jack frost a jack russell made completely of ice feels it s his life s purpose to find homes for lost and abandoned animals finished homing all the animals before christmas jack has decided to go to prince edward island in canada for the jack frost festival and wherever jack goes adventure surely follows this trip is no different as jack learns how thrilling it is to live aboard a ship in the middle of winter from finding a message in a bottle that turns out to be an sos to exploring a lighthouse and making a few unlikely friends jack has a lot of stories to tell when he returns home from his adventure in the maritimes while sharing jacks escapades this book for middle readers also communicates the importance of acceptance and love while uniting lonely animals with people who love them

pat tillman was well known to american sports fans a chisel jawed and talented young professional football star he was on the brink of signing a million dollar contract when in 2001 al qaeda launched terrorist attacks against his country driven by deeply felt moral patriotism he walked away from fame and money to enlist in the united states special operations forces a year later he was killed apparently in the line of fire on a desolate hillside near the pakistan border in afghanistan news of tillman s death shocked america but even as the public mourned his loss the us army aggressively maneuvered to conceal the truth that it was a ranger in tillman s own platoon who had fired the fatal shots in where men win glory jon krakauer reveals how an entire country was deliberately deceived by those at the very highest levels of the us army and government infused with the power and authenticity readers have come to expect from krakauer s storytelling where men win glory exposes shattering truths about men and war

in offering a comprehensive explanation of how militant islamists have hijacked the islamic religion aboul enein provides a realistic description of the militant threat which is far different and distinct from islamist political discourse and the wider religion of islam a key adviser at the joint intelligence task force for combating terrorism he argues that winning the war against militant islamists requires a more complete understanding of their ideology clearly defining the differences between islam islamist and military islamist he highlights how militant islamist ideology takes selected fragments of islamic history and theology and weaves them into a narrow pseudo intellectual ideology to justify their violence against muslims and non muslims alike

the reagan to the obama administrations this eye opening study uncovers the history of the most important instrument of u s counterterrorism today the armed drone it reveals that contrary to popular belief the cia s covert drone program is not a product of 9 11 rather it is the result of u s counterterrorism practices extending back to an influential group of policy makers in the reagan administration tracing the evolution of counterterrorism policy and drone technology from the fallout of iran contra and the cia s eagle program prototype in the mid 1980s to the emergence of al qaeda fuller shows how george w bush and obama built upon or discarded strategies from the reagan and clinton eras as they responded to changes in the partisan environment the perceived level of threat and technological advances examining a range of counterterrorism strategies he reveals why the cia s drones became the united states preferred tool for pursuing the decades old goal of preemptively targeting anti american terrorists around the world

this book examines the relationships between democratic government and political terrorism since the 9 11 attacks the united states and many of its allies have declared a war on terrorism this struggle has been inspired in part by the belief is that by promoting democracy they will also bring an end to terrorism where people enjoy the blessings of liberty they will naturally find peaceful outlets for the expression of their political views it has been widely held terrorism on the other hand is seen largely as a consequence of repression where citizens cannot choose rulers freely and where dissenting voices are silenced by the authorities terrorism and other types of violence appear to follow democracy and terrorism investigates the link between terrorism and the underlying principles of democracy both from an historical perspective and against contemporary developments in the middle east and elsewhere drawing upon a range of different case studies and using quantitative data to investigate statistical links between the waves of democracy and manifestations of terrorist violence the book reviews whether terrorism is in fact constrained by the rise of democratic government and the role of the law in fighting terrorism this book will be of much interest to students of terrorism political violence democratisation security studies and international relations in general

gregory gause s masterful book is the first to offer a comprehensive account of the international politics in the persian gulf across nearly four decades the story begins in 1971 when great britain ended its protectorate relations with the smaller states of the lower gulf it traces developments in the region from the oil revolution of 1973 4 through the iranian revolution the iran iraq war and the gulf war of 1990 1 to the toppling of saddam hussein in the american led invasion of iraq in 2003 bringing the story of gulf regional politics up to 2008 the book highlights transnational identity issues regime security and the politics of the world oil market and charts the changing mix of interests and ambitions driving american policy the author brings his experience as a scholar and commentator on the gulf to this riveting account of one of the most politically volatile regions on earth

what were the reasons behind the terrorist attacks of september 11th does the cause of islamist terrorism relate to the lack of democracy in the middle east through detailed research into the activities of both radical and moderate organizations across the middle east such as the muslim brotherhood hamas and hizbullah and via interviews with key personnel katerina dalacoura investigates whether repression and political exclusion pushed islamist entities to adopt terrorist tactics she also explores whether inclusion in the political process has had the opposite effect of

encouraging islamist groups toward moderation and ideological pragmatism in a challenge to the conventional wisdom she concludes that islamist terrorism is not a direct consequence of authoritarianism in the middle east and that there are many key factors that generate radicalism

virtually every trouble spot on the planet has some sort of religious component one need only consider iraq and afghanistan iran israel and palestine turkey india pakistan russia and china to name but a few looming behind national issues of course is the problem of regional islamist extremism and transnational islamist terrorism in all of these sectors religious tensions ideas and actors are of great geo political importance to the united states yet argues thomas farr our foreign policy is gravely handicapped by an inability to understand the role of religion either nationally or globally there is a strong disinclination in american diplomacy to consider religious factors at all either as part of the problem or part of the solution in this engaging and well written insider account farr offers a closely reasoned argument that religious freedom the freedom to practice one s own religion in private and in public is an essential prerequisite for a stable durable democratic society if the u s wants to foster democracy that lasts he says it must focus on fostering religious liberty especially in its public manifestations properly limited in a way that advances the common good although we ourselves have developed a remarkably successful model of religious freedom our foreign policy favors an aggressive secularism that is at odds with the american model it is essential says farr that we take an approach that recognizes the great importance of religion in people s lives

in the blur between innocence and experience stands chezdon morrison a sixteen year old australian with a silver spoon and a craving for chaos in innocence waning part 1 dive into a literary coming of age tale where privilege collides with poor choices and desire dances with self destruction chezdon isn t just chasing experience he s sprinting toward it tearing through the velvet curtain of adolescence into a world stitched together with sex secrets and the slow unravelling of self among drug fueled nights and neon lit decisions chezdon battles not just the temptations around him but the dysfunction that raised him wealth offers no protection from heartbreak or betrayal and each choice echoes louder than the last his words carry weight his

actions shape fates and the lines between right and ruin blur by the day this is no sugar coated journey it's raw queer brutal honest and darkly tender with mentors who mislead and peers who push boundaries chezdon is forced to navigate a maze of lust loyalty and loss where every wrong turn could be the one he doesn't return from will chezdon find himself before he's completely undone or is this just the beginning of his fall if you like your fiction messy magnetic and unapologetically human innocence waning will pull you deep and won't let go

an exclusive inside account of how and why al Qaeda is rebuilding in the unforgiving deserts of Yemen exhausted and on the run it looked like the end for the small band of men looking at the few who had followed him into the desert Muhammad said when disaster threatens seek refuge in Yemen Yemen was the last refuge far from the battlefields of Iraq and Afghanistan in an unforgiving corner of Arabia the US and al Qaeda are fighting a clandestine war of drones and suicide bombers the battles began in 2006 when twenty three men tunneled out of a maximum security prison in Yemen's capital to their freedom later they were joined by a dozen men released from Guantanamo Bay together they formed the core of al Qaeda on the Arabian Peninsula and now they and their recruits stand ready to hijack the Arab Spring from the streets of Syria to hotspots much closer to home in the last refuge al Qaeda scholar Gregory D. Johnsen charts the rise the fall and the ultimate resurrection of al Qaeda in Yemen given new life through a combustion of civil wars Afghan refugees and Muhammad's prophetic teachings Johnsen brings us inside al Qaeda's training camps and safe houses as the terrorists plot poison attacks and debate how to bring down a plane on Christmas Day based on years of on the ground interviews and never before translated al Qaeda battle notes he delivers a riveting and incisive investigation of the state of the Middle East

this book analyzes Hollywood storytelling that features an American crimefighter whether cop detective or agent who must safeguard society and the nation by any means necessary that often means going rogue and breaking the rules even deploying ugly violence but excused as self defense or to serve the greater good this ends justifies means approach dates back to gunfighters taming the western frontier to urban cowboy cops battling urban savagery first personified by Dirty Harry Callahan and later dispatched in global interventions to vanquish threats to national security America as the world's policeman often means controlling the other at home and abroad which also extends American hegemony from the Cold War through the war on terror this book also examines pioneering portrayals by males of color and female crimefighters to embody such a social or national defender which are frustrated by their existence as threats the white knight exists to defeat

from journalistic accounts like *Fiasco* and *Imperial Life in the Emerald City* to insider memoirs like *Jawbreaker* and *Three Cups of Tea* the books about America's wars in Iraq and Afghanistan could fill a library but each explores a narrow slice of a whole two wars launched by a single president as part of a single foreign policy now noted historian Terry H. Anderson examines them together in a single comprehensive overview shortly after the terrorist attacks of September 11 2001 president George W. Bush told advisor Karl Rove I am here for a reason and this is how we're going to be judged Anderson provides this judgment in this sweeping authoritative account of Bush's war on terror and his twin interventions he begins with historical surveys of Iraq and Afghanistan known respectively as the improbable country and the graveyard of empires and he examines US policies toward those and other nations in the Middle East from the 1970s to 2000 then Anderson focuses on the Bush administration carrying us through such events as the terrorist's attacks of 9/11 the invasion of Afghanistan and the siege of Tora Bora the axis of evil speech the invasion of Iraq and capture of Baghdad and the eruption of insurgency in Iraq he ranges from RPGs slamming into Abrams tanks to cabinet meetings vividly portraying both soldiers in the field and such policymakers as Dick Cheney and Condoleezza Rice Anderson describes the counter insurgency strategy embodied by the surge in Iraq and the simultaneous

revival of the taliban he concludes with an assessment of the prosecution of the wars in the first years of barack obama s presidency carefully researched and briskly narrated bush s wars provides the single volume balanced history that we have been waiting for

this book offers an examination of the signature weapon of barack obama s presidency his speeches it provides an in depth analytical look at the words of barack obama through the social and cultural contexts that made the content of his speeches timeless the book draws on the oral tradition of the black church in order to help explain aspects of the president s speaking style and to establish a direct link between the president s words and actions

the un outlawed genocide in 1948 and the united states launched a war on terror in 2001 yet still today neither genocide nor terrorism shows any sign of abating this book explains why those efforts have fallen short and identifies policies that can prevent such carnage the key is getting the causation analysis right conventional wisdom emphasizes ancient hatreds poverty and the impact of western colonialism as drivers of mass violence but far more important is the inciting power of mass ideological hate propaganda this is what activates the drive to commit mass atrocities and creates the multitude of perpetrators needed to conduct a genocide or sustain a terror campaign a secondary causal factor is illiberal dualistic political culture this is the breeding ground for the extremist us vs them ideologies that always precipitate episodes of mass hate incitement a two tiered policy response naturally follows from this analysis in the short term several targeted interventions to curtail outbreaks of such incitement and in the long term support for indigenous agents of liberalization in venues most at risk for ideologically driven violence

2009 outstanding academic title choice this groundbreaking volume examines the rise and spread of suicide attacks over the past decade sorting through 1 270 terror strikes between 1981 and 2007 assaf moghadam attributes their recent proliferation to the mutually related ascendance of al qaeda and its guiding ideology salafi jihad an extreme interpretation of islam that rejects national boundaries and seeks to create a global muslim community in exploring the roots of the extreme radicalization represented by salafism moghadam finds many causes including western dominance in the arab world the physical diffusion of salafi institutions and actors and the element of opportunity created by the soviet invasion of afghanistan he uses individual examples from the middle east southwest asia and europe to show how the elite leaders of al qaeda and affiliated groups and their foot soldiers interact with one another and how they garner support and a growing number of converts and attackers from the muslim community based on over a decade of empirical research and a critical examination of existing thought on suicide attacks moghadam distinguishes the key characteristics separating globalized suicide strikes from the traditional localized pattern that previously prevailed this unflinching analysis provides new information about the relationship between ideology and suicide attacks and recommends policies focused on containing salafi jihadism

experts in the intelligence community say that torture is ineffective yet much of the public appears unconvinced surveys show that nearly half of americans think that torture can be acceptable for counterterrorism purposes why do people persist in supporting torture and can they be persuaded to change their minds in tortured logic erin m kearns and joseph k young

draw upon a novel series of group experiments to understand how and why the average citizen might come to support the use of torture techniques they find evidence that when torture is depicted as effective in the media people are more likely to approve of it their analysis weighs variables such as the ethnicity of the interrogator and the suspect the salience of one's own mortality and framing by experts kearns and young also examine who changes their opinions about torture and how demonstrating that only some individuals have fixed views while others have more malleable beliefs they argue that efforts to reduce support for torture should focus on convincing those with fluid views that torture is ineffective the book features interviews with experienced interrogators and professionals working in the field to contextualize its findings bringing empirical rigor to a fraught topic tortured logic has important implications for understanding public perceptions of counterterrorism strategy
