mediacity situations practices and encounters investigates how the social settings and spaces of the city are created experienced and practiced through the use and presence of new media it takes the position that new media enables different settings practices and behaviours to occur in urban space contributions from academics practitioners and activists from disciplines such as media studies architecture urban studies cultural and urban geography and sociology present a critical reflection on the processes methods and impacts of technologies in urban space

setting up cultural encounters is a widespread intervention strategy employed to diffuse conflicts and manage difficulties related to diversity these organised cultural encounters bring together people of different backgrounds in order to promote peaceful coexistence and inclusion these transformative aims relate to the participants but are often also expected to spill over into the society community or context addressed by the encounter as a category organised cultural encounters draws together a variety of activities and events such as multicultural festivals dialogue initiatives diversity training and inclusion projects activities that are generally not considered to be of the same kind most of the existing literature on these types of encounters is instrumental and has an overall emphasis on evaluations in terms of outcome or success rate this book goes beyond evaluations and the contributors pose and debate theoretical and methodological questions and analyse the practices and performativities of particular encounters taken together it makes an important contribution to the theorisation and analysis of intercultural relations and negotiations this book was originally published as a special issue of the journal of intercultural studies

this volume collects written and visual works that engage with opportunities of ancient practice from within the continental tradition more than surveying ancient ethical or political ideas the chapters develop divergent yet resonant approaches to concrete ways of living acting reflecting and being with others found in antiquity and its reception the practices involve the habits exercises activities philosophies and lives of today's readers and so most chapters encourage the reader to do something to put the ideas into practice withstanding a temptation to simply theorize practice it insists on the embodied and shared materiality of living in singular times and places the practical encounters between this book and its readers range across antiquity and the contemporary world from political theatre casuistry and slavery to book production friendship and our own mortality through thinker practitioner collaborations occasional pieces exhortations to readers and recipes for action this work strives to articulate and cultivate old and new practices for our lives

the three concepts central to this volume practice learning and change have received very different treatments in the educational literature an oversight directly confronted here while learning and change have been extensively theorised their various contexts articulated and analysed practice is notably underrepresented where much of the literature on learning and change takes the notion of practice as an unexamined given its co location as a term with various classifiers as in legal practice and teaching practice render it curiously devoid of semantic force in this book practice is the super ordinate organising idea drawing on what has been termed the practice turn in contemporary theory the work develops a conceptual framework for researching learning in and on practice it challenges received notions of practice questioning the assumptions elisions conflation and silences on the subject in so doing it offers fresh insights into learning and change and how they relate to practice in tandem with this conceptual work the book details site ontological studies of practice and learning in diverse professional and workplace contexts examining the work of occupations as various as doctors chefs and orchestral musicians it demonstrates the value of theorising practice learning and change as well as exploring the connections between them amid our evolving social and institutional structures

what are the discourses of sexuality underpinning psychoanalysis and how do they impact on clinical practices clinical encounters in sexuality makes an intervention into the fields of clinical psychoanalysis and sexuality studies and stages but for the first time a sustained clinical psychoanalytic engagement with queer theory themes focused on include identity pleasure perversion ethics and discourse this interdisciplinary collection of essays includes thirty two contributors working in queer theory and or clinical psychoanalysis and from a number of different psychoanalytic traditions freudian kleinian lacanian independent jungian and relational this book invites readers to enter into a self reflective engagement with the text and their own views on sexuality paying particular attention to the psychosocial attention underpinnings of sexuality as it exists and can play out in the consulting room page 4 of cover

making sense of new cultural economies it is argued needs consistent attention to the resonances of individual lives otherwise a discussion of cultural economies remains suspended in a detached virtualism miller 2000 the idea of the remaking of geographies and cultural economies remains necessarily a consistent search to make the subject dynamic in its resonance with the contemporary world in recent debates concerning the reframing of the cultural economies of geography there is an evidence of increasing acknowledgement of the overlooked importance of subjectivities within geographical explanation this has often been difficult when trying to attend to the large scale apparent dynamics of change the shift of geographies to focus upon cultural economies combines two profound threads that inform this chapter the acknowledgement of the breadth and inclusivity of what economies are and the refusal mutually to isolate the cultural and the economic thus the economic becomes engaged and even framed in relation to the cultural and vice versa such an appraisal makes more robust the limits of either or claims from these two grounding components of geographical thinking and its representation of the world these themes are sustained in different ways across the chapters of this book this chapter seeks to build a critical discourse concerning space embodied practice and lay knowledge it does this in order to address the mechanisms through which individuals are engaged in the processes of new cultural economies

this book reports changes in gp ordering of imaging tests in australia from 2002 03 to 2011 12 and evaluates alignment between guidelines and recent gp test ordering for selected problems over the decade 9 802 gps participated in beach providing details of 980 200 gp patient encounters the likelihood of gps ordering imaging in the management of a problem increased over time in recent practice at least one imaging test was ordered at 9 of encounters at a rate of 10 imaging tests per 100 encounters diagnostic radiology was the most commonly ordered type of imaging test but the order rate decreased over time with a shift toward orders for ultrasound ct and mri which all significantly increased eight selected problems accounted for one third of all imaging orders imaging ordering behaviour suggests broad compliance with published guidelines in the management of osteoarthritis shoulder problems bursitis tendonitis synovitis abdominal pain and other musculoskeletal injuries current ordering patterns for knee problems and some sprains strains have potential for improvement the ordering pattern for new presentations of back problems was inconsistent with all established guidelines for management of back problems

voices found free jazz and singing contributes to a wave of voice studies scholarship with the first book length study of free jazz voice it pieces together a history of free jazz voice that spans from sound poetry and scat in the 1950s to the more recent wave of free jazz choirs the author traces the developments and offers a theory derived from interviews with many of the most important singers in the history of free jazz voice of how listeners have experienced and evaluated the often unconventional vocal sounds these vocalists employed this theory explains that even audiences willing to enjoy harsh sounds from saxophones or guitars often resist when voices make sounds that audiences understand as not human experimental poetry and scat were combined and transformed in free jazz spaces in the 1960s and 1970s by vocalists like yoko ono in solo work and her work with ornette coleman and john stevens jeanne lee in her solo work and her work with archie shepp and gunter hampel leon thomas in his solo work as well as his work with pharoah sanders and carlos santana and phil minton and maggie nicols who devoted much of their energy to creating unaccompanied free jazz vocal music by studying free jazz voice we can learn important lessons about what we expect from the voice and what happens when those expectations are violated this book doesn't only trace histories of free jazz voice it makes an attempt to understand why this story hasn't been told before with an impressive breadth of scope in terms of the artists covered drawing on research from the us canada wales scotland france the netherlands and japan

there has been a growing awareness in recent years of the importance of play in children s learning and development but that awareness has not been accompanied by sufficient scholarly attention outside of conceptual studies and how to textbooks this collection fills that gap by bringing together scholars from a range of fields and methodological approaches to look at play from a practice based perspective moving beyond the dominant voice of developmental psychology the book offers a number of new ways of approaching children s play and the roles of adults in supporting it as a result it will be valuable to anyone working with or studying children at play

analysis of language and discourse in social sciences has become increasingly popular over the past thirty years only very recently has it been applied to the study of social work despite the fact that communication and language are central to social work practice this book looks at how social workers their clients and other professionals categorise and manage the problems of social work in ways which are rendered understandable accountable and which justify professional intervention features include studies of key practice areas in social work such as interviews case conferences home visits analysis of the language and construction used in typical case studies of everyday social work practice exploration of the ways in which professionals can examine their own practice and uncover the discursive narrative and rhetorical methods that they use the purpose of this engaging study is to increase awareness of language and discourse in order to help develop better practice in social work it is essential reading for professionals in social work child welfare and the human services and will be a valuable contribution to the study of professional language and communication

this book proposes a novel creative research practice in geography based on comics it presents a transdisciplinary approach that uses a set of qualitative visual methods and extends from within the geohumanities across literary spatial studies comics urban studies mobility studies and beyond written by a geographer cartoonist the book focuses on narrative geographies and embraces a geocritical and relational approach to examine comic book geographies in pursuit of a growing interest in creative art based experimental methods in the geohumanities it explores comics based research through interconnections between art and geography and through theoretical and methodological contributions from scholars working in the fields of the social sciences humanities literary geographies mobilities comics literary studies and urban studies as well as from visual artists comics authors and art practitioners comics are valuable objects of geographical interest because of their spatial grammar they are also a language particularly suited to geographical analysis and the geographic novel offers a practice of research that has the power to assemble and disassemble new spatial meanings the book thus explores how the geographic novel as a verbo visual genre allows the study of geographical issues composes geocentred stories engages wider and non specialist audiences promotes geo artistic collaboration and works as a narrative intervention in urban contexts through a practice based approach and the internal perspective of a geographer cartoonist the book provides examples of how geographic fieldwork is conducted and offers analysis of the processes of ideation composition and dissemination of geographic narratives
