blocking out turning a blind eye shutting off not wanting to know wearing blinkers seeing what we want to see these are all expressions of denial alcoholics who refuse to recognize their condition people who brush aside suspicions of their partner s infidelity the wife who doesn t notice that her husband is abusing their daughter are supposedly in denial governments deny their responsibility for atrocities and plan them to achieve maximum deniability truth commissions try to overcome the suppression and denial of past horrors bystander nations deny their responsibility to intervene do these phenomena have anything in common when we deny are we aware of what we are doing or is this an unconscious defence mechanism to protect us from unwelcome truths can there be cultures of denial how do organizations like amnesty and oxfam try to overcome the public s apparent indifference to distant suffering and cruelty is denial always so bad or do we need positive illusions to retain our sanity states of denial is the first comprehensive study of both the personal and political ways in which uncomfortable realities are avoided and evaded it ranges from clinical studies of depression to media images of suffering to explanations of the passive bystander and compassion fatigue the book shows how organized atrocities the holocaust and other genocides torture and political massacres are denied by perpetrators and by bystanders those who stand by and do nothing

an astute diagnosis of one of the biggest problems in business denial is the unconscious determination that a certain reality is too terrible to contemplate so therefore it cannot be true we see it everywhere from the alcoholic who swears he s just a social drinker to the president who declares mission accomplished when it isn t in the business world countless companies get stuck in denial while their challenges escalate into crises harvard business school professor richard s tedlow tackles two essential questions why do sane smart leaders often refuse to accept the facts that threaten their companies and careers and how do we find the courage to resist denial when facing new trends changing markets and tough new competitors tedlow looks at numerous examples of organizations crippled by denial including ford in the era of the model t and coca cola with its abortive attempt to change its formula he also explores other companies such as intel johnson johnson and dupont that avoided catastrophe by dealing with harsh realities head on tedlow identifies the leadership skills that are essential to spotting the early signs of denial and taking the actions required to overcome it

genocide denial not only abuses history and insults the victims but paves the way for future atrocities yet few if any books have offered a comparative overview and analysis of this problem denial the final stage of genocide is a resource for understanding and countering denial denial spans a broad geographic and thematic range in its explorations of varied forms of denial which is embedded in each stage of genocide ranging far beyond the most well known cases of denial this book offers original pathbreaking arguments and contributions regarding competition over commemoration and public memory in ukraine and elsewhere transitional justice in post conflict societies global violence against transgender people which genocide scholars have not adequately confronted music as a means to recapture history and combat denial public education s role in erasing indigenous history and promoting settler colonial ideology in the united states triumphalism as a new variant of denial following the bosnian genocide denial vis à vis rwanda and neighboring congo drc with contributions from leading genocide experts as well as emerging scholars this book will be of interest to scholars and students of history genocide studies anthropology political science international law gender studies and human rights

offering a wide variety of philosophical approaches to the neglected philosophical problem of ignorance this collection builds on charles mills s claim that racism involves an inverted epistemology an epistemology of ignorance contributors explore how different forms of ignorance linked to race are produced and sustained and what role they play in promoting racism and white privilege book jacket

successive south african governments have had controversial views on hiv and aids which have led to allegations that south africa is in a state of denial about the aids epidemic this book attempts to determine the validity of such claims of government denial by formulating and testing a denial hypothesis the hypothesis is contextualized with an overview of the south african epidemic as well as a review of allegations of government denial it reveals possible political factors that may motivate policy makers to resort to official denial and tentatively concludes with a confirmation of the allegations contained in the

denial hypothesis however this is done within the broader notion that denial is inherently vague and couched in language rarely in writing and therefore difficult to test with certainty and as such this book s real value lies in the insights gained into the complex politics of denial by exploring the dynamics of denial and denialism and applying this to the south african aids epidemic this study provides a comprehensive analysis

this book deals in different ways with the politics of death with art and politics and with the politics of refuge and asylum cutting across these fields brings to the fore the fluid quality of social life under late capitalism the elements of time space and emotion are part of the overall approach adopted the individual chapters illustrate themes of despair striving and the politics of hope and bring out the fluid and unpredictable qualities of social life the guiding metaphor is fluidity or what urry refers to as waves continuous flow pulsing fluidity and viscosity characteristic of life death refuge and art under the contemporary global system between the worlds of culture political violence and art the interconnected themes in this study illuminate conditions of liminality or in betweenness the study presents a politics of hope under late capitalism and cuts through more usual boundaries between art and science harm and help death and the politics of bare life each chapter grapples with issues that help illustrate wider trends in global development and international relations scholarship and teaching amidst growing cynicism about human or even humanitarian values the volume appeals for a politics of hope and social justice based on the fluid contours of borderless and amorphous processes of self organising and radical anarchy

public apologies have become increasingly common scenes and representative moments in what appears to be a global process of forgiveness the apology forgiveness dynamic is familiar to all of us but what do these rituals of atonement mean when they are applied to political and historical events in his timely topical and incisive book a guilted age ashraf rushdy argues that the proliferation of apologies by politicians nations and churches for past events such as american slavery or the holocaust can be understood as a historical phenomenon in our post world war ii world rushdy claims that we live in a guilted age a guilted age identifies the two major forms of apologies political and historical and rushdy defines the dynamics and strategies of each showing how the evolution of one led to the other in doing so he reveals what apology and forgiveness do to the past events they respectively apologize for and forgive and what happens when they fail

when faced with those who act with impunity we seek the protection of law we rely upon the legal system for justice from international human rights law that establishes common standards of protection to international criminal law that spearheads efforts to end impunity for the most heinous atrocities while legal processes are perceived to combat impunity and despite the ready availability of the law accountability often remains elusive what if the law itself enables impunity law s impunity asks this question in the context of the modern private military company pmc examining the relationship between law and the concepts of responsibility and impunity this book proposes that ordinary legal processes do not neutralise but rather legalise impunity this radical idea is

applied to the abysmal record of human rights violations perpetrated by the modern pmc and the shocking absence of accountability this book demonstrates how the law organises rather than overcomes impunity by detailing how the modern pmc exploits ordinary legal processes to systematically exclude itself from legal responsibility thus law s impunity offers an alternative to conventional thinking about the law providing an innovative approach to assess and refine the rigour of legal processes in the ongoing quest to end impunity

jochen peiper was a colonel in the waffen ss one of the wars more divisive men who was accused and convicted of more than 900 murders yet he walked free after only a few years in prison why this book covers his whole life from his humble beginnings in berlin to his rise to full colonel in the ss and his participation in numerous campaigns in europe and the eastern front the story leads to the war crimes trial held in dachau in 1946 the results of that trial and the use of coercion and dubious interrogation methods leading up to it many guilty men walked free and many innocent men remained in jail others who were clearly guilty and named were never prosecuted at all rules were dismissed and what was supposed to be a shining example of justice became an embarrassing mess if peiper and his men were guilty of the crimes convicted of why were the sentences never carried out thoroughly researched using original archived documents and other material this book sheds new light on an old story

explores the mind s capacity for self deception by telling the story of tony blair and the invasion of iraq and looks at unconscious processes in organisations asking what role the saboteur played in huge corporate failures such as the collapse of barings bank and the boeing 737 max scandal the saboteur also operates on a larger scale governments and societies can be sabotaged by this unconscious force in nazi germany how did normal decent people behave like monsters colluding with or actively participating in the murder of innocent people why did big us corporates like ibm ford and chrysler work with the nazis to make the holocaust possible if you manage a team or lead an organisation you need to understand the role played by the saboteur in your workplace and in your own career and life this book enables leaders and managers to develop their leadership skills by understanding how the unconscious impacts individual group and social processes it will also be of use to coaches and organisational consultants working in the areas of teams and performance

conveniently structured into five sections the routledge research companion to outsourcing security offers an overview of the different ways in which states have come to rely on private contractors to support interventions part one puts into context the evolution of outsourcing in western states that are actively involved in expeditionary operations as well as the rise of the commercial security sector in afghanistan to explain the various theoretical frameworks that students can use to study security military outsourcing part two outlines the theories behind security outsourcing part three examines the law and ethics surrounding the outsourcing of security by focusing on how states might monitor contractor behaviour hold them to account and prosecute them where their behaviour warrants such action the drivers politics and consequences of outsourcing foreign policy are covered in part four which is divided into two sections section one is concerned with armed contractors providing the provision of private security with the main driver being a capability gap on the part of the military law enforcement agencies and section two looks at military contractors supporting military operations right back to antiquity less controversial politically and often technologically driven the final part takes into consideration emerging perspectives exploring areas such as gender feminist methodology maritime security and the impact of private security on the military profession this book will be of much interest to students of military and security studies foreign policy and international relations

human rights refers to the concept of human beings as having universal rights or status regardless of legal jurisdiction and likewise other localising factors such as ethnicity and nationality for many the concept of human rights is based in religious principles however because a formal concept of human rights has not been universally accepted the term has some degree of variance between its use in different local jurisdictions difference in both meaningful substance as well as in protocols for and styles of application ultimately the most general meaning of the term is one which can only apply universally and hence the term human rights is often itself an appeal to such transcended principles without basing such on existing legal concepts the term humanism refers to the developing doctrine of such universally applicable values and it is on the basic concept that human beings have innate rights that more specific

local legal concepts are often based within particular societies human rights refers to standards of behaviour as accepted within their respective legal systems regarding 1 the well being of individuals 2 the freedom and autonomy of individuals and 3 the representation of the human interest in government these rights commonly include the right to life the right to an adequate standard of living the prohibition of genocide freedom from torture and other mistreatment freedom of expression freedom of movement the right to self determination the right to education and the right to participation in cultural and political life these norms are based on the legal and political traditions of united nations member states and are incorporated into international human rights instruments this new book brings together the latest book literature centred on this crucial topic

a number of highly informative books have been written about what is often called the armenian genocide this book written by a political scientist offers a different approach it doesn t concentrate on the past it concentrates on the present and shows how this past event is perceived and discussed today the idea is that the arguments deployed in this debate those which allege that what happened amounts to genocide and those which deny this claim reveal something about cognitive structures of present agents such as the turkish government as well as about the meaning and use of the term genocide analyzing current positions and communication on this historical event thereby helps to illuminate present notions of identity justice and interethnic coexistence
