lucifer fallen angel or martyr of desire condemned to die by god and branded a traitor by his fellow fallen angels lucifer descends on boston in a blizzard he is drawn to humanity and vows to appear before the world again as lucifer but with heaven s longstanding disinformation campaign stacked against him he does not yet dare when he learns of a celibate cult the wise virgins he dons human disguises and enters the lives of two of its leaders virgil caldera and his aunt agatha brimsmead the powerful archangel michael lucifer s creator and former lover is behind the cult michael is convinced that sex is the source of all misery on earth and has decreed that humans must renounce erotic love or burn in hellfire the battle of wills and wits is onÑnot only over the bodies and souls of virgil and agatha but in that age old struggle between desire and divine authority lucifer has one hope of defeating michael he must expose the deadly flaw in michael s plan of salvation but as long as he remains hidden he cannot reveal the truth about his past in heaven or the scandal of the world to come in the bible and milton s paradise lost lucifer is portrayed as the angel whose pride caused him to fall from heaven and turn toward evil in lightbearer he is the artist the dissident and the genius of desire who dares to question the premise of creation itself and who reveals that sin may be all that stands between us and living hell

in evolutionary rhetoric scholar wendy hayden provides a comprehensive examination of the relationship between scientific and feminist rhetorics in free love feminism studying the movement from its inception in the 1850s to its dark turn toward eugenics in the early 1900s hayden organizes her provocative study by scientific discipline evolution physiology bacteriology embryology and heredity each chapter explores how free love feminists adopted the evidence of that discipline in their arguments for increased sex education women s sexual rights reproductive freedom and the abolition of a marriage system that repressed the rights and the sexuality of women hayden takes our conventional understanding of the relationship between nineteenth century feminism and science and expands it the author provides examples of the powerful words of free love feminists to show exactly how these exceptional women used science as a rhetorical platform to promote feminist and often radical social reforms considering why the free love movement has not yet been studied hayden also discusses how the recovery of

this movement may impact larger goals in the recovery of women's rhetoric this important and timely study of a long forgotten movement adds to our understanding of the complexities of the history of feminism

a group of men rape an intoxicated fifteen year old girl to make a woman of her an immigrant woman is raped after accepting a ride from a stranger a young mother is accosted after a neighbor escorts her home in another case a college frat party is the scene of the crime although these incidents appear similar to accounts one can read in the newspapers almost any day in the united states only the last one occurred in this century each however involved a woman or girl compelled to have sex against her will sex without consent explores the experience prosecution and meaning of rape in american history from the time of the early contact between

europeans and native americans to the present by exploring what rape meant in particular times and places in american history from interracial encounters due to colonization and slavery to rape on contemporary college campuses the contributors add to our understanding of crime and punishment as well as to gender relations gender roles and sexual politics

acknowledging the divine benefactor is a socio rhetorical interpretation of the second letter of peter using multiple interpretive perspectives and emphasising the pictorial dimensions of 2 peter terrance callan shows that the letter makes the following argument since jesus christ has given his followers benefits including the promise of sharing in divine nature they need to make a proper return for these benefits by living virtuously and this in turn will enable them to receive the fulfilment of the promise the occasion of the letter is that peter s death is near he writes so the addressees can remember his teaching after his death the author expounds this teaching because some people do not await the future fulfilment of christ s promises and so do not emphasise the need for virtuous living

theory and history in international relations is an eloquent plea to scholars of global politics to turn away from the manufacture of data and return to a systematic study of history as a basis for theory while the modest use of empiricism will always be important. Puchala rejects the logical positivism of the so-called scientific revolution in the field in favor of a more complex even intuitive vision of global politics. one of this book s main themes is how god s book of nature is concordant with his book of scripture in their writings many of the pioneers of the scientific revolution often referred to god s two books these brilliant naturalists were also devout christians but that was back then is modern science actually compatible with scripture more to the point are the findings of 21st century science concordant with the genesis creation story what else does the text of genesis 1 2 have to say while making an honest effort to answer those questions some vitally important theological concepts which were introduced by moses in the first two chapters of genesis are also examined and discussed in this volume this comprehensive study on how modern science is concordant with the intended meaning of the text of genesis 1 2 has many useful features including the following much of the first two parts of the book consists of background material on 1 logic 2 history and philosophy of science and 3 scientific method as well as 4 basic geological principles 5 descriptions of plate tectonic theory and 6 the principles and methods of radiometric dating this background material is designed to help the reader to understand the implications of the empirical evidence presented in part two god s book of nature similarly there is also extensive material on 1 biblical interpretation and hermeneutics 2 textual criticism 3 the history of ancient israel 4 development of the hebrew language and 5 some of the basic elements of biblical hebrew this material is given prior to looking at the literary structure and genre of the genesis 1 2 text and then conducting thorough and complete exegetical analyses of the various textual units of genesis 1 2 in part four god s book of scripture prior to the exegetical analyses for each of the textual units of genesis 1 2 1 the biblical hebrew text 2 a standard english translation and 3 an interlinear version of the text of that unit are provided the interlinear version consists of a the hebrew text with b sbl transliterations and c english glosses below each one of the hebrew words color coding and other types of annotations highlighting are used throughout part four god s book of scripture in order to help the reader identify important biblical hebrew elements including recurring phrases important bh words and key bhvs verb forms there are more than 2000 detailed footnotes many of these footnotes

also cross reference other topics in the book to make it easier for the reader to refer back to a discussion of some important theme or concept excerpts from the entries of reputable hebrew and greek lexicons for words written in the original languages of the biblical text are also footnoted an appendix is included with a key to transliteration and pronunciation for biblical hebrew graphemes it also has a short section on biblical hebrew accent markings numerous detailed colored figures are sprinkled throughout the text in many of these figures the artwork itself is worth the inexpensive price of the digital edition of this book part six the good news is worth reading as a stand alone exposition of god s grace but it also helps put the rest of the book in context although the most common and logical way to read a fresh look at genesis 1 2 is from start to finish this 1100 page book was also intended to be used as a reference work footnotes direct the reader back to pertinent material in preceding chapters that might not have been read already or that readers might want to revisit in order to refresh their memory on some topic more information is available at a fresh look at genesis org

this item is part of lenski new testament in twenty volumes pastors and students of the bible who seek deep and detailed engagement with the text of the new testament have long relied on r c h lenski s classic text now available again even though its historical critical work has been surpassed the strong narrative quality accessibility and holy reverence for the word of god moody monthly of lenski s work have allowed his commentary to continue as an excellent resource for serious study of the new testament and sermon preparation

this book chronicles the struggles of the drs foote examining not just their efforts to further individual rights and women s health but also the larger issues surrounding free speech and censorship in the gilded age of american history

throughout the centuries translations of the bible have steadily improved in general each new translation inherits from previous ones and opens the way for later ones while a new translation derives help from its predecessors it should go further the recovery version of the new testament following the precedent set by the major authoritative english versions and taking these versions as reference not only

incorporates lessons learned from an examination of others practices but also attempts to avoid biases and inaccurate judgments this version frequently guided by other versions attempts to provide the best utterance for the revelation in the divine word that it may be expressed in the english language with the greatest accuracy translating the bible depends not only on an adequate comprehension of the original language but also on a proper understanding of the divine revelation in the holy word throughout the centuries the understanding of the divine revelation possessed by the saints has always been based upon the light they received and this understanding has progressed steadily the consummation of this understanding forms the basis of this translation and its footnotes hence this translation and the accompanying footnotes could be called the crystallization of the understanding of the divine revelation which the saints everywhere have attained to in the past two thousand years it is our hope that the recovery version will carry on the heritage that it has received and will pave the way for future generations as with any new testament translation the determination of the original greek text based upon the available manuscripts forms the basis for the text of the recovery version of the new testament the recovery version follows for the most part the nestle aland greek text as found in novum testamentum graece 26th edition however in determining the original form of any verse the translators of the recovery version gave careful consideration to the larger context of chapter and book and to similar portions of the new testament the most recently discovered manuscripts or the manuscripts of oldest date are not necessarily the most accurate or reliable hence the determination of the text for this version was based largely upon the principle stated above departures from the nestle aland text are sometimes indicated in the footnotes italicized words in the verses indicate supplied words not found in the greek text quotation marks are used to indicate close quotation from the old testament the recovery version embodies extensive research into the meaning of the original text and attempts to express this meaning with english that is to the point easy to understand and readable in those places where it is difficult to express the exact meaning of the original greek explanatory footnotes have been supplied the subject provided at the beginning of each book and the outline of each book take the historical facts as their base and express the spiritual meaning in each book the footnotes stress the revelation of the truth the spiritual light and the supply of life more than history geography and persons the cross references lead not only to other verses with the same expressions and facts but also to other matters related to the spiritual revelation in the divine word

throughout its history the christian church has had a troubled relationship with the arts whether literature poetry music visual arts or other forms of artistic expression this volume is not designed to resolve the issues but it is designed to present a number of different statements about various dimensions of the arts in their relationship to the bible the bible is the document that stands behind the christian church as an inspiration to it and to its arts as a result we have divided this volume into six parts perspectives on the arts culture and art visual enactments contemporary interpretations music and the bible and literature many of the issues that the history of the interaction of the arts and the bible within the christian church has uncovered are insightfully and artfully addressed by this book the wide range of contributors runs the gamut from practicing artists of various media to scholars within varied academic fields

the lines have been drawn on one side are young earth creationists who assert that god created the universe in six days and based on calculations derived from the bible that the earth is six thousand years old on the other side are secular scientists who claim the universe has existed for over thirteen billion years the earth for 4.5 billion scientists claim that no miracles were necessary to form the universe and that everything is explained by natural causes however young earth creationists point to verses at the beginning of the bible and the beginning of the book of john that clearly claim that god created the universe in the beginning god created the heavens and the earth the earth was formless and void and darkness was over the surface of the deep and the spirit of god was moving over the surface of the waters genesis 1:1-2 in the beginning was the word and the word was with god and the word was god he was in the beginning with god all things were made by him and without him was not anything made that was made john 1:1-3 but what if there is no contradiction between scientific data and the bible arnold guyot was a nineteenth century geologist and geographer at princeton university in addition to his numerous scientific accomplishments he developed the day age interpretation of genesis 1 in which the days of creation represent geologic ages when we view the bible through this lens we find that modern science has not only failed to refute the miracles of genesis but has in fact provided abundant evidence for their veracity genesis revealed a scientific examination of the creation story takes readers down the twin paths of science and theology to show that they lead us to the same destination citing a multitude of discoveries in astronomy and geology dr peter waller makes a compelling case for guyot's interpretation and for the miracles described in genesis 1:1-25
