo s way opens in december 1705 with a terrifying nightmare that fills don carlos buenaventura a powerful brujo in his sixth life with dread feeling the need to strengthen his brujo powers always weakened by town life he rides out into the wild mountain landscapes around santa fe in order to practice his sorcerer s technique of transforming himself into hawks and owls transformations are exhilarating but they do not dispel his sense of an impending menace in addition as he tells his friend inéz de recalde whom he has rescued from a difficult past and to whom he has declared his love he is impatient to move forward in his quest for wisdom on what he calls the unknown way into this picture comes a trio of itinerant entertainers a magician and two women dancers who offer an ambiguous promise can they lead him to deeper realms of consciousness or are they agents of his enemy the evil sorcerer don malvolio the magician and his alluring companions introduce carlos to dances that transport him into ecstatic mind states but he remains uncertain about what master they serve despite the risk of exposing his secret brujo identity and of being disloyal to inéz carlos allows himself to be drawn ever farther into their web of dark and dangerous enchantments includes readers guide

this biography offers a fresh understanding of the life and work of spanish composer manuel de falla 1876 1946 recognized as the greatest

composer in the spanish cultural renaissance that extended from the latter part of the 19th century until the outbreak of the spanish civil war in 1936 the biography incorporates recent research on falla draws on untapped sources in the falla archives reevaluates falla s work in terms of current issues in musicology and considers falla s accomplishments in their historical and cultural contexts

a bold new novel about the intersection of art love fame and money from the acclaimed author of dogeaters jessica hagedorn s edgy and entertaining new novel centers on the lives of two women who are neighbors in manhattan s west village mimi smith is a filmmaker of low budget slasher movies in search of new material her neighbor eleanor delacroix is a legendary writer of erotic fiction now nearing eighty and addicted to cocaine and gin their personal and artistic lives begin to collide in unexpected ways as eleanor grieves over the recent death of her live in lover the renowned painter yvonne wilder and as mimi deals with the challenges presented by her newly sober brother carmelo her drug dealing boyfriend who has mysteriously disappeared and her wayward fourteen year old daughter violet looming over all these characters is the ghost of agnes an illegal and cousin of mimi s who might have been murdered by her new jersey employers toxicology is a dark yet playful exploration of money desire mortality and the connection between creativity and self destruction

the ninth hour is the hour in which the sun possesses us and we abandon ourselves to its burning blinding flame to think with a light so bright

at noon we come out of plato's cave and stare into the sun the unknown gazing into the unknown these writings do not owe anything to the philosophical sun the good sun of plato that erases all differences the good sun of enlightened reason that is oblivious to the knowledge of the madman they are writings born beyond the sun on the rotten side of the sun unprotected by the shadow of logic writings come out of darkness of the spiritual umbra of he who stares directly at the sun and more specifically writings begotten out of the spiritual nigrescence of whom writes at the ninth hour at high noon

in august and september of 1988 jerry fielder the yousuf karsh's long time studio assistant and currently director of the karsh estate sat down with the master photographer and taped over nine hours of recollections of many portrait sessions karsh had experienced in his great career

the essays in modernism and mourning examine the work of mourning in modernist literature or more precisely its propensity for resisting this work drawing from recent developments in the theory and cultural history of mourning its contributors explore the various ways in which modernist writers repudiate freud's famous injunction to mourners to work through their grief endorsing instead a resistant or melancholic mourning that shapes both their themes and their radical experiments with form the emerging picture of the pervasive influence of melancholic mourning in modernist literature casts new light on longstanding critical arguments especially those about the politics of modernism it also makes clear the pertinence of this literature to the present day in which the catastrophic losses of 9/11 of retaliatory war of racially motivated genocide of the aids epidemic have made the work of mourning a subject of widespread interest and debate patricia rae is head of the department of english at queen's university

hip hop is the largest youth culture in the history of the planet rock this is the first poetry anthology by and for the hip hop generation it has produced generations of artists who have revolutionized their genres by applying the aesthetic innovations of the culture the breakbeat poets features 78 poets born somewhere between 1961-1999 all city and coast to coast who are creating the next and now movements in american letters the breakbeat poets is for people who love hip hop for fans of the culture for people who've never read a poem for people who thought poems were only something done by dead white dudes who got lost in a forest and for poetry heads this anthology is meant to expand the idea of who a poet is and what a poem is for the breakbeat poets are the scribes recording and remixing a fuller spectrum of experience of what it means to be alive in this moment the breakbeat poets are a break with the past and an honoring of the traditions an undeniable body expanding the canon for the fresher

both dylan and cohen have been a presence on the music and poetry landscape spanning six decades this book begins with a discussion of their contemporary importance and how they have sustained their enduring appeal as performers and recording artists the authors argue that both dylan and cohen shared early aspirations that mirrored the beat generation they sought to achieve the fame of dylan thomas who proved a bohemian poet could thrive outside the academy and to live his life of unconditional social irresponsibility while dylan's and cohen's fame fluctuated over the decades it was sustained by self-consciously adopted personas used to distance themselves from their public selves this



separation of self requires an exploration of the artists relation to religion as an avenue to find and preserve inner identity the relationship between their lyrics and poetry is explored in the context of federico garcía lorca s concept of the poetry of inspiration and the emotional depths of duende such ideas draw upon the dislocation of the mind and the liberation of the senses that so struck dylan and cohen when they first read the poetry and letters of arthur rimbaud and lorca the authors show that performance and the poetry are integral and the duende or passion of the delivery is inseparable from the lyric or poetry and common to dylan cohen and the beat generation

in the affluent los feliz enclave of los angeles five wealthy seniors recall vivid memories of ancestors after claire a young massage therapist uses her grandmother s specially blended amazonian aromatherapy oil the seniors live in caregivers each with a rich history are inevitably caught up in the drama as the past collides with the present

organized around the idea of crisis and adversity be it personal social or categorical the contributors to pop when the world falls apart showcase the range of ways that pop music studies has responded to the social political and cultural shifts that are reshaping the world today

this interdisciplinary and creative study examines how african american culture is presented in american films and other media and is a provocative re reading of the historiography of black culture the author examines and interprets a number of cultural texts deriving memory as interpreted by freud and by franz fanon mixed with black liberation theology and islamic mysticism
