many early novels were cosmopolitan books read from london to leipzig and beyond available in nearly simultaneous translations into french english german and other european languages in novel translations bethany wiggin charts just one of the paths by which newness in its avatars as fashion novelties and the novel entered the european world in the decades around 1700 as readers across europe snapped up novels they domesticated the genre across borders the novel lent readers everywhere a suggestion of sophistication a familiarity with circumstances beyond their local ken into the eighteenth century the modern german novel was not german at all rather it was french as suggested by germans usage of the french word roman to describe a wide variety of genres pastoral romances war and travel chronicles heroic narratives and courtly fictions carried in large part on the coattails of the huguenot diaspora these romans nouvelles amours secrets histoires galantes and histoires scandaleuses shaped german literary culture to a previously unrecognized extent wiggin contends that this french chapter in the german novel's history began to draw to a close only in the 1720s more than sixty years after the word first migrated into german only gradually did the roman go native it remained laden with the baggage from its french origins even into the nineteenth century

this book aims to complement the traditional focus of translation studies which has primarily centered on translating english into other languages it presents a comprehensive analysis of the reverse translation trajectory exploring the movement of chinese literature into the core english literary domain the book aims to explore the ideological and sociological dynamics that underlie the translation of contemporary chinese novels this is achieved through an examination of the translation selection process translation paratexts and the roles of translation agents case studies are employed to illustrate specific linguistic literary and cultural challenges within translation it dissects the cultural and literary implications of translating genres such as women s writing science fiction and internet literature the argument presented is that the translation of peripheral literature is indispensable in shaping global literature beyond its literary implications the book identifies the political significance inherent in such reverse translation endeavors it suggests that the translation of chinese literature holds notable political interest for the chinese government which aims to reshape china s image and bolster the nation s soft power through literary translation this work will be an essential read to students and scholars of translation studies comparative literature and chinese studies

charles lutwidge dodgson known better by his pseudonym lewis carroll was a 19th century english logician mathematician photographer and novelist he is especially remembered for his children s tale alice s adventures in wonderland and its sequel through the looking glass by the time of dodgson s death in 1898 alice the integration of the two volumes had become the most popular children s book in england by the time of his centenary in 1932 it was perhaps the most famous in the world this book presents a complete catalogue of dodgson s personal library with attention to every book the author is known to have owned or read alphabetized entries fully describe each book its edition its contents its importance and any particular relevance it might have had to dodgson the library not only provides a plethora of fodder for further study on dodgson but also reflects the victorian world of the second half of the 19th century a time of unprecedented investigation experimentation invention and imagination dodgson s volumes represent a vast array of academic interests from victorian england and beyond including homeopathic medicine spiritualism astrology evolution women s rights children s literature linguistics theology eugenics and many others the catalogue is designed for scholars seeking insight into the mind of charles dodgson through his books

the book is based on hundreds of oral histories conducted in europe and north america with survivors who were children in the holocaust primary documentation uncovered by the author including diaries letters photographs and family albums and archival records drawing on these sources dwork reveals the feeling daily activities and perceptions of jewish children who lived and died in the shadow of holocaust she reconstructs and analyzes the many different experiences the children faced in the early years of nazi domination they lived at home increasingly oppressed by rising anti semitism later some went into hiding while others attempted to live openly on gentile papers as time passed more and more were forced into transit camps ghettos and death and slave labour camps although nearly 90 percent of the jewish children in nazi europe were murdered we learn in this history not of their deaths but of the circumstances of their lives

in his autobiography speak memory vladimir nabokov compared his life to a spiral in which twirl follows twirl and every synthesis is the thesis of the next series the first four arcs of the spiral of nabokov s life his youth in russia voluntary exile in europe two decades spent in the united states and the final years of his life in switzerland are now followed by a fifth arc his continuing life in literary history which this volume both explores and symbolizes this is the first collection of essays to examine all five arcs of nabokov s creative life through close analyses of representative works the essays cast new light on works both famous and neglected and place these works against the backgrounds of nabokov s career as a whole and modern literature in general nabokov analyzes his own artistry in his postscript to the russian edition of lolita presented here in its first english translation and in his little known notes to ada by vivian darkbloom published now for the first time in america and keyed to the standard u s editions of the novel in addition to a defense of his father s work by dmitri nabokov and a portrait interview by alfred appel jr the volume presents a vast spectrum of critical analyses covering all nabokov s major novels and several important short stories the highly original structure of the book and the fresh and often startling revelations of the essays dramatize as never before the unity and richness of nabokov s unique literary achievement
