they say that we come from different planets men from mars women from venus that we have different brain chemistries and hormones and that we listen speak and even define our morals differently how is it then that men and women live together take the same classes in school eat the same food read the same books and receive grades according to the same criteria in the gendered society michael s kimmel examines our basic beliefs about gender arguing that men and women are more alike than we have ever imagined kimmel begins his discussion by observing that all cultures share the notion that men and women are different and that the logical extension of this assumption is that gender differences cause the obvious inequalities between the sexes in fact he asserts that the reverse is true gender inequality causes the differences between men and women gender is not simply a quality inherent in each individual it is deeply embedded in society's fundamental institutions the family school and the workplace the issues surrounding gender are complex and in order to clarify them the author has included a review of the existing literature in related disciplines such as biology anthropology psychology and sociology finally with an eye towards the future kimmel offers readers a glimpse at gender relations in the next millennium well written well reasoned and authoritative the gendered society provides a thorough overview of the current thinking about gender while persuasively arguing that it is time to reevaluate what we thought we knew about men and women

the battle between the sexes has raged on for centuries however are men and women really from different planets in the gendered society reader fourth edition coeditors michael kimmel and amy aronson pull together an array of dynamic voices both male and female classic and contemporary to examine various interpretations of gender these lively in depth readings explore gender discourse over a wide range of disciplines focusing primarily on two central issues difference and domination thoroughly

equality is a widely championed social ideal but what is equality and what action is required if present day societies are to root out their inequalities the equal society collects fourteen philosophical essays each with a fresh perspective on these questions the authors explore the demands of egalitarian justice addressing issues of distribution and rectification but equally investigating what it means for people to be equals as producers and communicators of knowledge or as members of subcultures and considering what it would take for a society to achieve gender and racial equality the essays collected here address not just the theory but also the practice of equality arguing for concrete changes in institutions such as higher education the business corporation and national constitutions to bring about a more equal society the equal society offers original approaches to themes prominent in current social and political philosophy including relational equality epistemic injustice the capabilities approach african ethics gender equality and the philosophy of race it includes new work by respected social and political philosophers such as ann e cudd miranda fricker charles w mills and jonathan wolff

reading girls captures the voices and literacy experiences of a diverse group of urban adolescent girls the author an experienced

researcher and middle school teacher intertwines investigations of multiple literacies technologies race class gender sexuality and gender expression to provide a provocative look at what helps and what hurts adolescent girls in school through engaging case studies we see how traditional schooling fails to make room for crucial life topics such as grappling with sexual or racial identity understanding gang culture or coming of age in urban america each chapter concludes with concrete strategies for improving both in and out of school practices to better serve young girls especially marginalized students

the people s republic of china prc has made advances in narrowing gender gaps in its labor market it has one of the highest female labor force participation rates in asia and the pacific at around 64 in 2013 and one of the narrowest earnings gender gaps this study investigates how women are faring in the transition to the prc s new growth model and what can be done to promote women s participation it shows how the prc is undergoing multiple transitions that have implications for gender equality and work for example during the market transition gender wage gaps and gender wage discrimination increased reaching 33 in urban areas and 44 in rural areas find out how evidenced based gender analysis can foster gender responsive policy approaches to promote women s equality in the labor market

to picture though is a woman women have historically been excluded from the discipline of philosophy and remain largely marginalized in contemporary textbooks and anthologies the under representation of women in secondary and post secondary curricula makes it harder for young women to see themselves as future philosophers in fact it makes it harder for all people to engage the valuable contributions that women have made and continue to make to intellectual thought while some progress has been made in building a more inclusive world of philosophy especially in the last fifty years important work remains to be done philosophy for girls helps correct the pervasive and problematic omission of women from philosophy divided into four sections that connect to major primary fields in philosophy metaphysics epistemology social and political philosophy and ethics this anthology is unique chapters are all written by women and each chapter opens with an anecdote about a girl or woman from mythology history art literature or science to introduce chapter topics further nearly all primary and secondary sources used in the chapters are written by women philosophers the book is written in a rigorous academic spirit but in lively and engaging prose making serious philosophical insights accessible to readers who are new to philosophy this book appeals to a wide audience individual readers will find value in these pages especially girls and women ages 16 24 as well as university and high school educators and students who want a change from standard anthologies that include few or no women the book s contributors both represent and map the diverse landscape of philosophy highlighting its engagement with themes of gender and equity in doing so they encourage philosophers current and future philosophers to explore new territory and further develop the topography of the field philosophy for girls is a rigorous yet accessible entry point to philosophical contemplation designed to inspire a new generation of philosophers

regulating sexuality legal consciousness in lesbian and gay lives explores the impact that recent seismic shifts in the legal landscape have had for lesbians and gay men the last decade has been a time of extensive change in the legal regulation of lesbian and gay lives in britain canada and the us almost every area where the law impacts on sexuality has been reformed or modified these legal developments combine to create a new uncharted terrain for lesbians and gay men and through an analysis of their attitudes views and experiences this book explores the effects of these developments drawing on and developing the concept of legal consciousness regulating sexuality focuses on four different texts qualitative responses to a large scale online survey of lesbians and gay men s views about the legal recognition of same sex relationships published auto biographical narratives about being and becoming a lesbian or gay parent semi structured in depth interviews with lesbians and gay men about relationship recognition parenting discrimination and equality and fictional utopian texts in this study of the interaction between law and society in social justice movements rosie harding interweaves insights from the new legal pluralism with legal consciousness studies to present a rich and nuanced exploration of the contemporary regulation of sexuality

music print media and the internet utilizing each chapter to present core topical and timely examples kidd highlights the tension between inclusion and individuality that lies beneath mass media and commercial culture using this tension as a point of entry to an otherwise expansive topic he systematically considers several dimensions of identity race class gender sexuality disability to provide a broad overview of the field that encompasses classical and contemporary theory original data topical and timely examples and a strong pedagogical focus on methods pop culture freaks encourages students to develop further research questions and projects from the material both quantitative and qualitative analyses are brought to bear in kidd s examination of the labor force for cultural production the representations of identity in cultural objects and the surprising differences in how various audiences consume and use mass culture in their everyday lives

this collection of 21 articles is designed to serve as a state of the art reference book for intersexuals their parents health care professionals ethics committee members and anyone interested in problems associated with intersexuality it fills an important need because of its uniqueness as an interdisciplinary effort bringing together not just urologists and endocrinologists but gynecologists psychiatrists psychologists lawyers theologians gender theorists medical historians and philosophers most contributors are well known experts on intersexuality in their respective fields the book is also unique in that it is also an international effort including authors from england the netherlands germany australia india canada and the united states the book begins with introductory chapters on the etiology of intersex conditions conceptual clarification legal issues and reflections about the inherent characteristics of medical care that have led up to the issues we face today and explain the resistance to change in traditional practices researchers provide recent data on gender identity surgical outcomes and appropriate clinical care issues never having been addressed are introduced the significance of intersexuality for christianity and for philosophical concerns with authenticity add further depth to the collection the final chapters deal with future possibilities in the treatment of intersex and for intersex advocacy

today in western countries we are seeing both the fragmentation of the gender binary the division of the social world into two and only two genders and its persistence multiple genders gender neutral pronouns and bathrooms x designations and other manifestations of degendering are becoming common and yet the two gender structure of our social world persists underneath the persistence of the binary and its discriminatory norms and expectations lurks the continuance of men's power and privilege so there is the continued need to valorize the accomplishments of women especially those of denigrated groups this succinct and thoughtful book by one of the world's foremost sociologists of gender shines a light on both sides of this paradox processes in the fragmentation of gender that are undermining the binary and processes in the performance of gender that reinforce the binary and the pros and cons of each the conclusion of the book discusses why we haven't had a gender revolution and how degendering would go a long way in creating gender equality
