a survey of thomas merton's thought on fundamental aspects of monastic formation and spirituality which also addresses some of the temptations and popular misunderstandings surrounding monastic life

thinking is a dynamic process resulting from practices of integration thought encounters in openness wonder receptivity and contemplation confer upon us intellectual work that is uniquely our own digital patterns however distract us from these creative encounters our intellectual searching is weakened and fragmented by frenetic consumption of information we miss out on reason's innate pull toward integration and concrete reality this book is an invitation to enter into openness wonder receptivity and contemplation with deeper understanding and intentionality we can do this by considering exemplars persons who lived out the integrity of their hard won beliefs each process of integration is applied also so that practical knowledge and practice become a way into this intellectual restoration we need deeper knowledge won in the slow orbit of encounters encounters in thought are precisely what each generation needs to apprehend the cosmos nature authority truth and moral action responsibility to this ecologic age requires a reform of reason this book is just one attempt to convey a way toward this restoration

thomas merton recognized the value and possibility of contemplative dialogue between monastics and contemplatives of other religious traditions and hoped that through such dialogue monastics would strive for inter monastic communion and a bonding of the broader spiritual family he held out hope that this bond would demonstrate the fundamental unity of humanity to a world that was becoming ever more materialistic and divided among other themes and topics this book explores thomas merton's role as a pioneer of buddhist christian dialogue and monastic interreligious dialogue it delves into the process of merton's self transformation through contemplative experiences explores his encounter with zen and tibetan buddhists and his pioneering engagements in buddhist christian dialogue and presents and responds to the criticisms of those who raise questions about merton's understanding of buddhism fr jaechan anselmo park osb articulates and analyzes the influences of buddhist theory and practice on thomas merton's contemplative spirituality and shows how merton's legacy has influenced and

continues to inspire interreligious and inter monastic dialogue particularly in an asian monastic context

henri nouwen wisely said the great illusion of leadership is to think that man can be led out of the desert by someone who has never been there jesus has been there and knows how to lead us out but first he just may lead us in he meets us in the desert and does his best work in us there we look for an easier way in vain i myself reluctantly entered the desert and eventually received unimagined gifts there gifts i didn t ask for deserve or want gifts hidden in such painful loss that i despaired and yet looking back now these desert gifts were the best thing that ever happened to me i entered the desert and years later found my way out it s not a new way it was just new to me jewish and christian sages had been living it for thousands of years somehow in recent generations we managed to forget it in this collection i mean to begin to make those riches available to you i m hoping that like me you ll discover something that you didn t know you wanted or needed and something now you wouldn t give up at any price

examines the role of sophia divine wisdom in the writings of thomas merton a more personal and less academic presentation than in sophia the hidden christ of thomas merton the author s earlier book on this topic

superabundantly alive thomas merton s dance with the feminine is a unique unified multi genre work that includes dialogue imaginary letters poems and reflective essays by two established canadian poets taking cues from merton himself susan and john establish a playful jazzy dialogic tone superabundantly alive this book invites participation for those who already know merton s work and for those who are meeting this whole and broken prophetic whimsical paradoxical prophet and visionary for the first time robert lax once described merton s poetry and the man himself as superabundantly alive mccaslin and porter prove the truth of this description in their enchanting account of the writer mystic who now comes into his second century of stature and significance in the words of boris pasternak a live and burning to the end

this groundbreaking new source of international scope defines the essay as nonfictional prose texts of between one and 50 pages in length the more than 500 entries by 275 contributors include entries on nationalities various categories of essays such as generic such as sermons aphorisms individual major works notable writers and periodicals that created a market for essays and particularly famous or significant essays the preface details the historical development of the essay and the alphabetically arranged entries usually include biographical sketch nationality era selected writings list additional readings and anthologies

in exploring the role of catholic intellectuals in engaging science and technology in the twentieth century this book initially provides a background context for this evolution by examining the modernism crisis in the first chapter in order to unpack the subsequent evolution thompson then concentrates in separate chapters on the distinctive contributions of four specific catholic intellectuals jacques maritain 1882d1973 pierre teilhard de chardin 1881d1955 bernard lonergan 1904d1984 and thomas merton 1915d1968 all of these intellectuals experienced some degree of official restraint in their efforts but through their distinctive intellectual trajectories they contributed to a different engagement of the church with science and technology in the final chapters the book first reviews the changes within the institutional church in the twentieth century toward science and technology finally it then applies some key ideals of the four intellectuals to anneal and extend john paul ii s approach of critical openness to suggest how the church can now engage science and technology

how catholic was thomas merton since his death in 1968 merton s catholic identity has been regularly questioned both by those who doubt the authenticity of his catholicism given his

commitment to ecumenical and interreligious dialogue and by those who admire merton as a thinker but see him as an aberration who rebelled against his catholicism to articulate ideas that went against the church in this book gregory k hillis illustrates that merton's thought was intertwined with his identity as a catholic priest and emerged out of a thorough immersion in the church's liturgical theological and spiritual tradition in addition to providing a substantive introduction to merton's life and thought this book illustrates that merton was fundamentally shaped by his identity as a roman catholic

part iii the terrain of literature features greene's examination of a variety of literary approaches to literature in an era when the subject needs to be referred as well to cognitive science as more conventional critical modes even deconstruction that have long defined it additionally he illuminates important works by writers as various as jane austen and evelyn waugh these essays as well as the book as a whole are framed here by greene's assessment of canadian literature that calls attention to the native terrain that he originally called home and how the latter contributed to the making of one of the most cosmopolitan scholars of his era jacket

this book proposes a method for making educational systems and their curriculum leaderships in sub saharan africa particularly uganda relevant functional and generative in the current unfolding of a fast paced technology driven future that prompts questions about educational leadership in a society where many traditional educational systems are failing the book poses the following question what might constitute effective leadership in our heightened global nexus of realities often described as globalization nonhuman technologies are moving people away from connections that once strengthened human relationships and fostered collective actions too many workplace pressures and demands cause educational leaders to function on autopilot without involving others in the process of mindful leadership of educational reform focusing on mindfulness its application in different educational settings and its advantages for educational leadership this book argues that contemporary meditation practices and their benefits can inform effective successful twenty first century leadership practices in africa particularly uganda it draws on numerous theories from literature in the fields of business and management medicine psychology theology and the social and behavioral sciences the selected theories represent the growing research grounded in contemporary thoughts on leadership epistemology with inclination toward the mindfulness that grows out of regular practice of meditation the book concludes with the argument that collective mindful educational leadership emerges when all stakeholders are able to participate in the leadership of their institution or school and contribute to the entire systems development if practiced regularly mindfulness would conduce to healthier collaborative behavior that would markedly improve ugandan and other african educational systems this kind of mindful leadership requires each stakeholder to lead from inside the self and interconnection with others in a profound way this means leading by listening attentively and intently and embracing one another's voice nonjudgmentally for the common good

the analysis of the relationship between center and periphery is one of many theoretical approaches found in all fields of the humanities looking at this special relationship from several disciplinary perspectives is an effective methodology for establishing connections between various fields of study consequently the issue contains articles dealing with among others the russian enterprise in alaska german polar exploration gender in islamic contexts in europe labor relations economic securitization cultural nationalism in ghana and robert rodriguez's movie machete the historical perspective of cultural reception the economic relationship between central and peripheral areas as well as the development of stereotypes as a consequence of the exchange between both areas are also part of the discussion the first issue of global humanities therefore provides a broad outlook on the periphery center relationship giving the interested reader an insight into the different working fields of several disciplines within the humanities it furthermore can be considered an argument for strengthening interdisciplinary work in the future highlighting the interconnectedness of history literature art politics and many other disciplines

the works collected in this volume provide an illuminating introduction to george eliot s incisive views on religion art and science and the nature and purpose of fiction essays such as evangelical teaching show her rejecting her earlier religious beliefs while woman in france questions conventional ideas about female virtues and marriage and notes on form in art sets out theories of idealism and realism that she developed further in middlemarch and daniel deronda it also includes selections from eliot s translations of works by strauss and feuerbach that challenged many ideas about christianity excerpts from her poems and reviews of writers such as wollstonecraft goethe and browning wonderfully rich in imagery and observations these pieces reveal the intellectual development of this most challenging and rewarding of writers

this book presents a novel understanding of the break up of communist hegemony in east germany and eastern europe based on comparative case studies it argues that identity politics is a particular invention of communist rule producing a political citizen focusing upon identity politics helps us better to understand the longterm stability of communist hegemony its sudden collapse the difficulties of transforming communist societies to liberal democracies and the unexpected revival of ethnic nationalist and cultural conflicts in post communist eastern europe

stanley aronowitz traces the history of the cultural issue in both british and american manifestations

on the surface christianity and zen buddhism can appear to be worlds apart even antithetical christianity affirms the reality of the tri personal god and the eternal salvation of mortal human beings zen denies both the existence of god and the soul yet thomas merton the catholic spiritual master and d t suzuki the famous teacher of zen engaged in an extensive dialogue and found ways of mutually affirming shared meanings of god and person that each regarded to be true this book explores that dialogue within the larger context of merton s attraction to buddhism and considers the implications of their achievement for contemporary theologies of religious pluralism

this book synthesizes the diverse reflections on technology by monk and spiritual writer thomas merton to develop a compelling contemplative critique of the threats and challenges of nuclear war communication technologies and biotechnologies that may alter what it means to be human at the core of his critique merton opposes a technological mentality that favors processes of efficiency and utility at the expense of our ultimate purpose a quest for the wisdom to guide us to the divine source of our being and reality to counter this modern idolatry merton s insights offer a path of reflection balance and community more specifically merton offers some constructive approaches and healing possibilities through a balanced approach to work a careful and intentional managing of technology and an accessing of the recuperative dimensions of nature in its conclusion the book brings the insights of these chapters together for a final reflection on how to maintain our humanity and our spiritual integrity in a technological world

providing an intimate and timely view of merton this book traces the theme of peace and nonviolence in merton s life and writings drawing in particular on extensive correspondence with jim forest a merton biographer

pluralism on and off course explains the concept of pluralism as a trend that strives to restrict centralism the book classifies as pluralistic every trend that opposes uniformity both in social and political structure and in the sphere of culture the uniformity that centralism inevitably breeds organized into six chapters this book particularly tackles pluralism in france britain germany and united states this text also describes the pluralistic elements in the socialist reconstruction of society the rationality of pluralism is lastly discussed

in spatializing social justice literary critiques maryann p diedwardo uses seven literary critiques and seven reflections to share her newest research about the healing power of literature diedwardo argues that literacy is the lifelong intellectual process of gaining meaning from a critical interpretation of written or printed text literary critiques explore the writer s mind for

symbolism hidden within the words and writers of literary critiques listen to their own voices first in this book diedwardo touches upon different types of writing and writers who aim to explore the healing process through words

christian mysticism is unique in its view of jesus death and resurrection as the very cause and exemplar of the mystical life in all its purity jesus saving death on the cross exemplifies the mystical letting go of everything consoling tangible and finite in order to surrender totally to the mystery of the father s unconditional love in this introduction to christian mysticism reverend harvey egan s j presents four christian mystics as paradigms of the classical tradition st ignatius of loyola st teresa of avila st john of the cross and the unknown author of the cloud of unknowing from this foundation he moves to two contemporary figures thomas merton and pierre teilhard de chardin each of whom reflects a contemporary transposition of the two mystical traditions the apophatic which emphasizes the radical difference between god and creatures and the kataphatic which emphasizes the similarity between god and creatures
