centered on practices of the body human bodies the body politic bodies and disciplines considers a fascinating and largely uncanonical group of texts as well as public dramas rituals and spectacles from multidisciplinary perspectives the result is a volume that incorporates insights from history literature medieval studies and critical theory drawing from the strengths of each discipline to illuminate a relatively little studied period

theories of consumption explores the concept of consumption from the post disciplinary perspective of cultural studies john storey brings together work that up until now has been located in distinct disciplinary spaces including work on reception theory in literary studies and philosophy work on consumer culture in sociology anthropology and history and work on media audiences both ethnographic and theoretical in media studies and sociology moving beyond the usual analysis of consumer culture storey presents a critical assessment of a range of theoretical approaches to the study of consumption in doing so he provides an authoritative overview of a significant selection of research and analysis that has explored consumption as an object of study this book provides an ideal introduction to consumption for students of media and cultural studies and will also be useful for students within a number of other disciplines such as sociology history anthropology cultural geography and both literary and visual studies

first published in 1994 the media report terrible events but the academic study of the media is increasingly trivial and lacking in moral seriousness media culture and morality examines how this paradoxical situation could have emerged the author seizes upon the disparity between the enormous production of books in the field and the lack of substantive insights generated he argues that such a mass of self conscious criticism should have provided a moral critique of contemporary culture not the quagmire of theoretical verbiage and threadbare politicizing we are faced with today the book is a disturbing speculation on the fate of moral and cultural values in a media dominated world

how can we explain the process by which a literary text refers to another text for the past decade and a half intertextuality has been a central concern of scholars and readers of roman poetry in intertextuality and the reading of roman poetry lowell edmunds proceeds from such fundamental concepts as author text and reader which he then applies to passages from

vergil horace ovid and catullus edmunds combines close readings of poems with analysis of recent theoretical models to argue that allusion has no linguistic or semiotic basis there is nothing in addition to the alluding words that causes the allusion or the reference to be made intertextuality is a matter of reading

the daily show and rhetoric arguments issues and strategies examines the popular comedy central program from a rhetorical perspective to uncover the ways in which jon stewart the cast and writers critique mainstream media and politicians this volume analyzes the nature of the daily show the arguments the program makes about the media and politics the strategies that are used and some of the particular issues about which the program makes arguments overall the contributors skillfully demonstrate that the daily show is more than just a show designed to make the audience laugh rather the show provides useful information and arguments so that the audience can make informed decisions about the world around them

this provocative book includes a scathing refutation of the reality behind conservative christian fundamentalist morality a critical look at the limitations of liberation theology including a discussion of jim wallis s book the soul of politics and an inspiring look at morality from a revolutionary perspective this work is even more timely today as it was when it was published in 1999 bob avakian says in the prologue that from whatever vantage point one looks it is unmistakable that there is what could be called a moral crisis in america there has been to a significant degree a breakdown of traditional morality but the answer to this at least the answer that is in the interests of the majority of people in the u s and the overwhelming majority of humanity is not a more aggressive assertion of that traditional morality but winning people to a radically different morality in the process of radically transforming society and the world as a whole

the literary agenda is a series of short polemical monographs about the importance of literature and of reading in the wider world and about the state of literary education inside schools and universities the category of the literary has always been contentious what is clear however is how increasingly it is dismissed or is unrecognised as a way of thinking or an arena for thought it is sceptically challenged from within for example by the sometimes rival claims of cultural history contextualized explanation or media studies it is shaken from without by even greater pressures by economic exigency and the severe social attitudes that can follow from it by technological change that may leave the traditional forms of serious human communication looking merely antiquated for just these reasons this is the right time for renewal to start reinvigorated work into the meaning and value of literary reading we live in days no leaving them or choosing them what s in a day with their natural narrative arc they begin and they end and in between we talk about how they are going or wonder where they have gone they each have their small stories non stories ephemeral stories so every day slips by most days much like most other days we eat we sleep we go to work we endure enjoy continue day after day day before day it is the recurring of no particular story in

endless beginningless succession at the same time any single day is also a unique date with its multi digit identity its moment at last and never again of here and now today and on longer scales the slow small shifts of ordinary days and their surrounding stories will eventually remake the days that have been and gone as the times that are no more an ordinary day from decades let alone centuries ago must now be a once long passed away the old days to be regretted or to be revived in all the curiosity of their historical difference everyday stories makes us think again about the ordinary life we are in day after day and day by day always the same and always slightly changing entering into the single day drawing out the stories that surround us this book goes into everyday stories of many descriptions old and new both in literature and in that story laden place and time we call real life

novelist poet anglican priest and controversialist charles kingsley 1819 75 epitomizes the bustling victorian man of faith and letters a prolific polymath as ready to break a lance with john henry newman over christian doctrine as he was to preach to schoolchildren on the virtues of manly physical struggle kingsley s the water babies and westward ho were best sellers which became classics of children s literature kingsley has come to epitomize the victorian age on closer inspection kingsley is harder to categorize a socialist who was also an imperialist a chartist revolutionary who was queen victoria s favourite novelist a natural theologian who popularized darwin a priest who celebrated sex as sacrament kingsley only appears straightforward if you consider him one piece at a time the debates he shaped remain with us today faith and sexuality economics and exploitation race and identity the aim of this book is to present the whole man to consider the public crusades for public health alongside the most private fantasies of sexual intercourse to consider the ardent imperialist alongside the darwinist it will be of interest to all students of victorian studies as well as of

british imperial history church history and especially the history of science

this book is a sociological study of muslim youth culture in two global cities in the asia pacific singapore and sydney comparing young muslims participation in and reflections on various elements of popular culture this study illuminates the range of attitudes and strategies they adopt to reconcile popular youth culture with piety

in 1897 an indian yogi named bava lachman dass exhibited himself at the westminster aquarium in london demonstrating forty eight yoga positions to a bemused audience four years earlier hindu philosopher swami vivekananda had spoken at the first world parliament of religions in chicago where theosophist annie besant rhapsodised about his inborn sense of worth and the exquisite beauty of his spiritual message the victorians had conflicted views on the religious beliefs and practices of the indian sub continent blending fascination and suspicion but within two generations legions of young westerners would be following the hippie trail to india and the beatles would be meditating at the feet of the guru maharishi mahesh yogi journalist mick brown s vivid account charts the eccentric history of the west s evolving love affair with indian religion through a curious cast of scholars seekers charlatans and saints from edwin arnold whose epic poem about the life of the buddha became a best seller in victorian britain to the occultist and magician aleister crowley and from spiritual teachers jiddu krishnamurti meher baba and ramana maharshi to the controversial guru rajneesh the nirvana express is an exhilarating sometimes troubling journey through the west s search for enlightenment

spinoza s philosophy has an undeserved reputation for being obscure and incomprehensible but now in this indispensable collection spinoza is portrayed in the manner he deserves as a brilliant metaphysician who paved the way for an exciting new science the volume focuses on several important areas including monism the concept of conatus the nature of and the relation between mind and body and spinoza s relationship to descartes and leibniz the new physics posed difficult questions about the existence and power of god however it was commonplace of seventeenth century metaphysics to claim that all force was god s in his philosophy spinoza solves this problem identifying god with nature but what happens to individuals after that identification and what is an individual for spinoza how does it act how are its actions explained this volume clearly addresses these and other fascinating questions it explores spinoza s account of the relationship between mind and body along with his view on the ontology of values spinoza saw the threat of deterministic physics to mind body interaction how is it possible that minds act on bodies and vice versa furthermore the volume examines the problem of the nature of values asking is there room for an independent realm of values in the new philosophy finally the collection investigates problems in the interpretation of spinoza that stem from spinoza s debatable place in seventeenth century philosophy it is often claimed that spinoza s ideas evolved from cartesian doctrines while profoundly influencing leibniz with a stellar group of contributors including michael della
