this inspirational book takes a brief but in depth look into god s grace and the faith we have to receive it from salvation to a deeper more personal walk with god this book is intended to ground you in god s unfailing unending ever flowing grace and encourage and embolden you to open your hands of faith and receive all that your abba father has for you scriptures are provided and referenced for a more personal and deeper level of study may your spiritual eyes be opened and your heart be uplifted as you discover and explore god s amazing grace

this book brings together philosophical and theological perspectives on agapistic love the aim of the text is to illuminate the nature of unlimited love by distinct and integrative approaches to the intersection of the divine and the human various scientific

approaches to human forms of love seem to shed light on our nature as social beings but to what extent are the natural desires for affection sexual love and friendship augmented revised perfected or replaced by the gift of grace in other words we can ask how is it that agap modifies or shapes the natural loves diverse theological and moral traditions address the question in quite startling contrast thomists follow the dictum that grace does not destroy nature but perfects it lutherans draw a sharp contrast between law and gospel while wesleyans see charity as the sanctifying power of the holy spirit some feminist theorists see the idea of self giving love as contrary to genuine self fulfilment while the neo kantians see love as a duty to others and some kierkegaardians see the command to love as an unusual manifestation of divine command ethics these diverse approaches in light of contemporary research in the natural and social sciences can provide fertile ground for the exploration of the intersection of human and divine love to date there is no text available that brings scholars from various theological and philosophical backgrounds together to engage in interdisciplinary dialogue on this important and much neglected aspect of research into the human and divine loves this book offers a significant attempt to remedy the situation

discusses the complexities and paradoxes of love as represented in the history of western philosophy and christianity in the asymptote of love james kellenberger develops a theory of religious love that resists essentialist definitions of the term and brings into conversation historical debates on love in western philosophy and christian theology he argues that if love can be likened to a mathematical asymptote which is a straight line that infinitely approaches a curve but never quite reaches it then the asymptote of love reaches toward the infinite endpoint of love at its uttermost namely god s love drawing upon a broad range of thinkers who have put forth classic debates on love such as st augustine of hippo anders nygren and st thomas aguinas as well as some lesser known figures in the debate such as leo tolstoy and albert schweitzer kellenberger explains the

profound connection between human agape and god s infinite love in its capacity to offer both directive guidance and to exist beyond human conception the widening of the circle of love is a rather novel contribution both from the author and from the twentieth century in general for this reason alone the book stands out in contemporary publishing joeri schrijvers author of between faith and belief toward a contemporary phenomenology of religious life

the book explores the law the history the poetry the prophets the gospels and the letters endowing awareness and progression of light given throughout the bible to reveal god s love towards mankind in this selective eloquent discussion of god s amazing love pastor jeff rogers challenges us to think outside the box of understanding love and to experience it from a higher perspective pastor jeff has a long standing interest in seeing the church move in the anointing for healing and deliverance and understanding its role in the salvation of israel and wrote a book on the matter he appeared on a tv broadcast network tbn for over 17 years speaking about the things peculiar to the kingdom of god pastor jeff s goal is to see lifeless institutional traditions overcome by families ministering together evangelistically in the order and anointing of the spirit with power gifts and signs that follow his latest undertaking with this book is based on appreciating what we have not seen concerning the love of god

john rawls never published anything about his own religious beliefs but after his death two texts were discovered which shed extraordinary light on the subject a brief inquiry into the meaning of sin and faith is rawls s undergraduate senior thesis submitted in december 1942 just before he entered the army at that time rawls was deeply religious the thesis is a significant work of theological ethics of interest both in itself and because of its relation to his mature writings on my religion a short statement drafted in 1997 describes the history of his religious beliefs and attitudes toward religion including his abandonment of orthodoxy during world war ii the present volume includes these two texts together with an introduction by joshua cohen and thomas nagel which discusses their relation to rawls s published work and an essay by robert merrihew adams which places the thesis in its theological context the texts display the profound engagement with religion that forms the background

of rawls s later views on the importance of separating religion and politics moreover the moral and social convictions that the thesis expresses in religious form are related in illuminating ways to the central ideas of rawls s later writings his notions of sin faith and community are simultaneously moral and theological and prefigure the moral outlook found in theory of justice

christian mission involves god the missionary and the other the recipient of mission this book argues for the centrality of this other in the practice of mission the other as child of god is presented not as an empty vessel waiting to be filled but as the one who draws near to the missionary both are sent by god and together they enter into the journey towards god drawing on scripture contemporary missiology and phenomenology the book argues for the importance of this often neglected other and demonstrates through historical case studies involving saint ignatius of loyola william carey and saint innocent of alaska that the recognition of the gift of the other has always been present in christian mission and can continue to inspire

in a tragic instant in 1998 my relatively normal world as a mature man family provider and wage earner christian husband and father changed drastically but also my god changed or at least my perceptions and expectations of god and life in general were severely shaken the world i went to bed with was not the world i awakened to early the next morning to learn that my only daughter was dead the emotions that engulfed me were then and are to this day unfathomable emotions pain doubt anger and many other religious and interpersonal struggles that i ve called bitter grief the faith and religion that i had depended on and expected to provide strength understanding and comfort for most of my fifty four years in such a situation were now very quickly major parts of my problem simplistic efforts to console and explain to ease my pain to answer my questions just angered me and aggravated my bewilderment eventually this book emerged at first from the relentless conflagration of emotions and distress that first started their expression as a journal stressing my need for meaningful support and empathy following the open surprise bewilderment and guilt ridden feelings of divine betrayal that gripped me after my only daughter was killed in a tragic one vehicle accident the total impact that my daughter s death had on me was finally confirmed sixteen years later following the unexpected death of my eldest son this book recalls and reflects my personal experiences of dealing with bitter

grief and as a whole describes my feelings actions and even my very questionable thinking from that traumatic beginning the sometimes dark and unthinkable emotions and reasoning that followed my child s death not as i had expected that i should have or would have felt or thought but as i actually did feel and think triggering the overwhelming need to ask endless questions and then seek to understand i had to ask and continue to ask why until i understood well enough to again be at peace with god why is perhaps the most fundamental question of life why does anything exist and especially why does life exist if there is a creator god who loves us why do pain and suffering exist and i now realized that if one s religion and faith don t satisfactorily address the problem of severe human suffering and horrific tragedy then they must lack the capacity to interpret the human experience or to provide a realistic or adequate world view thus i had to ask why questions that reached well beyond the deaths of my children for the first time i had to step outside of my now crumbling former religious comfort zone to consider my tragic and bitter losses and god s role in my losses and his role in all the other terrible pain suffering and death that exists in the world i had to ask myself very difficult questions and try to understand why the harsher and horrific things of life happen but more specifically why jodi why me and why now i ve tried to honestly consider why life often seems so unfair but this was a surprisingly difficult thing to do to seriously question the things i had come to believe and to expect from life and from god and then sixteen years later by god s sovereign choice i got a second chance to look at and reassess why following the death of my eldest son brian this book is also in some sense a lament and a chronicle though somewhat topical and not strictly chronological of my life as a distraught bereaved parent transitioning by means of bitter grief and sorrow to some new more stable normal under the sovereign leading of god as must others who also suffer bitter grief this book is the story of my life since april 23 1998 my experiences successes and disappointments and i hope they will be of value to you as you deal with your own bitter grief and or try to help others cope with theirs
