many of the books listed in this work are military classics that is books of recognized value that set a standard of historical or literary excellence others evaluate or expand on the military classics focused mainly on the history of land warfare this bibliography begins with a general section the books listed cover more than one chronological period or topical area or are broad surveys of military history or concentrate on a unique subject the next sections are arranged chronologically beginning with ancient history and concluding with the nuclear age covered here are significant historical eras military writers and conflicts the modern warfare section encompasses lowintensity conflict the remaining sections in the bibliography are topical and include the moral effect of combat men in battle russian and soviet military history east asian military history sea power air power and the press the novels cited in this work provide an approach to the human elements of war are often enjoyable to read and are thought provoking the books listed in this bibliography should be read for professional development historical perspective information and pleasure they offer officers and students of military history an opportunity to understand better the nature of war

written between 500 bce and 700 ce these seven texts have inspired generals for millennia both in china and the wider world featuring sun tzu s the art of war this new translation brings to light the military masterpieces of ancient china these seven texts display an understanding of strategy and warfare still relevant more than 2 000 years after they were originally written together they present a uniquely eastern tradition of warfare that emphasizes speed stealth and cunning this collection includes the art of war wuzi wei liaozhi taigong s six secret teachings the methods of the sima questions and replies between emperor taizong of tang and general li jing

as east asia regains its historical position as a world centre information on the history of regional relations becomes ever more critical astonishingly northeast asia enjoyed five centuries of international peace from 1400 to 1894 broken only by one major international war the invasion of korea in the 1590s by japan s ruler hideyoshi this war involved koreans japanese chinese southeast asians and europeans it saw the largest overseas landing in world history up to that time and devastated korea it also highlighted the nature of the strategic balance in the region presenting china s ming dynasty with a serious threat that perhaps foreshadowed the dynasty s subsequent overthrow by the manchus played a major part in the establishment of the tokugawa regime with its policy of peace and controlled access to seventeenth and eighteenth century japan and demonstrated the importance for regional stability of the subtle relationship of korea to both china and japan this book presents a comprehensive analysis of the war and its aftermath in all its aspects military political social economic and cultural as such it deepens understanding of east asian international relations and provides important insights into the strategic concerns that continue to operate in the region at present

a major new revisionist history of the reception of the most important chinese work on strategy the art of war in the west peter lorge contends that the western interpretation of sun tzu s ideas was not based upon chinese understandings of the text but upon twentieth century western strategic ideas

classic war insights masterfully bridges ancient military wisdom with contemporary leadership challenges offering a compelling exploration of timeless strategic principles the book weaves together eastern military philosophy particularly sun tzu s tactical teachings with roman military organizational excellence to demonstrate how classical warfare concepts remain relevant in modern decision making and conflict resolution through a carefully structured approach the book first establishes the historical context of both

eastern and western military traditions examining how different cultural environments shaped strategic thinking the analysis of sun tzu s principles of deception and information gathering coupled with roman military s emphasis on discipline and standardization provides readers with a comprehensive understanding of classical military thought what makes this work particularly valuable is its practical application of these ancient principles to contemporary situations from business strategy to political leadership the book progresses logically through three major sections moving from theoretical foundations to practical applications by incorporating translated primary sources archaeological evidence and modern case studies it demonstrates how fundamental principles of strategy and leadership transcend time the interdisciplinary approach connecting military strategy with psychology and organizational behavior makes this work especially relevant for modern leaders seeking to enhance their strategic thinking and decision making capabilities in any field

this book provides a timely analysis of the politics philosophy and history of chinese power focusing on social strategic and diplomatic trends that have shaped china for over three thousand years chinese elites have used the past to inform the present but have also mobilized new ideas to address the country s rapid transition to global power china s intellectual world can draw on a surprisingly pluralist legacy when chinese thinkers assess power they bring to bear their classical legacy the military classics chinese socialism and western political thought there are also a number of intriguing formulations that give shape to the exercise of chinese power among these are comprehensive national strength stability preservation soft power asymmetric conflict and counter intervention strategies this book looks at key periods in chinese history when attitudes to power evolved and at their current expressions these include china s expanded use of think tanks to chart the future efforts at creating an eco civilization to balance growth and an extended set of security and information capabilities from observing the centrality of power in today s international affairs the book moves to the foundational concepts of chinese governance its belief in a strategic configuration of power as understood in military contexts as well as its growing diplomatic and maritime engagement abroad this analysis culminates in new ideas of functional multipolarity power is also deployed internally china s use of nationalism as a major tool for state building and cohesion the ongoing role of socialism and the people s liberation army are all examined in this light china s current strategic culture has shaped president xi jinping s search for a new model of power for china in the twenty first century an endeavor that will have serious implications for the future global order this book provides an alternative perspective on china s trajectory towards a revised international system

this book offers the first comprehensive analysis of warfare ethics in early china as well as its subsequent development chinese attitudes toward war are rich and nuanced ranging across amoral realism defensive just war humanitarian intervention and mournful skepticism covering the five major intellectual traditions in the golden age of chinese civilization confucian daoist mohist legalist and military strategy schools the book s chapters immerse readers in the proper historical contexts examine the moral concerns in the classical texts on their own terms reframe those concerns in contemporary ethical idioms and forge a critical dialogue between the past and the present the volume develops fresh moral interpretations of classical texts such as the art of war mencius xunzi mozi and the daodejing and discusses famous philosophers such as han fei and wang yang ming representing antithetical schools of thought about warfare attention is also given to the military ethics of the people s liberation army examining its thinking against the backdrop of its own civilizational context this book will be of much interest to students of just war theory

chinese politics ethics and philosophy military studies and international relations in general

chinese military history has emerged as one of the most promising and radical fields of chinese studies china's rapidly increasing military power make understanding the place of war in chinese culture as well as the role of the military and chinese strategic thought vital to dealing with this possible threat the recent flourishing of scholarship in this area has begun to allow an equivalent comparison with western and world military history leading to a new understanding of war as a historical and cultural phenomenon as well as revising earlier analyses of the significance of war in chinese history assembled in this volume is a selection of articles that present earlier approaches to chinese military history as well as the most recent trends in research the introductory essay provides an overview of the field of chinese military history and its significance in the study of china as well as pointing out encouraging new developments in recent scholarship

cultural realism is an in depth study of premodern chinese strategic thought that has important implications for contemporary international relations theory in applying a western theoretical debate to china iain johnston advances rigorous procedures for testing for the existence and influence of strategic culture johnston sets out to answer two empirical questions is there a substantively consistent and temporally persistent chinese strategic culture if so to what extent has it influenced china's approaches to security the focus of his study is the ming dynasty's grand strategy against the mongols 1368 1644 first johnston examines ancient military texts as sources of chinese strategic culture using cognitive mapping symbolic analysis and congruence tests to determine whether there is a consistent grand strategic preference ranking across texts that constitutes a single strategic culture then he applies similar techniques to determine the effect of the strategic culture on the strategic preferences of the ming decision makers finally he assesses the effect of these preferences on ming policies towards the mongol threat the findings of this book challenge dominant interpretations of traditional chinese strategic thought they suggest also that the roots of realpolitik are ideational and not predominantly structural the results lead to the surprising conclusion that there may be in fact fewer cross national differences in strategic culture than proponents of the strategic culture approach think

waging war conflict culture and innovation in world history provides a wide ranging examination of war in human history from the beginning of the species until the current rise of the so called islamic state although it covers many societies throughout time the book does not attempt to tell all stories from all places nor does it try to narrate important conflicts instead author wayne e lee describes the emergence of military innovations and systems examining how they were created and then how they moved or affected other societies these innovations are central to most historical narratives including the development of social complexity the rise of the state the role of the steppe horseman the spread of gunpowder the rise of the west the bureaucratization of military institutions the industrial revolution and the rise of firepower strategic bombing and nuclear weapons and the creation of people's war

the occupation of the northern half of the chinese territories in the 1120s brought about a transformation in political communication in the south that had lasting implications for imperial chinese history by the late eleventh century the song court no longer dominated the production of information about itself and its territories song literati gradually consolidated their position as producers users and discussants of court gazettes official records archival compilations dynastic histories military geographies and maps this development altered the relationship between court and literati in political communication for the remainder of the imperial period based on a close reading of reader responses to

official records and derivatives and on a mapping of literati networks the author further proposes that the twelfth century geopolitical crisis resulted in a lasting literati preference for imperial restoration and unified rule hilde de weerdts makes an important intervention in cultural and intellectual history by examining censorship and publicity together in addition she reorients the debate about the social transformation and local turn of imperial chinese elites by treating the formation of localist strategies and empire focused political identities as parallel rather than opposite trends

sun tzu s the art of war is a series of lessons in the applied art of problem solving sun 544 bc 496 bc an experienced general from the warring states period of chinese history saw war as an inevitable problem indeed the ultimate problem confronting the state the art of war summarises his lessons on how to solve the problems raised by conflict the work comprises a series of pithy discussions of the different strategic situations that might arise and the best responses for each in many ways it is a masterclass in the application of critical thinking to practical affairs aspiring generals are advised to appraise the situation according to five separate criteria and to plan accordingly the expert at battle seeks his victory from strategic advantage sun writes so every general must assess their situation from every angle and establish not only the best way to give themselves the strategic advantage but also of preventing the other side from giving itself the advantage throughout the text sun epitomises the qualities of a good problem solver by focusing on the nature of the problem asking productive questions about it and making sound decisions

ford s reading of confucius is both shrewd and instructive with implications for contemporary policymakers a scholarly analysis of chinese history the weekly standard china s prosperity has increased dramatically in the last two decades propelling the nation to a prominent position in the international community yet china s ancient history still informs and shapes its understanding of itself in relation to the world as a highly developed and modern nation china is something of a paradox in the mind of empire china s history and modern foreign relations christopher a ford demonstrates how china s historical awareness shapes its objectives and how the resulting national consciousness continues to influence the country s policymaking despite its increasing prominence among modern developed nations china continues to seek guidance from a past characterized by confucian notions of hierarchical political order and a moral geography that places china at the center of the civilized world the mind of empire describes how these attitudes have clashed with traditional western ideals of sovereignty and international law ford speculates about how china s legacy may continue to shape its foreign relations and offers a warning about the potential global consequences he examines major themes in china s conception of domestic and global political order describes key historical precedents and outlines the remarkable continuity of china s sinocentric stance expertly synthesizing historical philosophical religious and cultural analysis into a cohesive study of the chinese worldview ford offers revealing insights into modern china a much needed and an erudite contextualization this book will benefit immensely those interested in the history and strategic culture of china s foreign policy the china quarterly

the volume science technology imperialism and war interlinks the concerned themes to present a coherent analysis of the development of related ideas and institutions in the subcontinent the chapters on science therefore look at the cognitive and socio historical aspects of science relating the same with the establishment and spread of imperialism in india with its application to develop technologies and with the use of such technologies to fund the major preoccupation of imperialism war likewise the section on technology leads the reader to a search for its very probable links with imperialism and war the section on imperialism offers four themes in the edited volume the first one deals with its theories the

second with its link with colonialism and the third and the fourth follow its manifestation in the russian and british adventures chiefly in central asia and india the depecdence of imperialism on war looms large war the concluding theme of this exercise is the saturation point of himan efforts to subjugate and dominate others the scholars writing in this section critically survey the various kinds of war conventional limited and nuclear and a detailed and insightful analysis of the cold war by the editor completes the picture this volume will prove invaluable to scholars and students of south asian studies history political science and international relations and defence studies alike

although antiquity itself has been intensively researched together with its reception to date this has largely happened in a compartmentalized fashion this series presents for the first time an interdisciplinary contextualization of the productive acquisitions and transformations of the arts and sciences of antiquity in the slow process of the european societies constructing a scientific system and their own cultural identity a process which started in the middle ages and has continued up to the modern age the series is a product of work in the collaborative research centre transformations of antiquity and the august boeckh centre of antiquity at the humboldt university of berlin their individual projects examine transformational processes on three levels in particular the constitutive function of antiquity in the formation of the european knowledge society the role of antiquity in the genesis of modern cultural identities and self constructions and the forms of reception in art literature translation and media

a soldier citizen describes the role of the republic of china s military in the political socialization of taiwan s citizens during the first two decades after the loss of the chinese mainland

in the legality and legitimacy of the use of force in northeast asia brendan howe and boris kondoch bring together distinguished authors with extensive northeast asian backgrounds to offer a diverse and comprehensive evaluation of when it is right from regional perspectives to use force in international relations the use of force in international relations has been severely curtailed by pragmatic considerations of international order and further constrained by positive international law in northeast asia the prohibition of aggression has remained uncontested strict adherence to non intervention in northeast asia has however increasingly come under attack from internal and external normative communities the contributors therefore use regional legal normative cultural and historical insights to shed light on the contemporary positions of northeast asian political communities with regard to the use of force

this is a fascinating insight into china s strategic abilities and ambitions probing the real depths of its plans for the twenty first century china s rising sea power explores similarities between china s strategic outlook today and that of earlier continental powers whose submarine fleets challenged dominant maritime powers for regional hegemony germany in two world wars and the soviet union during the cold war using insights from classical naval strategic theory peter howarth examines beijing s strategic logic in making tactical submarines the keystone of china s naval force structure he also investigates the influence of soviet naval strategy and ancient chinese military thought on the pla navy s strategic culture contending that china s increasingly capable submarine fleet could play a key role in beijing s use of force to resolve the taiwan issue this book will be of great interest to all students and scholars of security and strategic studies asian politics geopolitics and military naval strategy

vanishing into things explores the concept of knowledge in chinese thought over two

millennia from confucius to wang yangming ca 1500 ce and compares the different philosophical imperatives that have driven chinese and western thought challenging the hyperspecialized epistemology of modern philosophy in the west barry allen urges his readers toward an ethical appreciation of why knowledge is worth pursuing western philosophers have long maintained that true knowledge is the best knowledge chinese thinkers by contrast have emphasized not the essence of knowing but the purpose ideas of truth play no part in their understanding of what the best knowledge is knowledge is not deduced from principles or reducible to a theory rather in chinese tradition knowledge is expressed through wu wei literally not doing a response to circumstances that is at once effortless and effective this type of knowledge perceives the evolution of circumstances from an early point when its course can still be changed provided one has the wisdom to grasp the opportunity allen guides readers through the major confucian and daoist thinkers including kongzi mengzi xunzi laozi and zhuangzi examining their influence on medieval neoconfucianism and chan zen buddhism as well as the theme of knowledge in china's art of war literature the sophisticated and consistent concept of knowledge elucidated here will be of relevance to contemporary western and eastern philosophers alike

confucianism has shaped a certain perception of chinese security strategy symbolized by the defensive nonaggressive great wall many believe china is antimilitary and reluctant to use force against its enemies it practices pacifism and refrains from expanding its boundaries even when nationally strong in a path breaking study traversing six centuries of chinese history yuan kang wang resoundingly discredits this notion recasting china as a practitioner of realpolitik and a ruthless purveyor of expansive grand strategies leaders of the song dynasty 960 1279 and ming dynasty 1368 1644 prized military force and shrewdly assessed the capabilities of china's adversaries they adopted defensive strategies when their country was weak and pursued expansive goals such as territorial acquisition enemy destruction and total military victory when their country was strong despite the dominance of an antimilitarist confucian culture warfare was not uncommon in the bulk of chinese history grounding his research in primary chinese sources wang outlines a politics of power that are crucial to understanding china's strategies today especially its policy of peaceful development which he argues the nation has adopted mainly because of its military economic and technological weakness in relation to the united states

it is difficult to overstate the importance of china to the world economy and yet the majority of books either look at chinese business by applying western frameworks or models to the context of china or focus on a particular aspect of business in china authored by an academic expert on china this new completely revised edition of chinese business offers its readers a comprehensive and systematic body of knowledge of chinese business it has taken a holistic perspective intending to achieve a balance between the academic and practical between theory and practice and between traditional and current internet based industry the framework of this book subsumes all the major factors that should be taken into consideration when western companies contemplate a china strategy including history philosophy ancient military classics strategy and marketing innovation internet business and human resources the discussion of these factors is supplemented with insightful case studies chinese business second edition can be used as a textbook for undergraduates and postgraduates at business schools and as a useful reference for researchers senior executives consultants and government officials involved in chinese business

in doing good and ridding evil in ming china the political career of wang yangming george israel offers an account of this influential neo confucian philosopher's official career and military campaigns while his contribution to china's intellectual history and the outlines of his political life are well known the relation between his thought and what he did in his

capacity as a ming official has been given less attention prior writing on wang yangming has passed judgment on his ideas by either idealizing or condemning him for how he treated those he was assigned to govern through a detailed reconstruction of his career in the context of issues of empire ethnicity and violence george israel demonstrates that the truth lies somewhere in the middle

morgan deane a military historian and former marine sustains the authenticity of the book of mormon as an ancient document and shows how text contains a strong and distinctive voice on military matters that should be taken seriously by modern readers and even policy makers and generals through a hugh nibbley like command of ancient societies from mesoamerica china and rome as well as a grasp of military theory from clausewitz to sun tzu he expands upon the Jaredite civil war the face of battle logistics ethno religious conflict the political dimensions of conflict and insurgency and strategy he specifically valorizes captain moroni against a rise in attacks against his character presents a nephite and latter day saint just war theory and shows how the book of mormon defends the use pre emptive war in a world filled with strife and conflict bleached bones and wicked serpents will help the reader understand the context and society in which the nephites lived and died and provide critical tools to evaluate modern military issues ranging from how to understand the threat posed by terrorists to assessing the wisdom of military action
