robert b brack knew from an early age that his grandfather and father hoped he would join barker steel co the business started by his grandfather in 1920 after graduating from college in 1960 with a degree in civil engineering he went to work at the family business but after a few years he left to pursue his dream of teaching math and science hed return to a more challenging role at the company about a year later at the time the firm had one location and was barely profitable with less than 1 million in sales and twenty eight employees by the time this story ends in 2007 however barker steel was one of the largest independent rebar fabricators in north america with twelve locations throughout new england new york new jersey and pennsylvania generating in some years more than 200 million in sales and employing more than five hundred people learn valuable business lessons gleaned through four generations of a closely held family business and discover how brack his family and their teams built a successful and respected company in with gratitude

roger is a retired professor of history once famous and admired as an academic star and a lifelong advocate for the rights of women he has grown fat and self indulgent

and is currently living in exile in provence a very public scandal of betrayal precipitated his fall from grace his only hope of restoring his reputation is a memoir or preferably a detached biography he convinces his oldest friend clive another retired academic to write it roger s personal reflections take us back to the 1960s where we learn of a life devoted compulsively to sexual adventure with countless women mostly young feminists drawn to this charismatic man of principle fighting their cause clive is inclined to ignore these escapades he is to write a professional biography not indulge in prurient gossip but when he discovers that roger s adventures bring betrayal into his own family he cannot separate the personal from the political lives are shattered as truths are revealed tony garnett was born in birmingham england and attended university in london where he has been ever since with the exception of a few years spent working in the motion picture industry in hollywood now retired after a career as a prolific screenwriter his work in the movies and at the bbc has taken him all over the uk and to many other countries as well although still residing in london he remains close to his family in birmingham and closely follows his boyhood soccer team aston villa free love is his third novel publisher s website sbpra com tonygarnett

from the unfaithful husband to the binge eater from the secret cross dresser to the pilferer of worthless items there are those who seem to live two lives to be divided selves to be literally of two minds this division or vertical split appears in a person at odds with himself a person who puzzles over and even heartily dislikes that parallel person who behaves in so repugnant a manner in being of two minds arnold goldberg provides trenchant insight into such divided minds their origins their appearances and their treatment goldberg s inquiry into divided minds leads to a return to the psychoanalytic concept of disavowal which forms the basis of the vertical split goldberg explores the developmental circumstances that tend to a reliance on disavowal provides numerous examples of the emergence of disavowal in the treatment situation and considers the therapeutic approaches through which disavowal may be addressed he is especially perceptive in discussing the manner in which the therapist s own tendency to disavow may collusively interact with that of the patient goldberg considers the full range of splits to which disavowal gives rise from circumscribed instances of dissociation to the much debated multiple personality disorders he gives special attention to the role of the vertical split in patients with behavior disorders here his thoughtful insights point to a treatment approach that significantly differs both from the simple ascription of a self disorder and from the usual pedagogical emphasis on issues of self control and or punishment as goldberg shows the repugnance felt by many therapists for offensive behaviors emanating from the patient s parallel self are frequently shared by the patient who commonly despises misbehavior that he is unable to understand being of two minds begins to formulate just such understanding to the great benefit of patient and therapist alike

sam dawson a former army special forces sergeant still dealing with the bitter failure of his last mission a bullet wound to his chest and his wife divorcing him is supposedly hunting big game on a northern new mexico indian reservation sam has gone there to pull the trigger on his empty existence sam s college coed daughter is suspicious of her father s erratic drunken behavior and decides to pay him a surprise visit when she vanishes under mysterious circumstances sam races into action energized with a new purpose at the abduction site after a quick and fruitless search the police stall sam s efforts and seek to blame the local indians but an aged indian native points sam to a mesa topped mountain looming in the distance where his wife

was abducted years ago never seen again together the stubborn efforts of these very different men will unlock the mountain's deep dark secret and sam must save his daughter from a sickening fate and himself from a horrifying cover up in american history

david moore is a middle aged high school science teacher and baseball coach and a fanatical baseball fan his dream to pitch in the major leagues becomes a reality when he suffers a freak accident and develops a miracle pitch david falls in love with the general manager of his team jennifer branch and they both become the targets of the mafia the cubans the italians and the russians how all this is possible becomes the riveting adventures bouncing off each page of miracle pitch dale berne the author throws as many fastballs and curveballs at the reader as david moore does from the pitcher's mound

the first john grey historical mystery the theatres are padlocked christmas has been cancelled it is 1657 and the unloved english republic is eight years old though cromwell's joyless grip on power appears immovable many still look to charles stuart's dissolute and threadbare court in exile and some are prepared to risk their lives plotting a restoration for the officers of the republic constant vigilance is needed so when the bloody corpse of a royalist spy is discovered on the dung heap of a small essex village why is the local magistrate so reluctant to investigate john grey a young lawyer with no clients finds himself alone in believing that the murdered man deserves justice grey is drawn into a vortex of plot and counter plot and into the all encompassing web of intrigue spun by cromwell's own spy master john thurloe so when nothing is what it seems can grey trust anyone tyler juggles his characters story wit and clever one liners with perfect balance the times a cracking pace lively dialogue wickedly witty one liners salted with sophistication why would we not want more of john grey the bookbag

is the novel a category of knowledge that merits serious study even if the novel has shed the stigma of being mindless entertainment one might easily assume that reading a novel is not studying unless one reads closely and carefully preferably from a scholarly edition or for a scholarly purpose novel pedagogy explores how victorian writers envisioned the novel's potential to become knowledge long before the form's ascendance into the ivory tower liwen zhang argues that victorian novelists constant critique of schooling on the one hand and their frequent invocation of deep knowledge on the other are not self contradictory instead of offering a blissful escape from education writers such as william thackeray charles kingsley charles dickens elizabeth gaskell george eliot and george gissing seek to offer uniquely novelistic pathways to knowledge novel pedagogy offers a new model of novelistic epistemology by showing how the novel unlike other educational genres reflects on the unpleasant realities of learning and of not learning amid the ubiquity

terry pickard was born off the record as his cruel father an illiterate dairyman compared his birth to the freshening of a heifer the cruelty he experience at the hand of his father possibly combined with an innate propensity for insanity rendered terry to become a highly intelligent serial killer and mass murder his technique was such that the authorities were never able to get a handle on a way to capture him beginning with the brutal murder of his father in 1973 and continuing for forty three years terry pickard would be responsible for more than one hundred cold blooded slaughters before being stopped in a most unlikely way

roger williams championed liberty of conscience cotton mather promoted acts of kindness and doing good roger williams was born in london but migrated to boston and then to salem plymouth and finally to the town he founded providence rhode island cotton mather was born in boston and never strayed from it both were trained puritan ministers but the young man roger resigned from the ministry saying it was the best callings but generally they are the worst trades in the world instead he made his living trucking with the indians cotton preached at his pulpit at boston s old north church until seven weeks before he passed away they both wrote books especially cotton who wrote over four hundred alike and yet so different the two men were thinkers and writers in america s early religious history author william h benson compares and contrasts roger williams and cotton mather in this the first of six volumes of the parallel lives of the noble american religious thinkers vs believers

additional volumes will include thomas paine and george whitefield ralph waldo emerson and joseph smith william james and mary baker eddy mark twain and billy graham and h l menoken and jim bakker
