in the urban communities of medieval germany and northern france the beliefs observances and practices of jews allowed them to create and define their communities on their own terms as well as in relation to the surrounding christian society although medieval jewish texts were written by a learned elite the laity also observed many religious rituals as part of their everyday life in practicing piety in medieval ashkenaz elisheva baumgarten asks how jews especially those who were not learned expressed their belonging to a minority community and how their convictions and deeds were made apparent to both their jewish peers and the christian

majority practicing piety in medieval ashkenaz provides a social history of religious practice in context particularly with regard to the ways jews and christians separately and jointly treated their male and female members medieval jews often shared practices and beliefs with their christian neighbors and numerous notions and norms were appropriated by one community from the other by depicting a dynamic interfaith landscape and a diverse representation of believers baumgarten offers a fresh assessment of jewish practice and the shared elements that composed the piety of jews in relation to their christian neighbors

in the promise of piety arsalan khan examines the zealous commitment to a distinct form of face to face preaching dawat among pakistani tablighis practitioners of the transnational islamic piety movement the tablighi jamaat this group says that muslims have abandoned their religious duties for worldly pursuits creating a state of moral chaos apparent in the breakdown of relationships in the family nation and global islamic community tablighis insist that this dire situation can only be remedied by drawing muslims back to islam through dawat which they regard as the sacred means for spreading islamic virtue in a country founded in the name of muslim identity and where islam is ubiquitous in public life the tablighi claim that pakistani muslims have abandoned islam is particularly striking the promise of piety shows how tablighis constitute a distinct form of pious relationality in the ritual processes and everyday practices of dawat and how pious relationality serves as a basis for transforming domestic and public life khan explores both the promise and limits of the tablighi project of creating an islamic moral order that can transcend the political fragmentation and violence of life in postcolonial pakistan

the summa theologica is the best known work of italian philosopher scholar and dominican friar saint thomas aquinas 1225 1274 widely considered the catholic church s greatest theologian famously consulted immediately after the bible on religious questions at the council of trent aquinas s masterpiece has been considered a summary of official church philosophy ever since aquinas considers approximately 10 000 questions on church doctrine covering the roles and nature of god man and jesus then lays out objections to church teachings and systematically confronts each using biblical verses theologians and philosophers to bolster his arguments in volume iii aquinas addresses faith and heresy charity peace and war mercy anger and justice prayer truth and much more this massive work of scholarship spanning five volumes addresses just about every possible query or argument that any believer or atheist could have and remains essential more than seven hundred years after it was written for clergy religious historians and serious students of catholic thought

this carefully crafted ebook summa theologica all complete unabridged 3 parts supplement appendix interactive links and annotations is formatted for your ereader with a functional and detailed table of contents this ebook is the best known work of thomas aquinas c 1225 1274 although unfinished the summa is one of the classics of the history of philosophy and one of the most influential works of western literature it is intended as an instructional guide for moderate theologians and a compendium of all of the main theological teachings of the catholic church it presents the reasoning for almost all points of christian theology in the west the summa theologica is divided into three parts and each of these three parts contains numerous subdivisions part 1 deals

primarily with god and comprises discussions of 119 questions concerning the existence and nature of god the creation angels the work of the six days of creation the essence and nature of man and divine government part 2 deals with man and includes discussions of 303 questions concerning the purpose of man habits types of law vices and virtues prudence and justice fortitude and temperance graces and the religious versus the secular life part 3 deals with christ and comprises discussions of 90 questions concerning the incarnation the sacraments and the resurrection some editions of the summa theologica include a supplement comprising discussions of an additional 99 questions concerning a wide variety of loosely related issues such as excommunication indulgences confession marriage purgatory and the relations of the saints toward the damned scholars believe that rainaldo da piperno a friend of aquinas probably gathered the material in this supplement from a work that aquinas had completed before he began working on the summa theologica it seeks to describe the relationship between god and man and to explain how man's reconciliation with the divine is made possible at all through christ to this end aquinas cites proofs for the existence of god and outlines the activities and nature of god approximately one half of the summa theologica then examines the nature and purpose of man finally aquinas devotes his attention to the nature of christ and the role of the sacraments in effecting a bridge between god and man within these broad topical boundaries though aquinas examines the nature of god and man in exquisite detail his examination includes questions of how angels act on bodies the union of body and soul the cause and remedies of anger cursing and the comparison of one sin with another aquinas is attempting to offer a truly universal and rational view of all existence thomas aquinas o p 1225 1274 also thomas of aquin or aquino was an italian dominican priest and an immensely influential philosopher and theologian in the tradition of scholasticism within which he is also known as the doctor angelicus doctor communis and doctor universalis he was the foremost classical proponent of natural theology and the father of thomism his influence on western thought is considerable and much of modern philosophy was conceived in development or refutation of his ideas particularly in the areas of ethics natural law metaphysics and political theory

in the figure of abdallāh b al mubārak 118 181 736 797 we find a paragon of the fields of adīth zuhd and jihād as attested to by the large number of references to him in the classical islamic texts his superior rank as a adīth transmitter earned him the title commander of the faithful in adīth he contributed to islamic law at its early phases of development practiced jihād composed poetry and participated in various theological discussions in addition ibn al mubārak was a pioneer in writing on piety and was later regarded by many mystics as one of the earliest figures of sufism ibn al mubārak's position during the formative period of islamic thought illustrates the unique evolution of zuhd adīth and jihād these form a junction in the biography of ibn al mubārak in a way that distinctively illuminates the second eighth century dynamics of nascent sunnī identity furthermore ibn al mubārak's status as a fighter and pious figure of the late antique period reveals a great deal about the complex relationship between the early muslim community and the religiously diverse setting which it inhabited this critical and comprehensive monograph of abdallāh b al mubārak situates him within the larger context of the social and religious milieu of late antiquity it explores the formation of sunnī identity in the second islamic century and demonstrates the way in which it manifested itself through networks of pious scholars who defined preserved and passed on what they understood to be normative islamic practice and beliefs from one generation of muslim intellectuals to another

w e b du bois is an improbable candidate for a project in religion his skepticism of and even hostility toward religion is readily established and canonically accepted indeed he spent his career rejecting normative religious commitments to institutions and supernatural beliefs in this book jonathon kahn offers a fresh and controversial reading of du bois that seeks to overturn this view kahn contends that the standard treatment of du bois turns a deaf ear to his writings for if we re open to their religious timbre those writings from his epoch making the souls of black folk to his unstudied series of parables that depict the lynching of an african american christ reveal a virtual obsession with religion du bois s moral literary and political imagination is inhabited by religious rhetoric concepts and stories divine discontent recovers and introduces readers to the remarkably complex and varied religious world in du bois s writings it s a world of sermons of religious virtues such as sacrifice and piety of jeremiads that fight for a black american nation within the larger nation unlike other african american religious voices at the time however du bois s religious orientation is distinctly heterodox it exists outside the bounds of institutional christianity kahn shows how du bois self consciously marshals religious rhetoric concepts typologies narratives virtues and moods in order to challenge traditional christian worldview in which events function to confirm a divine order du bois s antimetaphysical religious voice he argues places him firmly in the american tradition of pragmatic religious naturalism typified by william james this innovative reading of du bois should appeal to scholars of american religion intellectual history african american studies and philosophy of religion
