an incredibly moving book detailing the life of a medium and giving insight into life after death gordon smith the uk s most highly respected medium is well known for giving powerful messages from loved ones on the other side to bring healing to people who are devastated and immobilized by grief in this powerful and inspirational book gordon opens a window into his life to describe how the world looks through his eyes he walks the reader through his spirit filled world and answers questions about death that haunt the bereaved many of the people that gordon has brought healing and comfort to are happy for him to tell their story in this book in the hope that it will help others who are experiencing intense grief gordon hopes that this intimate and candid book will offer great wisdom comfort and practical advice to his thousands of readers

through my eyes are the diaries of belle munro as imagined by her grand daughter frances margaret munro it chronicles the life and times of the munro family from their arrival in saskatoon in 1908 through to the end of the first world war through my eyes provides an intimate picture of both the early days of saskatoon and of a family living in extraordinary times

what s meant to be is written among the stars in the heavens above the clouds air whiffed

this book begins with the story of a young boy rem vandenberg who was born in 1937 in the netherlands just before the onslaught of the second world war his youth was a struggle to exist under the german occupation and in combating the depravation of poverty added to these hardships was the ongoing personal battle he fought daily in accepting the doctrines of the roman

catholic church which were heavily imposed on him by the uncompromising adult belief of the time his authoritarian father loaded with the responsibility of caring for the large family was staunch in upholding his strong principles and instilling them into his children of a less serious nature and with a strong desire to be free of the bonds restricting him from freedom of expression and thought rem was often on the punitive end of the discipline rod both at school and home opposing this oppression was the endless love and compassion of his mother who through the strength of her faith was able to engulf the whole family under her mantle of love and bind them together into a caring family unit at a young age rem had to begin work to help support the family what he was expected to do for a few cents per week was beyond the capability of this small undernourished lad his father insisted on strength of character and allowed him to be pushed to the limit of his endurance held by the love of his family but tormented with the urge to be free of restrictions rem finally took his life in his own hands at the age of sixteen driven by the spirit of adventure he left home and joined the merchant navy his first voyage was on a whaling ship to the south pole which was followed by voyages throughout the world for the next few years on sailing into his first australian port his desire to stay in australia took over he jumped ship and went inland where he took a job on the railway after six months as gang worker he was finally picked up by the law and experienced a short jail sentence before being deported back to holland his love for australia was strong and within two years he returned as a legal migrant and still lives in his beloved land today

in this book eva pilch cleverly expresses the way she sees things through her eyes in inspiring poetry she also shows you the things she literally saw through her eyes in photographs which include everything from awe inspiring nature to her own unique displays of various messages explore the mind love hate happiness struggles social injustice and even the age old question of the meaning of life there are also some surprises it is a book that will capture you into curling up with it on the couch then you ll want to leave it on your coffee table to flip through and entertain your guests with

mosul iraq in the 1940s is a teeming multiethnic city where arabs kurds assyrians jews aramaeans turkmens yazidis and syriacs mingle in the ancient souks and alleyways in these crowded streets among rich and poor educated and illiterate pious and unbelieving a boy is growing up burdened with chores from an early age and afflicted with an older brother who persecutes him with mindless sadism the child finds happiness only in stolen moments with his beloved older sister and with friends in the streets closest to his heart are three girls encountered by chance a muslim a christian and a jew after enriching the boy s life immensely all three meet tragic fates leaving a wound in his heart that will not heal a richly textured portrayal of iraqi

society before the upheavals of the late twentieth century saeed's novel depicts a sensitive and loving child assailed by the cruelty of life sometimes defeated but never surrendering he is sustained by his city and its people

crying in h mart meets my sister the serial killer in this feminist psychological horror about the making of a female serial killer from a korean american perspective ji won's life tumbles into disarray in the wake of her appa's extramarital affair and subsequent departure her mother distraught her younger sister hurt and confused her college freshman grades failing her dreams horrifying yet enticing in them ji won walks through bloody rooms full of eyes succulent blue eyes salivatingly blue eyes eyes the same shape and shade as george's who is umma's obnoxious new boyfriend george has already overstayed his welcome in her family's claustrophobic apartment he brags about his puffed up consulting job ogles asian waitresses while dining out and acts condescending toward ji won and her sister as if he deserves all of umma's fawning adoration no george doesn't deserve anything from her family ji won will make sure of that for no matter how many victims accumulate around her campus or how many people she must deceive and manipulate ji won's hunger and her rage deserve to be sated a brilliantly inventive subversive novel about a young woman unraveling monika kim's the eyes are the best part is a story of a family falling apart and trying to find their way back to each other marking a bold new voice in horror that will leave readers mesmerized and craving more

the wax statue and other stories is a translated version of the short stories written by jeelani bano she is one of the most reputed literary figures in sawnet known for her supremacy in exposing the flaws of society before the readers jeelani bano keeps the pedal to the metal her stories are a mirror of the society of those days which are relevant even today her stories like moum ki maryam won great acclaim by the readers and literary men of that age in her stories she explores the diaspora feelings and the exploitation of the poor she is a critic of social evils her vim and vigour portrays the misery and suffering of women in a male dominated society her stories are solely objective she is never didactic in her tone and allows the readers to judge her approach is multidimensional and not a storm in a tea cup hence their translation into english will spread her message far and wide and serve the purpose of her writings my aim in translating her short stories into english is to convey the message to the non urdu readers and to enliven her literary talent in other languages

watch out for falling lizards is a non fiction novel regarding the life and adventures of keith huntington this book is intended for mature readers

the next full moon night is coming and i really don t want to be a rogue i need someone to help me by having sex with me the alpha murmured desperately heller was an alpha and he already had a mate that he loved mira but now he was desperately in need of a new one mira was in the hospital in a coma for a year but that was not the main reason for heller to find a new mate the main reason was more complicated he was supposed to have sex with his new and fated mate during the next full moon and quieten and placate his wolf to make him less disturbing and destructive and most importantly stop himself from turning to a rogue on that rainy monday morning heller met his fated mate leah it was ridiculous that the moon goddess would choose someone like her to be my mate she didn t even know she got werewolf blood running in her veins she just thought she was a damn human but for leah wasn t this whole thing more ridiculous could she end up being heller s luna or just his sex tool

a moving tale of loss and reaching out to the ones we love our narrator s days are numbered estranged from his family living alone with only his cat cabbage for company he was unprepared for the doctor s diagnosis that he has only months to live but before he can set about tackling his bucket list the devil appears with a special offer in exchange for making one thing in the world disappear he can have one extra day of life and so begins a very bizarre week because how do you decide what makes life worth living in dealing with the devil our narrator will take himself and his beloved cat to the brink genki kawamura s if cats disappeared from the world is a story of loss and reconciliation of one man s journey to discover what really matters in modern

life this beautiful tale is translated from the japanese by eric selland who also translated the guest cat by takashi hiraide if you re a fan of the guest cat or even just cats generally you ll love this sunday times

eye movements are a vital part of our interaction with the world they play a pivotal role in perception cognition and education research in this field is now proceeding at a considerable pace and casting new light on how the eyes move and what information we can derive during the frequent and brief periods of fixation however the origins of this work are less well known even though much of our knowledge was derived from this research with far more primitive equipment this book is unique in tracing the history of eye movement research it shows how great strides were made in this area before modern recording devices were available especially in the measurement of nystagmus when photographic techniques were adapted to measure discontinuous eye movements from about 1900 many of the issues that are now basic to modern research were then investigated one of the earliest cognitive tasks examined was reading and it remains in the vanguard of contemporary research modern researchers in this field will be astonished at the subtleties of these early experimental studies and the ingenuity of interpretations that were advanced one and even two centuries ago though physicians often carried out the original eye movement research later on it was pursued by psychologists it is within contemporary neuroscience that we find these two strands reunited anyone interested in the origins of psychology and neuroscience will find much to stimulate and surprise them in this valuable new work

the pulitzer prize winning poet and historian recalls his midwestern boyhood in this classic memoir born in a tiny cottage in galesburg illinois in 1878 carl sandburg grew with america as a boy he left school at the age of thirteen to embark on a life of work driving a milk wagon and serving as a hotel porter a bricklayer and a farm laborer before eventually finding his place in the world of literature in always the young strangers sandburg delivers a nostalgic view of small town life around the turn of the twentieth century and an invaluable perspective on american history

professor carmichael here proposes a convincing solution to a perplexing problem in biblical studies the order and arrangement of the deuteronomic laws he shows that deuteronomy is not a haphazard collection of fragments but rather a carefully constructed coherent literary work with a definite purpose through his analysis many of the peculiar features of the code are made intelligible for example the relationship between the laws and earlier stories sagas and historical narratives opening up a new approach to the interpretation of the laws this book makes an important contribution to the understanding of biblical material

the poems some of the poetic drama particularly sweeney agonistes and relevant sections of prose criticism are discussed in detail and placed in relation to the development of eliot's oeuvre and more briefly to his life and a wider context of philosophical and religious enquiry introduction

metaphors are a vital linguistic component of religious speech and serve as a cultural indicator of how groups understand themselves and the world the essays compiled in this volume analyze the use function and structure of metaphors in jewish writings from the hellenistic roman period including the works of philo and the texts of qumran as well as in apocryphal early christian texts and inscriptions

as one of the many passages of faith god preordained in my life journey to sunrise is a witness of conviction and gratefulness of a preachers kid pk as to the grace and mercy of christ jesus this is a chronological account of how christ jesus answered prayers from my heart and prayers prayed intellectually i had not yet become aware of how god and christ jesus had been working in my life from the age of twenty four when i was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis at which time i lost my eyesight for three months up to the point of yet another miraculous life altering event years later this event caused me to stay in a constant prayerful relationship with christ jesus more than ever before it caused me to build not only a stronger prayer life but also a more humbling and willfully trusting relationship with god the father and christ jesus okay youre probably thinking arent they the same lets see as god tells us in his word there is but one god none else isaiah 45 18 james 2 19 revelations 1 8 just to reference a few of his scriptures he is god the father to all and over all alpha the beginning the creator of all things and omega the end god the son our living example savior intercessor and comforter and god the holy spirit our ever present help our guide into all truth john 16 13 each one is distinct and equally necessary and is one as god is omnipresent in our lives at all times hebrew 13 5 this was a passage that was a blessing for and to me growing deeper into a more humbled willful genuine heart desiring an even greater presence of god the father my creator god the son christ jesus my savior and intercessor and god the holy spirit my ever present help it was a daily blessing god preordained for my family and friends chosen to be with me giving

me support and receiving the blessing of encouragement that he had waiting for us all during this critical season in my life others were blessed that christ jesus allowed to cross my path during that time of anointed rehabilitation of the body and mind and are being blessed even today to god be all the glory it is my hope that you will be encouraged by this witness and scriptures that god allowed the holy spirit to give me then and now
