the contributors in this volume present a systematic survey of the struggles of athens sparta and thebes to dominate greece in the fourth century only to be overwhelmed by the newly emerging macedonian kingdom of philip ii additionally the situation of greeks in sicily italy and asia is portrayed showing the geographical and political diffusion of the greeks in a broader historical context this book will provide the reader with a clearly drawn and vivid picture of the main events and leading personalities in this decisive period of greek history

the history of the federal state of boiotia from the outbreak of the peloponnesian war in 432 bc to the triumph of the states over its enemies in 371 bc is the focus of professor buck s study it is especially interesting because the federation underwent so many changes the interplay of political factions with external enemies and with clashing ideologies makes it useful to study

the joint allied invasion of sicily the first successful attempt to occupy enemy territory and the precursor for both the invasion of

italy and the later normandy campaign

an overview of history in ancient athens beginning with the ill fated sicilian expedition of 413 b c and ends with the surrender of athens to sparta in 404 b c

at the end of the peloponnesian war in 404 bc sparta reigned supreme in greece having vanquished their rival athens and quickly dismantled the wealthy and powerful athenian empire sparta set its sights on dominating the mediterranean world and had begun a successful invasion of the vast persian empire under their legendary king agesilaus ii but with their victory over athens came the inheritance of governing athens s empire and sparta desperately lacked both a cogent vision of empire and the essential economic and trade infrastructure to survive in the role of hegemon sparta s overextension of empire compounded with internal political conflict to antagonize the rest of greece with heavy fisted and uneven interventionism soon the unlikely confederacy of athens corinth thebes argos and persia united against sparta in a war that despite a spartan victory had devastating ramifications for their empire the corinthian war 395 387 bc was a fascinating entanglement of clashing empires complex diplomatic alliances and betrayals and political fissures erupting after centuries of tension situated between the great peloponnesian war and the theban spartan war the corinthian war is often overlooked or understood as an aftershock of the civil war greece had just endured but the corinthian war was instead a seminal conflict that reshaped the greek world illustrating the limits of sparta s newfound imperial experiment as they grappled with their own internal cultural conflicts and charted the rise and fall of their newfound hegemony and the future of greece

a study of the career of the KKK and its appeal in Texas Louisiana Oklahoma and Arkansas in the early twentieth century this is a study of a disturbing phenomenon in American society the Ku Klux Klan and that eruption of nativism racism and moral authoritarianism during the 1920s in the four states of the Southwest Texas Louisiana Oklahoma and Arkansas in which the Klan became especially powerful the Hooded Order is viewed here as a move by frustrated Americans through anonymous acts of terror and violence and later through politics to halt a changing social order and restore familiar orthodox traditions of morality entering the Southwest during the post World War I period of discontent and disillusion the Klan spread rapidly over the region and by 1922 its tens of thousands of members had made it a potent force in politics Charles C. Alexander finds that the Klan in the Southwest however functioned more as vigilantes in meting extra legal punishment to those it deemed moral offenders than as advocates of race and religious prejudice but the vigilante hysteria vanished almost as suddenly as it had appeared opposition to its terrorist excesses and its secret politics led to its decline after 1924 when the Klan failed abysmally in most of its political

efforts especially significant here are the analysis of attitudes which led to this revival of the klan and the close examination of its internal machinations the ku klux klan is not a single phenomenon it is three different organizations which sprang up three different times for three different reasons charles alexander focuses this study and it s a good one on the middle klan the so called invisible empire extending from 1915 to 1944 flourishing in the mid twenties with a membership estimated at 5 million at one time or another dominating to some degree politically every city in the southwest a forthright and definitive account to be read along with david chalmers s recent hooded americanism for the complete national picture kirkus reviews

it seems we have not internalized the lessons of george orwell s dystopian vision in 1984 now forty years later that terrifying notion is becoming a reality win the fictional son of winston smith experiences firsthand the horrors of the totalitarian system a system that takes control of every aspect of daily life with sophisticated and cruel efficiency a system that clutches each of us with a cold claw right now we all live in an illusion of freedom but one that is increasingly curtailed if we are not vigilant we too could be enslaved for good becoming functioning machines in a repressive and inhumane system of control the year 2024 is not dystopian fiction but an urgent warning we must resist the plans of governments and powerful corporations that threaten our freedom while digitization offers incredible opportunities for humanity it also poses dangers it is our duty to ensure that no one intentionally or unintentionally abuses digitization as a modern ankle bracelet an ankle bracelet that forces us onto the benches of a punishment gallery where we have no choice but to row until we drop dead while being monitored seamlessly at every moment under omnipresent surveillance and control it is possible to instantly identify and punish any misconduct or political opinion so the very thought of resisting the system becomes unthinkable it is time to fight together for a just free and democratic future in which digitization does not subjugate us but serves us and supports us in our pursuit of happiness and self realization
