as leader of one of the world s most notorious and powerful drug organizations pablo escobar made billions of dollars in the drug trade and murdered thousands of people he had his own fleet of airplanes multiple mansions and even a private zoo not to mention his own army of criminals while at the helm of the medellin cartel this colombian drug lord was responsible for smuggling in 80 of the cocaine that entered the united states of america in 1990 his net worth was estimated at us 30 billion imagine what his net worth would be in 2010 dollars how did escobar become one of the most powerful colombian drug lords let s find out by exploring his life of crime in this book

this history of colombia s illegal drug trade and of the extreme violence it created describes how in the late 1960s narcotics traffickers from the united states convinced colombians who had no previous involvement in the drug trade to grow marijuana for export to america by the early 70s foreign mostly american traffickers began requesting cocaine this book focuses on the decades of crime and violence the illegal drug trade brought to colombia and how this social upset was ended in the early 2000s six chapters detail the medellin and cali cartels war against the colombian government the revolutionary guerrillas war against the government the war that paramilitary groups conducted against the guerrillas and the way in which the government finally put a stop to the cartel financed bloodshed in conclusion the author assesses colombia s progress and prospects since the end of the violence claimed the lives of some 300 000 between 1975 and 2008

pablo escobar born on the 1st of december 1949 and killed on the 2nd of december 1993 was a

notorious drug lord in colombia during the height of his career he supplied an estimated 80 percent of the cocaine smuggled into the united states he was widely regarded as the king of cocaine and the wealthiest drug lord in history with a net worth that had exceeded 30 billion by the start of the 90s and estimated 50 billion including the money hidden in different areas in colombia

here is the whole story of the world of drugs from the infamous opium wars to the legal availability of narcotics in the united states during the past century from the unexpected boost given to illicit drugs by prohibition to the great success of the french connection the global drug trade is one of the most prominent examples of the law of supply and demand despite such countermeasures as the execution of narcotics dealers in china and the united states s much ballyhooed war on drugs drug traffickers have always managed to meet the demand and satisfy an ever growing customer base in addition to offering a wealth of little known facts the war on drugs also covers major dealers cartels organizations smuggling and anti smuggling strategies major miscalculations and disasters drug epidemics legal restraints famous incidents and more

since mexican president felipe calderón declared war on the drug cartels in dec 2006 more than 35 000 mexicans have died due to narco violence this monograph examines whether the various mexican drug trafficking organizations are insurgents or organized criminal elements mexican narco violence and its affiliated gang violence have spread across mexico s southern border into guatemala honduras and el salvador additionally the narco violence is already responsible for the deaths of american citizens on both sides of the u s mexico border and the potential for increased

spillover violence is a major concern this monograph argues that the mexican drug cartels are transnational criminal organizations tcos that pose a national security threat to the regional state actors however they are not an insurgency for four reasons first none of the cartels have the political aim or capability to overthrow the mexican government second the various tcos are competing criminal organizations with approximately 90 percent of the violence being cartel on cartel for example the violence in the city of Juárez is largely the result of the fighting between the local Juárez cartel and the sinaloa cartel for control of one of the primary smuggling routes into the u s third the cartels use of violence and coercion has turned popular support against them thus denying them legitimacy fourth although the cartels do control zones of impunity within their areas of influence the mexican government has captured killed and extradited kingpins from every major tco

for over twenty years ranchers on our southern border have been overrun with smugglers criminals illegal immigrants and terrorists law enforcement personnel have joined the ranchers to expose the government policies that have maintained an open lawless and deadly border

i ve begged god for forgiveness but i won t know till the day i die if he has truly forgiven me i ve paid my dues to society by serving my long sentence but perhaps i haven t earned his indulgence oh my god i ve lived so many different lives i survived pablo escobar gavia el patrón the boss and it was the strength of his indomitable spirit that kept me going all these years i don t quite know how or why i still feel his presence every day of my existence the medellin cartel s crimes weigh as heavily on my shoulders today as they did yesterday my youth wasted in crime became the sword that now hangs over my graying head to the world i ll always be known by my alias popeye the fearsome hitman of the medellin cartel pablo escobar gavia s right hand man how can

i make you understand i m a new man that twenty three years behind bars in that hellhole have transformed the person i once was now the freedom i yearned for is vanishing in the murderous hands of my enemies perhaps fate has extended my life only to toy with me by preparing my own dying moments i survived in captivity but i don t know if i ll be able to live in freedom a prisoner of my own mind i ll try to fight to find some peace it s very cold now it s august 2014 i m one step from freedom and i m still breathing still here in this dimly lit cell in the maximum security prison in cómbita boyacá

cocaine has had a long and prominent position in the history of american substance abuse as far back as the late 1800s cocaine was commonly found hi patent medicines elixirs and astonishingly in the earliest versions of coca cola eventually the potency of cocaine was recognized and its purveyors came under gradual regulation events hi the early 1900s kept cocaine use down until world war ii but the extensive drug use of the 1960s once again sparked a national temperance movement created in 1989 the office of national drug control policy maintains responsibility for coordinating and monitoring the nation s countemarcotics policy but responsibility for coordination and monitoring is not the same thing as control in snow job kevin jack riley examines source country control policies policies intended to control the production and export of cocaine from latin america and their limitations part i draws together drug use drug production and drug control policies hi an analytic framework it goes on to examine the recent history of u s drug control policies source country control policies the ways hi which cocaine prices affect cocaine use how cocaine is made and the vulnerable points in its production part ii examines the economic effects that production and controls exert on the sources of cocaine bolivia and peru and probes the colombian drug lord connection part iii prescribes an appropriate path for source

country cocaine policies and examines their implications for two other widely smuggled drugs heroin and marijuana. Riley disagrees with analysts who believe that source country control policies can lead to permanent victory in the war against cocaine because of the potentially high costs associated with implementing source country control policies on a large scale. He suggests a better strategy would be one that recognizes the severe limits facing interdiction, eradication, and other source country policies and instead focuses on directing source country resources where they will be most useful. This necessitates defining a regional strategy that elevates political stability and institution building and demotes traditional counternarcotics objectives. Snow Job offers original thinking and practical approaches to a multidimensional world problem and will be of interest to policymakers, political scientists, sociologists, and law enforcement officials.

Pablo Emilio Escobar Gaviria was born on December 1, 1949, in Rionegro, the Antioquia department of Colombia. His father, Abel de Jesús Dari Escobar, was a farmer, and his mother, Hermilda Gaviria, was a teacher in an elementary school in the area. He was the third of seven children of his parents and began his criminal activities as a teenager. Some reports claim that he would steal gravestones, sand them down, and then resell them to smugglers. However, his brother denies that he used to steal those gravestones. His friends and family report that Pablo would often tell them that he wanted to become the president of Colombia. Instead, he became the world's most notorious drug lord.

Written from the perspective of a former active participant in the U.S. anti-drug policy formulation and implementation efforts, *Cocaine Quagmire* is an in-depth analysis of why the U.S. drug war in Colombia is failing while frequent anti-drug battles are won. Dynamic socioeconomic and political factors have created a quagmire of countervailing obstacles leading to strategic foreign policy

defeat in the north and the Clinton administration focused on combating narco trafficking and yet misunderstood how a strong international demand and immense profits provide the basic incentives that keep the Colombian cocaine traffickers in business. This book is important in that it fills a significant gap in our knowledge of U.S. foreign policy and its application in the drug wars of the South American country of Colombia.

In the post 9/11 era, the nexus between organized crime and terrorism has raised much concern and has been widely discussed in both academic and policy circles but is still largely misunderstood. This critical book contributes innovatively to the debate by distinguishing three types of nexus interaction: transformation, imitation, and similarities, and identifying the promoting factors of each type.

Bribes, Bullets, and Intimidation is the first book to examine drug trafficking through Central America and the efforts of foreign and domestic law enforcement officials to counter it. Drawing on interviews, legal cases, and an array of Central American sources, Julie Bunck and Michael Fowler track the changing routes, methods, and networks involved while comparing the evolution and consequences of the drug trade through Belize, Costa Rica, Guatemala, Honduras, and Panama over a span of more than three decades. Bunck and Fowler argue that while certain similar factors have been present in each of the Central American states, the distinctions among these countries have been equally important in determining the speed with which extensive drug trafficking has taken hold, the manner in which it has evolved, the amounts of different drugs that have been transshipped, and the effectiveness of antidrug efforts.

An entire chapter is devoted to chronicling how the \$500 billion a year that is paid for these drugs

more than the gdp of all but the world s seven richest nations is efficiently laundered
