the colony called santo domingo which became the dominican republic was the violent crucible in which the ingredients of the new world drawn from america europe and africa were fused together for the first time humans religions technologies animals plants and learned behaviors the history of the dominican republic diverged from the patterns established by the rest of latin america as it ultimately gained independence not from spain but from haiti and spain later recolonized the country during a watershed period in the 1860s in the 20th century the united states occupied the dominican republic on two formative occasions from 1916 to 1924 and again in 1965 1966 interventions detailed in this volume at every turn the backdrop to this pattern of shaky sovereignty has been the extreme instability of dominican politics which has been punctuated by incessant civil wars coups and periods of dictatorship until the last few decades the historical dictionary of the dominican republic contains a chronology an introduction appendixes and an extensive bibliography the dictionary section has over 500 cross referenced entries on important personalities politics economy foreign relations religion and culture this book is an excellent access point for students researchers and anyone wanting to know more about the dominican republic

2023 honorable mention isis duarte book prize haiti dominican republic section lasa after revolutionary cooperation between dominican and haitian majorities produced independence across hispaniola dominican elites crafted negative myths about this era that contributed to anti haitianism despite the island's long simmering tensions dominicans and haitians once unified hispaniola based on research from over two dozen archives in multiple countries siblings of soil presents the overlooked history of their shared imperial endings and national beginnings from the 1780s to 1822 haitian revolutionaries both inspired and aided dominican antislavery and anti imperial movements ultimately santo domingo's independence from spain came in 1822 through unification with haiti as dominicans embraced citizenship and emancipation their collaboration resulted in one of the most unique and inclusive forms of independence in the americas elite reactions to this era formed anti haitian narratives racial ideas permeated the revolution vodou catholicism secularism and even deism some dominicans reinforced hispanic and catholic traditions and cast haitians as violent heretics who had invaded dominican society undermining the

innovative multicultural state two centuries later distortions of their shared past of kinship have enabled generations of anti haitian policies assumptions of irreconcilable differences and human rights abuses

despite its significance in the history of spanish colonialism the dominican republic is familiar to most outsiders through only a few elements of its past and culture non dominicans may be aware that the country shares the island of hispaniola with haiti and that it is where christopher columbus chose to build a colony some may know that the country produces talented baseball players and musicians others that it is a prime destination for beach vacations little else about the dominican republic is common knowledge outside its borders this reader seeks to change that it provides an introduction to the history politics and culture of the country from precolonial times into the early twenty first century among the volume s 118 selections are essays speeches journalism songs poems legal documents testimonials and short stories as well as several interviews conducted especially for this reader many of the selections have been translated into english for the first time all of them are preceded by brief introductions written by the editors the volume s eighty five illustrations ten of which appear in color include maps paintings and photos of architecture statues famous figures and dominicans going about their everyday lives

reinterpreting the haitian revolution as both an islandwide and a circum caribbean phenomenon graham nessler examines the intertwined histories of saint domingue the french colony that became haiti and santo domingo the spanish colony that became the dominican republic tracing conflicts over the terms and boundaries of territory liberty and citizenship that transpired in the two colonies that shared one island nessler argues that the territories borders and governance were often unclear and mutually influential during a tumultuous period that witnessed emancipation in saint domingue and reenslavement in santo domingo nessler aligns the better known history of the french side with a full investigation and interpretation of events on the spanish side articulating the importance of santo domingo in the conflicts that reshaped the political terrain of the atlantic world nessler also analyzes the strategies employed by those claimed as slaves in both colonies to gain liberty and equal citizenship in doing so he reveals what was at stake for slaves and free nonwhites in their uses of colonial legal systems and how their understanding of legal matters affected the colonies relationships with each other and with the french and spanish metropoles

composici<sup>n</sup> social dominicana social composition of the dominican republic first published in 1970 in spanish and translated into english here for the first time discusses the changing structure of social classes and groups in dominican society from the first encounter between europeans and natives until the mid twentieth century this influential and pioneering book details the struggles of the dominican people as they evolved from pre colonial and colonial subjects to sovereign actors with the task of moving a republic forward amidst imperialist desires and martial ambitions juan bosch one of the most well known and best loved dominican politicians and scholars here sets out the important themes that define modern dominican society he tackles topics such as the inter imperialist rivalry between france spain england and holland and its subsequent impact on the caribbean region as well as the u s occupation of the dominican republic from 1916 1924 he also discusses the aftermath of political alliances between liberals and conservatives during the birth of the dominican republic the restoration war fought against the spanish crown the role of the petit bourgeoisie and the hateros cattle ranchers in the formation of a dominican oligarchy the emergence of dictator rafael trujillo and the composition of society during his time in power this translation introduced and contextualized by leading dominican studies scholar wilfredo lozano opens up bosch s work for a new generation of scholars studying the caribbean

american studies association winner 2019 barbara christian literary award given by the caribbean studies association highlights the histories and cultural expressions of the dominican people using a blend of historical and literary analysis colonial phantoms reveals how western discourses have ghosted miscategorized or erased the dominican republic since the nineteenth century despite its central place in the architecture of the americas through a variety of dominican cultural texts from literature to public monuments to musical performance it illuminates the dominican quest for legibility and resistance dixa ramirez places the dominican people and dominican expressive culture and history at the forefront of an insightful investigation of colonial modernity across the americas and the african diaspora in the process she untangles the forms of free black subjectivity that developed on the island from the nineteenth century national dominican poet salomó ureña to the diasporic writings of julia alvarez chiqui vicioso and junot díaz ramirez considers the roles that migration knowledge production and international divisions of labor have played in the changing cultural expression of dominican identity in doing so colonial phantoms demonstrates how the centrality of gender race and class in the nationalisms and imperialisms of the west have profoundly impacted the lives of dominicans ultimately ramirez considers how the dominican people negotiate being left out of western imaginaries and the new modes of resistance they have carefully crafted in response

commanding a vast historiography of slavery and emancipation aline helg reveals as never before how significant numbers of enslaved africans across the entire western hemisphere managed to

free themselves hundreds of years before the formation of white run abolitionist movements her sweeping view of resistance and struggle covers more than three centuries from early colonization to the american and haitian revolutions spanish american independence and abolition in the british caribbean helg not only underscores the agency of those who managed to become free people of color before abolitionism took hold but also assesses in detail the specific strategies they created and utilized while recognizing the powerful forces supporting slavery helg articulates four primary liberation strategies flight and marronage manumission by legal document military service for men in exchange for promised emancipation and revolt along with a willingness to exploit any weakness in the domination system helg looks at such actions at both individual and community levels and in the context of national and international political movements bringing together the broad currents of liberal abolitionism with an original analysis of forms of manumission and marronage slave no more deepens our understanding of how enslaved men women and even children contributed to the slow demise of slavery

the definitive biography of the haitian revolutionary toussaint louverture leader of the only successful slave revolt in world history toussaint louverture s life was one of hardship triumph and contradiction born into bondage in saint domingue present day haiti the richest colony in the western hemisphere he witnessed first hand the torture of the enslaved population yet he managed to secure his freedom and establish himself as a small scale planter he even purchased slaves of his own in toussaint louverture philippe girard reveals the dramatic story of how louverture transformed himself from lowly freedman to revolutionary hero in 1791 the unassuming louverture masterminded the only successful slave revolt in history by 1801 he was general and governor of saint domingue and an international statesman who forged treaties with britain france spain and the united states empires that feared the effect his example would have on their slave regimes louverture s ascendancy was short lived however in 1802 he was exiled to france dying soon after as one of the most famous men in the world variously feared and celebrated as the black napoleon as girard shows in life louverture was not an idealist but an ambitious pragmatist he strove not only for abolition and independence but to build saint domingue s economic might and elevate his own social standing he helped free saint domingue s slaves yet immediately restricted their rights in the interests of protecting the island s sugar production he warded off french invasions but embraced the cultural model of the french gentility in death louverture quickly passed into legend his memory inspiring abolitionist black nationalist and anti colonialist movements well into the 20th century deeply researched and bracingly original toussaint louverture is the definitive biography of one of the most influential people of his era or any other
