called to remove a bullet from a man shot in a duel he meets the jim of the title on the run from the law and gambling for a living jim brings his spanish wife and child to live with him

the 30 000 bequest and other stories 1906 is a collection of thirty comic short stories by the american writer mark twain the stories contained span the course of his career from advice to young girls in 1865 to the titular tale in 1904 although twain had ample time to refine his short stories between their original publication date and this collection there is little evidence to suggest he took an active interest in doing so

beckford's gothic novel *Vathek* an arabian tale was originally written in french when the author was twenty one published in english in 1786 it was one of the most successful of the oriental tales then in fashion this edition makes available to a new generation of scholars and general readers the originality of beckford's ideas and the excellence of his prose

i guess in truth *reno by the lake* is my autobiography light the material is indeed autobiographical in that little has been gleaned from any outside source and it is definitely light both in serious content and the serious nature often portrayed by an autobiography so read on just for fun *reno beach* was a magical place in the 1920s 30s 40s and 50s a resort town that never really quite reached its prime it had however attained great stature in the hearts and minds of all it entertained especially in the imagination of a young boy who could see adventure even in the smallest buttonhole or banal blemish in his mind a vegetable garden became a wilderness plantation an overturned rowboat became a fortress a pirate's treasure cave or a magician's maudlin mansion a willow tree only recently uprooted by the wind and waves of an angry possessive lake trying desperately to reclaim its own this became the perfect home for tarzan jimie of the apes the fact that i'm even writing this book belies the fact that the place and that little boy still live if only in my imagination the stories you're about to read are about that small waterfront community just east of toledo ohio on the western end of lake erie and how its life death and frequent revitalizations affected the life of one small boy namely me the stories are absolutely true except as altered by an aging memory wishful thinking and delusions of grandeur not necessarily in that order and they represent some of the very best days of my life i've been told that it's good to share your very best i hope you enjoy reading my stories nearly as much as i enjoyed living them the writing's been fun too some names and places may have been altered to protect the innocent and or the guilty but not many some may also be changed just because i've forgotten or don't really know what i'm talking about please forgive me many may recognize themselves a friend or family member in some of these stories and each one probably deserves whatever treatment or attention they received either good or bad this book is intended to be a bathroom book this is not a negative for those unable to grasp this creative terminology i provide the following explanation in the form of a prescription take in small doses continuous exposure could be hazardous to your health and could lead to an abrasive situation requiring an immediate application of preparation h this does not imply that either you the reader or the writer is full of anything should you disapprove of any of the material in this book please feel free to remove the offending pages and put them to better use right there in the reading room solving the problems of the moment i'm sure you understand enjoy life is short don't waste it on seriousness

twelve stories by science fiction master stanisław lem nine of them never before published in english of these twelve short stories by science fiction master stanisław lem only three have previously appeared in english making this the first new book of fiction by lem since the late 1980s the stories display the full range of lem's intense

curiosity about scientific ideas as well as his sardonic approach to human nature presenting as multifarious a collection of mad scientists as any reader could wish for many of these stories feature artificial intelligences or artificial life forms long a lem preoccupation some feature quite insane theories of cosmology or evolution all are thought provoking and scathingly funny written from 1956 to 1993 the stories are arranged in chronological order in the title story the truth a scientist in an insane asylum theorizes that the sun is alive the journal appears to be an account by an omnipotent being describing the creation of infinite universes until in a classic lem twist it turns out to be no such thing in an enigma beings debate whether offspring can be created without advanced degrees and design templates other stories feature a computer that can predict the future by 137 seconds matter destroying spores a hunt in which the prey is a robot and an electronic brain eager to go on the lam these stories are peak lem exploring ideas and themes that resonate throughout his writing

the wax statue and other stories is a translated version of the short stories written by jeelani bano she is one of the most reputed literary figures in sawnet known for her supremacy in exposing the flaws of society before the readers jeelani bano keeps the pedal to the metal her stories are a mirror of the society of those days which are relevant even today her stories like moun ki maryam won great acclaim by the readers and literary men of that age in her stories she explores the diaspora feelings and the exploitation of the poor she is a critic of social evils her vim and vigour portrays the misery and suffering of women in a male dominated society her stories are solely objective she is never didactic in her tone and allows the readers to judge her approach is multidimensional and not a storm in a tea cup hence their translation into english will spread her message far and wide and serve the purpose of her writings my aim in translating her short stories into english is to convey the message to the non urdu readers and to enliven her literary talent in other languages

the folk tales collected by the brothers jacob and wilhelm grimm were first published in 1812 15 and in many more editions up to the deaths of the brothers around 1860 while no one knows where the tales first came from features of many are found in myths from all over the world they were passed on for centuries in the oral tradition until at last collectors began recording them in print for the world of today where we still respond to them this volume contains a small but representative selection from the grimms children s and household tales the most famous and influential of all the great nineteenth century folklore collections

courtship a strange secret the marvellous doctor the witches of traquair sheep prayers odd characters nancy chisholm snow storms the shepherd s dog the expedition to hell the mysterious bride the wool gatherer the hunt of eildon james hogg 1770 1835 was a scottish poet novelist and essayist who wrote in both scots and english as a young man he worked as a shepherd and farmhand and was largely self educated through reading he was a friend of many of the great writers of his day including sir walter scott of whom he later wrote an unauthorized biography

turning her back on what is considered conventional makhosazana xaba engages with her subject matter on a revolutionary level in running and other stories she takes tradition be that literary tradition cultural tradition gender tradition and re imagines it in a way that is liberating and innovative bracketed by xabas revisitings of can thembas influential short story the suit the ten stories in this collection while strongly independent are in conversation with one another resulting in a collection that can be devoured all at once or savoured slowly story by story by re envisioning the ordinary and accepted xaba is creating a space in which womens voices are given a rebirth

this collection of short stories explores the survival of the fittest in the hardship and poverty of a remote village in matabeleland bongani sibanda draws his characters and their situations with a sardonic eye and caustic humour sibanda satirises churches which enrich their leaders with the tithes of the poor and draws our attention to self proclaimed pastors who use the gospel of nationalism and patriotism to persuade their congregants to desist from supporting opposition politics the church is also a source of the villagers weekly entertainment with its cleansing ceremonies and the interrogation of witches belief has a place but so too does theatre patriarchy family hierarchies and the traditional position of women and children all fall under sibanda s wry but compassionate scrutiny we feel an intimacy with the villagers as we learn about how they cope with no self pity little ambition but a fierce determination to survive

during the fifteen years glenda baker was the publisher and editor in chief of newn she read and critiqued hundreds of short stories she also wrote many of her own this volume contains twenty two of glendas stories from short 21 000 words to short short about 1 000 words to flash fiction 52 words total in which glenda addresses subjects such as after doing a favor for his boss how does a man end up in a maze he cant find his way out of what would happen if a contemporary kid created a golem what secrets do three generations of women learn about each other while on a weekend trip to cape cod how far will a passive aggressive woman go if pushed to the limit

a star above it and other stories is volume 1 of a collection of chad oliver s sf containing the following blood s a rover the land of lost content the ant and the eye artifact any more at home like you rewrite man the edge of forever the boy next door a star above it the mother of necessity night technical advisor between the thunder and the

sun the one that got away transfusion guardian spirit the gift to whom it may concern a stick for harry eddington old four eyes

open any door of a house along a dead end street on santa barbara s west side and you ll find lives full of desire rage loss joy and chaos this collection tells their stories including the opera singer who practices more than her afternoon scales the boyhood friends who build a bridge between trees that brings tragedy and triumph the japanese wife who struggles to raise a mentally disabled child at a time when they were shunned and labeled a black couple who try to find a better neighborhood a stressed out lawyer riding his own personal midnight tornado the cabinetmaker trying to reach out to a neglected boy and four young men driving without lights into their uncertain futures these 17 tales are written from the points of view of the young and old the moral and questionable from white bread americans and people of color these are glimpses into lives both compelling and revealing

critics call it controversial twisted and just plain messed up brain parasites an insane planet ruled by retarded monkeys violent video games turning teens into something else and a bio weapon that will make you lose your appetite for a little while it s all here read it now you know you want to stories from the theater of science fiction

peter bayer was seventy three he d taught at the school just up the road for most of his life and when the wall came down saw no reason to move nobody could say life had been easy and when it was built he d lost contact with many friends but he d learnt to enjoy life as best he could and had had the good fortune of a happy marriage to elsa it s 2006 peter bayer and his wife elsa live on the east side of berlin as they ve always done even when that wasn t an attractive proposition what limits peter s freedom nowadays isn t a concrete wall but often feels like one elsa has dementia and barely recognises him so his life is not only hard work but it s lonely what makes it lonelier is that his wife s illness has given her a distorted view of the past and one that would horrify the woman he married when helen a recently widowed english woman rents the flat peter owns nearby he experiences the kinds of conversations that used to be normal for him which makes his current reality all the more painful helen s come to berlin to find out more about her husband s past in the city and learns things from their german friends that she was unaware of when he was alive during her struggle to come to terms with her present life helen sees that the terrible demands on peter s life are almost impossible to endure other stories in the book show the toll of war as fear is passed from one generation to another and we see how the power of secrecy never disappears they also reveal how gratitude can take various forms and how intergenerational friendships really are all they re cracked up to be the writing on the wall and other stories is a collection of tales spanning the 1980s to the present day that will appeal to fans of anne tyler alan bennett and alice munro whom penny edwards takes inspiration from
