the correspondence that results from a brief encounter between two women one chinese american and the other chinese highlight the vast differences yet surprising similarities of two separated lives

students played a critical role in the sandinista struggle in nicaragua helping to topple the us backed somoza dictatorship in 1979 one of only two successful social revolutions in cold war latin america debunking misconceptions students of revolution provides new evidence that groups of college and secondary level students were instrumental in fostering a culture of insurrection one in which societal groups from elite housewives to rural laborers came to see armed revolution as not only legitimate but necessary drawing on student archives state and university records and oral histories claudia rueda reveals the tactics by which young activists deployed their age class and gender to craft a heroic identity that justified their political participation and to help build cross class movements that eventually paralyzed the country despite living under a dictatorship that sharply curtailed expression these students gained status as future national leaders helping to sanctify their right to protest and generating widespread outrage while they endured the regime s repression students of revolution thus highlights the aggressive young dissenters who became the vanguard of the opposition

during the 1920s the soviet union made a determined effort to stimulate revolution in china sending several scores of military and political advisers there as

well as arms and money to influence political developments the usual secrecy surrounding soviet foreign intervention was broken when the chinese government seized a mass of documents in a raid on the soviet military headquarters in peking in 1927 missionaries of revolution weaves together information gleaned from these documents with contemporary historical materials

student politics in communist poland tackles the topic of student political activity under a communist regime during the cold war it discusses both the communist student organizations as well as oppositional independent and apolitical student activism during the forty five year period of poland s existence as a soviet satellite state the book focuses on consecutive generations of students who felt compelled to act on behalf of their milieu or for what they saw as the greater national good the dynamics between moderates and radicals between conformists and non conformists are analyzed from the points of view of the protagonists themselves the book traces ideological evolutions but also counter cultural trends and transnational influences in poland s student community as they emerged developed and disappeared over more than four decades it elaborates on the importance of the catholic church and its role in politicizing students the regime s higher education policies are discussed in relation to its attempts to control the student body which in effect constituted an ever growing group of young people who were destined to become the regime s future elite in the political economic social and cultural spheres and thus provide it with the necessary legitimacy for its survival the pivotal crises in the history of communist poland those of 1956 1968 1980 1981 are treated with a special

emphasis on the students and their respective role in these upheavals the book shows that student activism played its part in the political trajectory of the country at times challenging the legitimacy of the regime and contributed in no small degree to the demise of communism in poland in 1989 student politics in communist poland not only presents a chronological narrative of student activism but it sheds light on lesser known aspects of modern polish history while telling part of the life stories of prominent figures in poland s communist establishment as well as its dissident and opposition milieu ultimately it also provides insights into modern day poland and its elite many of whose members laid the groundwork for their later careers as student activists during the communist period

the cold war in latin america spawned numerous authoritarian and military regimes in response to the ostensible threat of communism in the western hemisphere and with that a rigid national security doctrine was exported to latin america by the united states between 1964 and 1985 argentina chile mexico brazil paraguay and uruguay experienced a period of state sponsored terrorism commonly referred to as the dirty wars thousands of leftists students intellectuals workers peasants labor leaders and innocent civilians were harassed arrested tortured raped murdered or disappeared many studies have been done about this phenomenon in the other areas of latin america but strangely mexico s dirty war has been excluded from this particular scholarship here for the first time is a sustained look at this period and consideration of the many facets that make up the nearly two decades of the mexican dirty war offering the reader a broad perspective of the period the case studies in the book present narratives of particular armed revolutionary movements as well as thematic essays on gender human rights culture student radicalism the cold war and the international impact of this state sponsored terrorism

movement to the point where it can carry out the mass noncooperation that opens a power vacuum earlier democratic organizing structures growing as the strategy unfolds can then fill the vacuum this stage prevents a relapse into the old oppression and defends the new society against counterrevolutionary forces although focused on how each society can realize its own revolution this book acknowledges the context of global power and proposes a vision for transformed world institutions that are on the side of peace and justice the principles in the book have particular application in the climate crisis humanity now faces which is why the book describes a living revolution

when the chinese great proletarian cultural revolution gpcr of the middle and late 1960s burst forth the initial response both in china and the west seemed primarily to be one of mystification the spectacle of severe splits among leaders long thought to be compatible of armed struggles between factional units whose uniform pledges to chairman mao and the party center appeared to make their similarities greater than their differences and of destructive red guards who were bent on tearing down the old world to build a new one was at first difficult to explain
