fitzgerald bereits ein gefeierter autor und die 19 jährige zelda das blonde mädchen aus den südstaaten reisen im jahre 1920 drei monate nach ihrer hochzeit von connecticut nach alabama nicht mit dem zug wie es üblich gewesen wäre sondern in einem wrack von einem auto genannt expenso oder rolling junk und das alles weil zelda eines morgens aufwacht und appetit auf die biscuits und pfirsiche hat wie es sie nur in ihrer heimat gibt das vorhaben wird zur mut und ersten beziehungsprobe die die beiden wetteifernd bestreiten sie erleben die großen hoffnungen und rückschläge des reisens den wechsel der landschaft und bevölkerung stoßen auf hilfsbereitschaft und werden als sonderlinge beäugt sie erleben echte zusammenbrüche die euphorie des unterwegsseins und sie erkennen dass die sehnsucht der vielleicht wichtigste motor ist ein stück komischer leichter und erhellender literatur über das aufbrechen ankommen und den vielleicht wichtigsten motor im leben die sehnsucht aus der glücklichsten zeit des autors von der große gatsby und seiner großen liebe

in an early series of journalistic pieces for motor magazine f scott fitzgerald described a journey he took with his wife zelda from connecticut to alabama in a clapped out automobile which he called the rolling junk

with the prominence of one name couples brangelina kimye and famous families the smiths the beckhams it is becoming increasingly clear that celebrity is no longer an individual pursuit if it ever was accordingly first comes love explores celebrity kinship and the phenomenon of the power couple those relationships where two stars come together and where their individual identities as celebrities become inseparable from their status as a famous twosome taken together the chapters in this volume interrogate the ways these alliances are bound up in wider cultural debates about marriage love intimacy family parenthood sexuality and gender in their particular historical contexts from the 1920s to the present day interdisciplinary in scope first comes love seeks to establish how celebrity relationships play particular roles in dramatizing disrupting and reconciling often contradictory ideas about coupledom and kinship formations

this bibliography extends the work of stanley s first volume the foreign critical reputation of f scott fitzgerald an analysis and annotated bibliography to the final two decades of the 20th century it includes literature from the former countries of the ussr romania india and canada as well as countries that were covered in the first volume such as britain france italy germany and japan one of the major findings that emerges is that fitzgerald s poetic prose is extremely difficult to translate but new translations continue to appear the introduction to this volume provides a synthesis of fitzgerald scholarship abroad at the turn of the 21st century and points to new directions already suggested that may represent challenges to current scholarship an extended analysis introduces each chapter each chapter also includes a chronological list of translations and editions of fitzgerald s work from his earliest appearances in print to those appearing in 2000 the most substantial section of each chapter features fairly detailed annotations of monographs collections book chapters essays conference papers articles reviews and school editions this compilation will intrigue anyone interested the work of f scott fitzgerald

the start of a fantastic new series johannes cabal has never pretended to be a hero of any kind there is after all little heroic about robbing graves stealing occult volumes and being on nodding terms with demons his purpose however is noble his researches are all directed to raising the dead not as monstrosities but as people just as they were when they lived physically mentally and spiritually for such a prize some sacrifices are necessary one such sacrifice was his own soul but he now sees that was a mistake it s not just that he needs it for his research to have validity but now he realises he needs it to be himself unfortunately his soul now rests within the festering bureaucracy of hell satan may be cruel and capricious but most dangerously he is bored it is cabal s unhappy lot to provide him with amusement in short a wager in return for his own soul cabal must gather one hundred others placed in control of a diabolical carnival created to tempt to contentiousness to blasphemy argumentation and murder but one may also win coconuts and armed only with his intelligence a very large handgun and a total absence of whimsy cabal has one year one year to beat the devil at his own game and isn t that perhaps just a little heroic

pure and lovely to read zelda s letters is to fall in love with her the washington post edited by renowned jackson r bryer and cathy w barks with an introduction by scott and zelda fitzgerald s granddaughter eleanor lanahan this compilation of over three hundred letters tells the couple s epic love story in their own words scott and zelda fitzgerald s devotion to each other endured for more than twenty two years through the highs and lows of his literary success and alcoholism and her mental illness in dear scott dearest zelda over 300 of their collected love letters show why theirs has long been heralded as one of the greatest love stories of the 20th century edited by renowned fitzgerald scholars jackson r bryer and cathy w barks with an introduction by scott and zelda s granddaughter eleanor lanahan this is a welcome addition to the fitzgerald literary canon

f scott fitzgerald is one of the most challenging authors of american literature he is known internationally as the author of the great gatsby 1925 a twentieth century literary classic studied by high school students and scholars alike but fitzgerald was an amazingly productive writer despite numerous personal and professional difficulties from the beginning of his literary career with the publication of this side of paradise in 1920 to his death in 1940 he wrote 5 novels roughly 180 short stories numerous essays and reviews much poetry several plays and some film scripts even when he wrote hastily and perhaps bleary eyed his works almost always exhibit the flashes of his genius he is celebrated as a symbol of the jazz age and the roaring twenties but beneath all the glitter for which his prose is famous he warns of the dangers of personal recklessness and praises the redemptive power of love through hundreds of alphabetically arranged entries this reference book provides complete coverage of fitzgerald s life and writings the volume begins with a chronology that traces his rise from obscurity to fame his struggles with alcoholism and his eventual financial downfall the entries that follow give a full and detailed picture of fitzgerald and his work they present the essential action in fitzgerald s novels short stories plays and poems identify all named fictional characters and indicate their significance and give brief biographical information for fitzgerald s family members friends and professional associates many of the entries include bibliographies which emphasize criticism published after 1990 and the volume closes with a general bibliography of the most important broad studies of fitzgerald and his works a thorough index and extensive cross references provide additional access to the wealth of information in this

reference book and help make it a useful tool for a wide range of users

literary criticism biography conversations with f scott fitzgerald assembles over thirty interviews with one of america's greatest novelists the author of the great gatsby and tender is the night although most of these are not standard interviews in the modern sense the quotes from fitzgerald and the contemporary journalistic reaction to him reveal much about his writing techniques artistic wisdom and life editors matthew j bruccoli the foremost fitzgerald scholar and judith s baughman have collected the most usable and articulate pieces on fitzgerald including a three part 1922 interview conducted for the st paul daily news fitzgerald 1896 1940 died before the authorial interview became a literary subgenre after world war ii although fitzgerald enjoyed his celebrity as is clear in these pieces he had a poor sense of public relations and provided interviewers with opportunities to trivialize him as a result fitzgerald was often treated condescendingly in the press seven of his interviews five printed before 1924 have flapper in their headlines in the jazz age a term fitzgerald coined he was regarded as a spokesman for rebellious youth as a playboy as an authority on sex and marriage as an expert on prohibition and as an immensely popular writer for his work published in the saturday evening post yet his literary ambitions were sizable and his impact on american fiction immeasurable matthew j bruccoli is jefferies professor of english at the university of south carolina he has written or edited thirty volumes on fitzgerald including the standard biography some sort of epic grandeur the life of f scott fitzgerald judith s baughman who works in the department of english at the university of south carolina has written the f scott fitzgerald volume in the gale study guides series and has edited american decades 1920 1929

eleven specially commissioned essays by major fitzgerald scholars present a clearly written and comprehensive assessment of f scott fitzgerald as a writer and as a public and private figure no aspect of his career is overlooked from his first novel published in 1920 through his more than 170 short stories to his last unfinished hollywood novel contributions present the reader with a full and accessible picture of the background of american social and cultural change in the early decades of the twentieth century the introduction traces fitzgerald s career as a literary and public figure and examines the extent to which public recognition has affected his reputation among scholars critics and general readers over the past sixty years this volume offers undergraduates graduates and general readers a full account of fitzgerald s work as well as suggestions for further exploration of his work

the historical context of fitzgerald s writing is explored in these essays which among other topics discuss the literary marketplace of the 1920s 1930s the influence of public figures such as walter lippmann the mass market motion pictures the aftermath of the great war

epic indeed this is the definitive biography of fitzgerald plain and simple there s no reason to own another library journal the great gatsby the beautiful and damned tender is the night the curious case of benjamin button these works and more elevated f scott fitzgerald to his place as one of the most important american authors of the twentieth century after struggling to become a screenwriter in hollywood fitzgerald was working on the last tycoon when he died of a heart attack in 1940 he was only forty four years old fitzgerald left behind his own mythology he was a prince charming a drunken author a spoiled genius the personification of the jazz age and a sacrificial victim of the depression here matthew j bruccoli strips away the façade of this flawed literary hero he focuses on fitzgerald as a writer by tracing the development of his major works and his professional career beginning with his midwest upbringing and first published works as a teenager this biography follows fitzgerald s life through the successful debut of this side of paradise his turbulent marriage to zelda sayre his time in europe among the lost generation the disappointing release of the great gatsby and his ignominious fall as former us poet laureate james dickey said the spirit of the man is in the facts and these as gathered and marshalled by bruccoli over thirty years are all we will ever need but more important they are what we need

a vibrant self portrait of an artist whose work was his life in this new collection of f scott fitzgerald s letters edited by leading fitzgerald scholar and biographer matthew j bruccoli we see through his own words the artistic and emotional maturation of one of america s most enduring and elegant authors a life in letters is the most comprehensive volume of fitzgerald s letters many of them appearing in print for the first time the fullness of the selection and the chronological arrangement make this collection the closest thing to an autobiography that fitzgerald ever wrote while many readers are familiar with fitzgerald s legendary jazz age social life and his friendships with ernest hemingway gertrude stein edmund wilson and other famous authors few are aware of his writings about his life and his views on writing letters to his editor maxwell perkins illustrate the development of fitzgerald s literary sensibility those to his friend and competitor ernest hemingway reveal their difficult relationship the most poignant letters here were written to his wife zelda from the time of their courtship in montgomery alabama during world war i to her extended convalescence in a sanatorium near asheville north carolina fitzgerald is by turns affectionate and proud in his letters to his daughter scottie at college in the east while he was struggling in hollywood for readers who think primarily of fitzgerald as a hard drinking playboy for whom writing was effortless these letters show his serious painstaking concerns with creating realistic durable art
