leon krier is one of the best known and most provocative architects and urban theoreticians in the world until now however his ideas have circulated mostly among a professional audience of architects city planners and academics in the architecture of community krier has reconsidered and expanded writing from his 1998 book architecture choice or fate here he refines and updates his thinking on the making of sustainable humane and attractive villages towns and cities the book includes drawings diagrams and photographs of his built works which have not been widely seen until now with three new chapters the architecture of community provides a contemporary road map for designing or completing today s fragmented communities illustrated throughout with krier s original drawings the architecture of community explains his theories on classical and vernacular urbanism and architecture while providing practical design guidelines for creating livable towns the book contains descriptions and images of the author s built and unbuilt projects including the krier house and tower in seaside florida as well as the town of poundbury in england commissioned by the prince of wales in 1988 krier s design for poundbury in dorset has become a reference model for ecological planning and building that can meet contemporary needs

architects and artists have always acknowledged over the centuries that rome is rightly called the eternal city rome is eternal above all because it was always young always in its prime here the buildings that defined the west appeared over more than 2000 years here the history of european architecture was written the foundations were laid even in ancient roman times when the first attempts were made to design interiors and thus make space open to experience as something physical and at that time the roman architects also started to develop building types that are still valid today thus creating the cornerstone of later western architecture in it rome s primacy remained unbroken whether it was with old st peter s as the first medieval basilica or new st peter s as the building in which bramante and michelangelo developed the high renaissance or with works by bernini and borromini whose rich and lucid spatial forms were to shape baroque as far as vienna bohemia and lower franconia and also with modern buildings of which there are many unexpected pearls to be found in rome all this is comprehensible only if it is presented historically i e in chronological sequence and so the guide has not been arranged topographically as usual but chronologically this means that one is not led in random sequence from a baroque building to an ancient or a modern one but the historical development is followed successively every epoch is preceded by an introduction that identifies its key features this produces a continuous lavishly illustrated history of the architecture of rome and thus at the same time of the whole of the west practical handling is guaranteed by an alphabetical index and detailed maps whose information does not just immediately illustrate the historical picture but also makes it possible to choose a personal route through history

by locatingthe architecture already hidden within deconstructive discourse wigley opens up more radical possibilities for both architectureand deconstruction

the architecture of survival setting and politics in apocalypse films offers a compelling exploration of how popular films and tv series from the past two decades use architectural spaces to comment on socio political issues the authors harness varied theoretical perspectives to demonstrate how through set design these works suggest

that certain kinds of architecture support human development community and freedom while other kinds separate us from our fellow humans and make democratic politics impossible the clean lines of modernist design serve in films such as contagion and ex machina as a metaphor for the sanitized sterile politics that drive disaster in the walking dead apocalypse survivors favor traditional architectural styles when rebuilding society a choice that symbolically affirms their democratic principles the massive walls and super gentrification as seen in elysium and army of the dead divide humanity with those on one side wielding illegitimate power empty streetscapes intensify loneliness alienation and the destruction of civil norms smart cities offering a blend of high tech surveillance and big data erode social capital and community in her and transcendence the book concludes with a somewhat hopeful glimpse into architecture s potential to mitigate the catastrophic adverse effects of climate change as seen in films like zootopia

this important addition to the literature is the first overall study of the architecture of norman england since sir alfred clapham s english romanesque architecture after the conquest 1934 eric fernie a recognized authority on the subject begins with an overview of the architecture of the period paying special attention to the importance of the architectural evidence for an understanding of the norman conquest the second part the core of the book is an examination of the buildings defined by their function as castles halls and chamber blocks cathedrals abbeys and collegiate churches monastic buildings parish churches and palace chapels the third part is a reference guide to the elements which make up the buildings such as apses passages vaults galleries and decorative features and the fourth offers an account of the processes by which they were planned and constructed this book contains powerful new ideas that will affect the way in which we look at and analyze these buildings

the main complex of the america s stonehenge site in new hampshire is a collection of stone chambers enclosures niches standing stones carved drains basins and astronomical alignments the archaeological community has largely dismissed this seemly eclectic collection of structures as the work of an eccentric farmer named jonathan pattee who built his house on top of the ruins in the 19th century other researchers have sought to compare the chambers and astronomical alignments to stone structures from around the world built by other ancient peoples no one has thought to evaluate the site on its own merits specifically evaluating its architecture architecture can tell you a lot about a culture using this approach the author unravels the mystery surrounding the site this architectural study revealed the site was built in a series of distinct phases each with its own unique style while at the same time incorporating key concepts and ideas from previous phases there is a clear evolution of building skills and cultural ideas that can be followed through the architectural build out of the site because key features and ideas were carried forward from one phase to the next we now know that the site was the work of a single culture over a several thousand year period stone tools and pottery recovered from archaeological excavations at the site confirm that the builders were native americans the idea of native americans building stone structures for ceremonial and spiritual purposes has gained a lot of credibility over the past twenty five years there is mounting evidence that hundreds of ceremonial stone landscapes csl with stone cairns niches enclosures standings stones chambers and astronomical alignments found throughout northeastern united states are part of a broad based native american cultural tradition the america s stonehenge site is one of the most sophisticated and culturally complex of these sacred ceremonial places the second part of this book uses primary source materials like deeds town records court cases and genealogy to reconstruct the history of the pattee family who owned the hill where the site is found from 1739 through 1863 the pattees started out in the 1700s as a prosperous family with a house in north salem village and a 248 acre farm by the 1820s the third generation was reduced to owning 15 acres of the original farm and living in a small house built on top of the ruins of the site despite his many financial misfortunes jonathan pattee third generation managed to hold on to and protect the site

what is the place of architecture in the history of art why has it been at times central to the discipline and at other times seemingly so marginal what is its place now many disciplines have a stake in the history of architecture sociology anthropology human geography to name a few this book deals with perhaps the most influential tradition of all art history examining how the relation between the disciplines of art history and architectural history has waxed and waned over the last one hundred and fifty years in this highly original study mark crinson and richard j williams point to a decline in the importance attributed to the role of architecture in art history over the last century which has happened without crisis or self reflection the book explores the problem in relation to key art historical approaches from formalism to feminism to the social history of art and in key institutions from the museum of modern art to the journal october among the key thinkers explored are banham baxandall giedion panofsky pevsner pollock riegl rowe steinberg wittkower and wölfflin the book will provoke debate on the historiography and present state of the discipline of art history and it makes a powerful case for the reconsideration of architecture

adedayo jeremiah adeyekun is a nigerian author architect artist urban planner educator and a preacher of the word of god he is the son of mr pius oladele adeyekun a registered contractor and mrs victoria folayemi adeyekun a retired teacher in a government school in lagos he was inspired by his father to study architecture not because he was talented in art but because of his friend who is an architect he was encouraged by the practice of the profession of his friend arc abiodun christopher akinrimisi 47 years experienced fellow of the nigerian institute of architects and one of nigeria s pioneer architect with arcon no f 195 a forefront of nigerian architecture having designed some of the most prestigious buildings in nigeria 1973 2020 adedayo was an apprentice with architect a c akinrimisi for 10 months in 2007 and said his master told him to follow instructions and be patient in learning otherwise you can t work here he said his master was always complaining about spaces and said waste spaces in design will require more materials hence all spaces in design must have a compulsory use the architecture of adedayo jeremiah adeyekun comprises of his autobiography and different types of buildings including mass housing hotel hostels offices and mixed used development stadium sport centres schools institutional building hospital health centres in nigeria and india adedayo is trying to create contextual relevant modern architectural idiom that will be suitable for nigeria this book is a collection of 254 drawings in 60 selected projects 102 displayed pictures of buildings and live construction projects 30 architectural models sketches and 125 pictures for autobiography adedayo designed about 122 buildings of which 47 have been constructed in nigeria and india more than 20 buildings already constructed in india making him the only nigerian architect whoever practiced in india with a good knowledge of indian architectural style

in the aftermath of world war ii the united states experienced a rapid expansion of church and synagogue construction as part of a larger religious boom the synagogues built in that era illustrate how their designs pushed the envelope in aesthetics and construction the design of the synagogues departed from traditional concepts embraced modernism and innovations in building technology and evolved beyond the formal rational style of early 1950s modern architecture to more of an expressionistic design the latter resulted in abstraction of architectural forms and details and the inclusion of jewish art in the new synagogues the architecture of modern american synagogues 1950s 1960s introduces an architectural analysis of selected modern american synagogues and reveals how they express american jewry s resilience in continuing their physical and spiritual identity while embracing modernism american values and landscape in addition the book contributes to the discourse on preserving the recent past e g mid 20th century architecture while most of the investigations on that topic deal with the brick mortar challenges this book introduces preservation issues as a function of changes in demographics in faith rituals in building codes and in energy conservation as an introduction or a reexamination the architecture of modern american synagogues 1950s 1960s offers a fresh perspective on an important moment in american jewish society and culture as reflected in their houses of worship and adds to the literature on modern american sacred architecture the book may appeal to jewish congregations architects preservationists scholars and students in fields of studies such as architectural design sacred architecture american modern architecture and building technology post wwii religious and jewish studies and preservation and conservation

maxwell fry and jane drew were pioneers of modern architecture in britain and its former colonies from the late 1920s through to the early 1970s as a barometer of twentieth century architecture their work traces the major cultural developments of that century from the development of modernism its spread into the late colonial arena and finally to its re evaluation that resulted in a more expressive formalist approach in the post war era this book thoroughly examines fry and drew s highly influential tropical architecture in west africa and india whilst also discussing their british work such as their post world war ii projects for the festival of britain harlow new town pilkington brothers headquarters and coychurch crematorium it highlights the collaborative nature of fry and drew s work including schemes undertaken with elizabeth denby walter gropius denys lasdun pierre jeanneret and le corbusier positioning their architecture writing and educational endeavours within a wider context this book illustrates the significant artistic and cultural contributions made by fry and drew throughout their lengthy careers

the kariye camii remains one of the most important and best known monuments of the

byzantine world rebuilt and decorated in the early 14th century by statesman scholar theodore metochites the monument played a key role in the development of late byzantine art ousterhout presents a structural history and architectural analysis of this building

the architecture of ruins designs on the past present and future identifies an alternative and significant history of architecture from the sixteenth century to the twenty first century in which a building is designed occupied and imagined as a ruin this design practice conceives a monument and a ruin as creative interdependent and simultaneous themes within a single building dialectic addressing temporal and environmental questions in poetic psychological and practical terms and stimulating questions of personal and national identity nature and culture weather and climate permanence and impermanence and life and death conceiving a building as a dialogue between a monument and a ruin intensifies the already blurred relations between the unfinished and the ruined and envisages the past the present and the future in a single architecture structured around a collection of biographies this book conceives a monument and a ruin as metaphors for a life and means to negotiate between a self and a society emphasising the interconnections between designers and the particular ways in which later architects learned from earlier ones the chapters investigate an evolving interdisciplinary design practice to show the relevance of historical understanding to design like a history a design is a reinterpretation of the past that is meaningful to the present equally a design is equivalent to a fiction convincing users to suspend disbelief we expect a history or a novel to be written in words but they can also be delineated in drawing cast in concrete or seeded in soil the architect is a physical novelist as well as a physical historian like building sites ruins are full of potential in revealing not only what is lost but also what is incomplete a ruin suggests the future as well as the past as a stimulus to the imagination a ruin s incomplete and broken forms expand architecture s allegorical and metaphorical capacity indicating that a building can remain unfinished literally and in the imagination focusing attention on the creativity of users as well as architects emphasising the symbiotic relations between nature and culture a building designed occupied and imagined as a ruin acknowledges the coproduction of multiple authors whether human non human or atmospheric and is an appropriate model for architecture in an era of increasing climate change
