traces the transformation of the united states from an agrarian isolationist nation into a liberal industrialized power entangled in foreign affairs in spite of itself

this is the first book to offer a comprehensive look at american life in the 1920s as framed by the aspirations scandals and attitudes of the wilson harding coolidge and hoover presidencies in fascinating detail goldberg examines how victorian values were transformed into the freewheeling lifestyle of the jazz age and explores the effects of such far reaching issues as isolationism vs internationalism massive immigration labor management relations and the prevalence of big business even as he pierces the era's claim to being a time of wonderful nonsense goldberg balances its giddy fads and foibles with a stinging critique of darker and or significant social issues from the rise of the ku klux klan to black protests to the scopes monkey trial from bootlegging and prohibition to the red scare goldberg shows how the temper of the 1920s shaped the nation's future finally he poses provocative questions about how mistakes might have been avoided and what consequences ensued

in this stimulating volume stephen m krason considers whether the founding fathers vision of the american democratic republic has been transformed and if so in what ways he looks to the basic principles of the founding fathers then discusses the changes that resulted from evolving contemporary expectations about government referencing philosophical principles and the work of great western thinkers krason then explores a variety of proposals that could forge a foundation for restoration acknowledging that any attempt to revive the founders views on a democratic republic must start in the public sphere krason focuses on concerned citizens who are aware of the extent to which our current political structures deviate from the founders vision and want to take action ultimately a democratic republic can exist be sustained and flourish only when there is a deep commitment to it in the minds and norms of its people written by a foremost authority in the field of us constitutional law this book will appeal to those interested in american history society and politics

world war i marked the first war in which the united states government and military took full responsibility for the identification burial and memorialization of those killed in battle and as a result the process of burying and remembering the dead became intensely political the government and military attempted to create a patriotic consensus on the historical memory of world war i in which war dead were not only honored but used as a symbol to legitimize america s participation in a war not fully supported by all citizens in this book the author unpacks the politics and processes of the competing interest groups involved in the three core components of commemoration repatriation remembrance and return this book emphasizes the inherent tensions in the politics of memorialization and explores how those interests often conflicted with the needs of veterans and relatives

in 1916 philadelphia department store magnate john wanamaker launched plans for a sesqui centennial international exposition in 1926 it would be a magnificent world s fair to celebrate the 150th anniversary of the declaration of independence the sesqui would also transform sooty industrial philadelphia into a beautiful beaux arts city however when the sesqui opened

on may 31 1926 in the remote muddy swamps of south philadelphia the fair was unfinished with a few shabbily built and mostly empty structures crowds stayed away in droves fewer than five million paying customers attended costing the city millions of dollars philadelphia became a national scandal a city so corrupt that one political boss could kidnap an entire world s fair in his fascinating history sesqui noted historian thomas keels situates this ill fated celebration a personal boondoggle by the all powerful congressman william s vare against the transformations taking place in america during the 1920s keels provides a comprehensive account of the sesqui as a meeting ground for cultural changes sweeping the country women s and african american rights anti semitism eugenics prohibition and technological advances

from the new york times bestselling author of democracy awakening the most comprehensive account of the gop and its competing impulses los angeles times when abraham lincoln helped create the republican party on the eve of the civil war his goal was to promote economic opportunity for all americans not just the slaveholding southern planters who steered national politics yet despite the egalitarian dream at the heart of its founding the republican party quickly became mired in a fundamental identity crisis would it be the party of democratic ideals or would it be the party of moneyed interests in the century and a half since republicans have vacillated between these two poles with dire economic political and moral repercussions for the entire nation in to make men free celebrated historian heather cox richardson traces the shifting ideology of the grand old party from the antebellum era to the great recession revealing the insidious cycle of boom and bust that has characterized the party since its

inception while in office progressive republicans like teddy roosevelt and dwight eisenhower revived lincoln s vision of economic freedom and expanded the government attacking the concentration of wealth and nurturing upward mobility but they and others like them have been continually thwarted by powerful business interests in the party their opponents appealed to americans latent racism and xenophobia to regain political power linking taxation and regulation to redistribution and socialism the results of the party s wholesale embrace of big business are all too familiar financial collapses like the panic of 1893 the great depression in 1929 and the great recession in 2008 with each passing decade with each missed opportunity and political misstep the schism within the republican party has grown wider pulling the gop ever further from its founding principles expansive and authoritative to make men free is a sweeping history of the party that was once america s greatest political hope and time and time again has proved its greatest disappointment

from 1922 to 1936 the presbyterian church in the u s a was torn by conflict fundamentalists led by clarence e macartney william jennings bryan and j gresham machen modernists guided by henry sloane coffin and moderates directed by charles r erdman and robert e speer struggled over theological questions and their implications for such issues as ordination requirements the role of princeton theological seminary and foreign missions the church managed to maintain its institutional unity at the height of the conflict in the mid 1920s but the struggle resulted in a loosening of the church s doctrinal standards the reorganization of princeton seminary the founding of westminster theological seminary and the eventual birth of the presbyterian church of america weaving together the history of this ecclesiastical conflict with biographies of the six leaders longfield shows that theological concerns though primary were not the only issues in the struggle he demonstrates that social and cultural considerations profoundly contributed to the roles of the leaders and to the outcome of the conflict finally longfield traces the current decline of the presbyterian church and other mainline denominations back to this period arguing that by embracing doctrinal pluralism they undermined the very foundations of their mission to the world he concludes that renewal can only be based on a biblical and creedal faith distinct from the values and norms of the surrounding culture

hollywood in crisis is a detailed study of the workings of the american film industry during the 1930s colin schindler looking at hollywood as an agent of roosevelt s new deal and the attempts made by film moguls and movie makers to withstand the political turmoil that

threatened to engulf america schindler illustrates how the studios and their products from the glamour of mgm stars and escapist musicals to gangster movies and westerns even to the radical films of the warner studios helped foster ideas of social unity and patriotism

fdr s republicans illuminates the debate over foreign policy that took place in the united states prior to world war ii robert e jenner approaches this issue from the perspective of republican members of the house and senate who eventually came to support the interventionist position of a democratic president unlike other diplomatic histories of this period fdr s republicans focuses on domestic components of the foreign policy debate combining historical analysis and political theory jenner recounts the republican party s internationalist roots under mckinley the split of 1912 and the defeat of the league of nations in deference to its agrarian progressive wing taking both a local and national approach he provides in depth analysis of the party s reaction to the fdr landslides of 1932 and 1936 the party s resurgence in 1938 fdr s aggressive defense of the new deal and the decline of the party s agrarian progressive faction the result is a broader explanation of the battle that raged between isolationists and interventionists as well as the failure of policy makers to deter fascism at an earlier date

this volume is a study of the career of robert lansing woodrow wilsons secretary of state from 1915 to 1920 holding this office during the neutrality period americas entry into world war i and the peace negotiations that followed his was an important position at a critical juncture in american history while many historians have dismissed lansings contributions as insubstantial this author believes otherwise this work will show that in nudging a reluctant president toward war with germany lansing was persuasive indeed his most important contributions however came after wilson returned to the united states in 1919 and became incapacitated during the fight for ratification of the treaty of versailles in the months that followed lansing took the position of leadership in the cabinet holding important meetings on all of the issues of the day and reassuring the nation that the executive branch of government still functioned he also helped to resolve critical mexican and russian issues finally and most importantly during this period lansing was in league with the strong reservations in attempting to force wilson to accept modifications to the treaty as a condition for ratification in this regard he provided the republican opposition with important information regarding compromises made at paris and the feelings of both himself and other commissioners as to flaws in the treaty throughout his career lansing was a strong proponent of his views on the key issues of the day sadly when faced with a president of equally strong views often different from his own lansing resorted to

indirection deception and ultimately disloyalty in attempting to achieve his objectives in the end
lansings many positive contributions were diminished by the actions of his final days

annotation in the summer of 1955 six african american golfers in beaumont texas began attacking the jim crow caste system when they filed a federal lawsuit for the right to play the municipal golf course the golfers and their african american lawyers went to federal court and asked a conservative white republican judge to render a decision that would not only integrate the local golf course but also set precedent for desegregation of other public facilities in fair ways robert j robertson chronicles three parallel stories that converged in this important case he tells the story of the plaintiffs avid golfers who had learned the game while working as caddies and waiters of their young lawyers recent graduates from howard university law school and of the republican judge just appointed to the bench by president eisenhower using public case papers public records newspapers and oral histories robertson has recreated the scene in beaumont on the eve of desegregation fair ways gives a vivid picture of racial segregation and the forces that brought about its end

as a study of modern american political culture beyond left and right gets high marks this is an extremely readable book it should quickly become a basic source especially beneficial to scholars who are researching modern american political history lay readers with an interest in american politics should find it informative and accessible horowitz explains his ideas in clear direct prose free of jargon leroy ashby author of william jennings bryan champion of democracy beyond left and right is a sweeping overview of political insurgency in the united states from the 1880s to the present it is at once a stunning synthesis drawing on a large number of scholarly works and an ambitious and original piece of research the book ranges over diverse individuals and groups that have attacked the established order from the left and the right from the populists of the 1890s to ross perot and the religious right of our times dealing along the way with non interventionists klans monetary radicals mccarthyites birchers and reaganites among many others

the revolution of 28 explores the career of new york governor and 1928 democratic presidential nominee alfred e smith robert chiles peers into smith s work and uncovers a distinctive strain of american progressivism that resonated among urban ethnic working class americans in the early twentieth century the book charts the rise of that idiomatic progressivism during smith s early years as a state legislator through his time as governor of the empire state in the 1920s before proceeding to a revisionist narrative of the 1928

presidential campaign exploring the ways in which smith's gubernatorial progressivism was presented to a national audience as chiles points out new stock voters responded enthusiastically to smith's candidacy on both economic and cultural levels chiles offers a historical argument that describes the impact of this coalition on the new liberal formation that was to come with franklin delano roosevelt's new deal demonstrating the broad practical consequences of smith's political career in particular chiles notes how smith's progressive agenda became democratic partisan dogma and a rallying point for policy formation and electoral success at the state and national levels chiles sets the record straight in the revolution of 28 by paying close attention to how smith identified and activated his emergent coalition and put it to use in his campaign of 1928 before quickly losing control over it after his failed presidential bid

this volume is the first comprehensive examination of african american conservative thought and politics from the late eighteenth century to the present the essays in the collection explore various aspects of african american conservatism including biographical studies of abolitionist james fortin clergymen henry mcneal turner and j h jackson and activists a philip randolph and bayard rustin thematic essays in the volume consider southern black conservatism in the late nineteenth century and after world war i african american success manuals ellisonian cultural criticism the nation of islam and african americans and the republican party after 1964

this first book length treatment of the life and work of christine frederick 1883 1970 reveals an important dilemma that faced educated women of the early twentieth century contrary to her professional role as home efficiency expert advertising consultant and consumer advocate christine frederick espoused the nineteenth century ideal of preserving the virtuous home and a woman's place in it in an effort to reconcile her desire to succeed in the public sphere of modernization and consumerism with the knowledge that most middle class americans still held traditional beliefs about gender roles frederick fashioned a career for herself that encouraged other women to remain at home with the rise of home economics and scientific management frederick college educated but confined to the drudgery of housework devised a plan for bringing the public sphere into the domestic her home would become her factory she learned how to standardize tasks by observing labor saving devices in industry and then applied this knowledge to housework she standardized dishwashing for example by breaking the job into three separate operations scraping and stacking washing and drying and putting away determined to train women to become proficient homemakers and efficient managers

frederick secured a job writing articles for the ladies home journal a professional career as home efficiency expert later expanded to include advertising consultant and consumer advocate frederick assured male advertisers that she knew women well and promised to help them sell to mrs consumer while frederick sought the power and influence available only to men she promoted a division of labor by gender and therefore served the fall of the early twentieth century wave of feminism rutherford s engaging account of christine frederick s life reflects a dilemma that continues to affect women today whether to seek professional gratification or adhere to traditional family values
