a year after the disappearance and commencement of the international search for malaysia airlines flight 370 no sign of the plane has been found no debris no bodies no sign of the much talked about black box richard belzer george noory and david wayne want to know why scrutinizing the theories the media and politicians claim are the most likely reasons the plane crashed belzer noory and wayne argue that if a year after a huge boeing 777 has gone missing and there s still no sign of it whatsoever it s time to think outside the box the public needs to stop being misled if a plane and its passengers went missing once what s to stop it from happening again some of the theories the authors consider seem implausible on the surface but the thorough research they ve done and the continual failure of politicians aviation

authorities and military members around the world to give any indication they re wrong makes their arguments as good if not better than the more widely shared ones the title of this thought provoking volume someone is hiding something is a line spoken by former malaysian prime minister mahathir mohamad perhaps the only government official to publicly acknowledge the true reason that neither flight 370 nor the 239 people onboard have been found

in hiding from history meili steele challenges an assumption at the heart of current debates in political literary historical and cultural theory that it is impossible to reason through history steele believes that two influential schools of contemporary thought hide from history liberal philosophies of public reason as espoused by such figures as jürgen habermas martha nussbaum and john rawls and structuralism poststructuralism as practiced by judith butler hayden white and michel foucault for steele public reasoning cannot be easily divorced from either the historical imagination in general or the specific legacies that shape and often haunt political communities steele introduces the concept of public imagination concepts images stories symbols and practices of a culture to show how the imaginative social space that citizens inhabit can be a place for political discourse and debate steele engages with a wide range of thinkers and their works as well as historical events debates over the display of the confederate flag in public places ralph ellison s exchange with hannah arendt over school desegregation in little rock the controversy surrounding daniel goldhagen s book hitler s willing executioners and arguments about the concept of a clash of civilizations as expressed by samuel huntington ashis nandy edward said and amartya sen championing history and literature s capacity to articulate the politics of public imagination hiding from history boldly outlines new territory for literary and political theory

they are associated in troubling ways with a desire to hide from our humanity embodying an unrealistic and sometimes pathological wish to be invulnerable nussbaum argues that the thought content of disgust embodies magical ideas of contamination and impossible aspirations to purity that are just not in line with human life as we know it she argues that disgust should never be the basis for criminalizing an act or play either the aggravating or the mitigating role in criminal law it currently does she writes that we should be similarly suspicious of what she calls primitive shame a shame at the very fact of human imperfection and she is harshly critical of the role that such shame plays in certain punishments drawing on an extraordinarily rich variety of philosophical psychological and historical references from aristotle and freud to nazi ideas about purity and on legal examples as diverse as the trials of oscar wilde and the martha stewart insider trading case this is a major work of legal and moral philosophy

the book of harold is as profound and deeply respectful a novel as it is irreverent in its wild often hilarious take on a modern messianic movement in suburbia the titular and sometimes exasperating hero of this masterful satire is harold peeks a middle aged suburbanite living a lonely if typical modern life in the outskirts of houston texas his world feels bland and pointless until one evening at a mundane office party he announces to his stunned co workers that he is the second coming of christ oddly enough people start to believe him blake waterson harold s closest friend and narrator of the novel is as skeptical as anyone of this disheveled and disconcertingly bawdy savior and yet this would be judas is compelled to follow harold on his two hundred mile walking journey to austin with a mismatched group of equally puzzled disciples on the road this motley crew of witnesses to the holy get to experience misguided converts violent possums and the ungrateful recipients of off kilter healings they also discover the inherent paradoxes absurdities and dangers of spirituality as they learn that saviors may not have all the answers and humanity is just as bizarre and beautiful as the beliefs we hold

this book argues that there is a complex logical and epistemological interplay between the concepts of metaphor narrative and emotions they share a number of important similarities and connections in the first place all three are constituted by aspect seeing the seeing as or perception of gestalts secondly all three are meaning endowing devices helping us to furnish our world with meaning thirdly the threesome constitutes a trinity emotions have both a narrative and metaphoric structure and we can analyse the concepts of metaphors and narratives partly in each other s terms further the concept of narratives can partly be analysed in the terms of emotions and if emotions have both a narrative structure and a metaphoric one then the concept of emotions must to some extent be analysable through the concepts of narratives and metaphors but there is more metaphors especially poetic ones are important tools for the understanding of the tacit sides of emotions perhaps because of the metaphoric structure of emotions the notion that narrations can be tools for understanding emotions follows from two facts narrations are devices for explanation and emotions have a narrative structure fourthly the threesome has an impact on our rationality it has become commonplace to say that emotions have a cognitive content that narratives have an explanatory function and that metaphors can perform cognitive functions this book is the first attempt to articulate the implications that these new ways of seeing the three concepts entail for our

concept of reason the cognitive roles of the threesome suggest a richer notion of rationality than has traditionally been held a rationality enlivened with metaphoric narrative and emotive qualities stefan snaevarr reykjavik 1953 studied philosophy and related subjects in norway and germany professor at lillehammer university college in norway he is the author of several books of various kind in english norwegian and icelandic

this book makes the attempt to wed reason and the poetic the tool for this attempt is rational poetic experimentalism rpe which is introduced and explored in this book according to rpe it makes sense to look for poetic elements in human reality including reason outside of the realm of imaginative literature provocatively rpe contends that philosophy s search for truth has not been a great success so far so why not experiment with philosophical concepts and look for thought provoking ideas by employing the principles of rpe instead of fruitlessly searching for truths using conventional methods
