john wells introduces the opera with a high spirited account of the action packed career of the author in many respects the prototype of figaro himself basil deane explores the score he shows that mozart s characters are illuminated here not so much in soliloquies but in their reactions to each other composer stephen oliver discusses how the comedy exists not just in the words but essentially in the music the full italian text is given with a note on the order of scenes in act three and the alternative passages mozart wrote for the 1789 revival the classic translation of e j dent is an excellent way to get to know the twists and turns of the plot and the stylish wit of da ponte s innuendos contents a society marriage john wells a musical commentary basil deane music and comedy in the marriage of figaro stephen oliver beaumarchais s characters le nozze di figaro libretto by lorenzo da ponte the marriage of figaro english version by edward j dent

amadeus today mozart s exquisite le nozze di figaro delights and moves audiences everywhere long after its 1786 birth into tumultuous times the original beaumarchais play raised a firestorm in france then on the brink of revolution with its dangerous commentary on class relations however lorenzo da ponte carefully omitted anything political from his opera libretto what remained when joined with mozart s sublime and penetrating music was a witty yet profound tale of infatuation heartache scheming and tenderness where complex emotions are laid bare and everyone regardless of class is equally vulnerable to the powers of love figaro continues the story of the barber of seville several years later in a single day of madness count almagiva s love rosina is now his long suffering countess and the barber figaro now the count s valet is about to marry susanna the countess s maid but the couple to be must first deal with two obstacles a demand that figaro pay his debt to an older woman or marry her instead and the count s determination to bed susanna on her wedding night suspicions fly plots are hatched narrow escapes abound and connivers receive their due love and forgiveness finally bring order to the craziness and a day filled with torment and worry ends in joy

music sexuality and the enlightenment explains how mozart s music for le nozze di figaro don giovanni and così fan tutte sounds the intentions of da ponte s characters and their relationships with one another mozart by way of the infinitely generative and beautiful

logic of the sonata principle did not merely interpret da ponte's characterizations but lent them temporal musical forms charles ford's analytic interpretation of these musical forms concerns processes and structures in detail and at medium to long term levels he addresses the music of a wide range of arias and ensembles and develops original ways to interpret the two largely overlooked operatic genres of secco recitative and finales moreover ford presents a new method by which to relate musical details directly to philosophical concepts and thereby the music of the operas to the inwardly contradictory thinking of the european enlightenment this involves close readings of late eighteenth century understandings of man and nature self and other morality and transgression and gendered identities and sexuality with particular reference to contemporary writers especially goethe kant laclos rousseau sade schiller Sterne and Wollstonecraft the concluding discussion of the implied futures of the operas argues that their divided sexualities which are those of the enlightenment as a whole have come to form our own unquestioned assumptions about gender differences and sexuality this along with the elegant and eloquent precision of Mozart's music is why Figaro Giovanni and Così still maintain their vital immediacy for audiences today

this is a state by state guide to more than 90 opera houses and companies in the united states inaugural performances a history of opera in the city an ordinary season's repertory and performers and directors are highlighted

this collection of essays presented by an internationally known team of scholars explores the world of Vienna and the development of opera buffa in the second half of the eighteenth century although today Mozart remains one of the most well known figures of the period the era was filled with composers librettists writers and performers who created and developed opera buffa among the topics examined are the relationship of Viennese opera buffa to French theatre Mozart and eighteenth century comedy gender nature and bourgeois society on Mozart's buffa stage as well as close analyses of key works such as Don Giovanni and Le Nozze di Figaro

sophisticated and engaging this volume explores and compares musical irony in the works of major composers from Mozart to Mahler

Claudio Monteverdi 1567-1643 was the first important composer of opera this innovative study by one of the foremost experts on Monteverdi and seventeenth century opera examines the composer's celebrated final works *Il Ritorno d'Ulisse* 1640 and *L'incoronazione di Poppea* 1642 from a new perspective Ellen Rosand considers these works as not merely a pair but constituents of a trio a Venetian trilogy that Rosand argues properly includes a third opera *Le Nozze d'Enea* 1641 although its music has not survived its chronological placement between the other two operas opens new prospects for better understanding all three both in their specifically Venetian context and as the creations of an old master a thorough review of manuscript and printed sources of *Ritorno* and *Poppea* in conjunction with those of their erstwhile silent companion offers new possibilities for resolving the questions of authenticity that have swirled around Monteverdi's last operas since their discovery in the late nineteenth century *Le Nozze d'Enea* also helps to explain the striking differences between the other two casting new light on their contrasting moral ethos the conflict between a world of emotional propriety and restraint and one of hedonistic abandon

comprehensive and engaging exploration of mozart s greatest works focussing on his dual roles as performer and composer in vienna

mozart s beloved comic romp reprinted from a late c f peters 1941 edition which preserves mozart s autograph manuscript and early translations of the libretto and includes passages that are often cut in other editions

during the last 30 years technological social economic and environmental changes have brought about the most dramatic evolution to architectural practice that has taken place since the profession emerged during the italian renaissance whilst these changes have transformed the way architects work few contemporary books discuss architectural practice the architecture chronicle sets out to define the role of the contemporary architect in the light of these changes most books on architecture start when a building is complete carefully editing out any evidence of the design and production process the architecture chronicle engages with the design and production process it investigates how and by whom design decisions are made and executed chapter 1 is a diary reporting on the design and realisation of five stage sets and one urban intervention over a period of four years starting on 16 december 2003 the diary is intercepted by references that are where appropriate carefully integrated in the overall narrative chapter 2 reflects on the diary to discover patterns and cross references and to draw conclusions the contemporary architect can be defined as three distinct characters the architect inventor challenges conventions and questions the social status quo the architect activist transgresses the boundary of the profession and enters the construction process the architect arbitrator engages the audience to realise the ambitious project the architecture chronicle concludes that the contemporary architect still draws and writes but that it is often the architect s ability to engage and direct that asserts his or her status to assert his or her status in the design team the architect s ability to talk and to act is more important than his or her ability to draw and write

italian literature before 1900 in english translation provides the most complete record possible of texts from the early periods that have been translated into english and published between 1929 and 2008 it lists works from all genres and subjects and includes translations wherever they have appeared across the globe in this annotated bibliography robin healey covers over 5 200 distinct editions of pre 1900 italian writings

most entries are accompanied by useful notes providing information on authors works translators and how the translations were received among the works by over 1 500 authors represented in this volume are hundreds of editions by italy s most translated authors dante alighieri niccolao machiavelli and giovanni boccaccio and other hundreds which represent the author s only english translation a significant number of entries describe works originally published in latin together with healey s twentieth century italian literature in english translation this volume makes comprehensive information on translations accessible for schools libraries and those interested in comparative literature

a timeless classic includes 8 200 songs in 818 lists for nine voice classifications indexed by composer title vocal range and publisher the complete work represents the living song repertoire of today drawn from recital programs recordings broadcasts telecasts and other sources and is comprised of part i coloratura lyric and dramatic soprano part ii mezzo soprano and contralto part iii lyric and dramatic tenor and part iv baritone and bass

when first published in 1947 a short history of opera immediately achieved international status as a classic in the field now more than five decades later this thoroughly revised and expanded fourth edition informs and entertains opera lovers just as its predecessors have the fourth edition incorporates new scholarship that traces the most important developments in the evolution of musical drama after surveying anticipations of the operatic form in the lyric theater of the greeks medieval dramatic music and other forerunners the book reveals the genre s beginnings in the seventeenth century and follows its progress to the present day a short history of opera examines not only the standard performance repertoire but also works considered important for the genre s development its expanded scope investigates opera from eastern european countries and finland the section on twentieth century opera has been reorganized around national operatic traditions including a chapter devoted solely to opera in the united states which incorporates material on the american musical and ties between classical opera and popular musical theater a separate section on chinese opera is also included with an extensive multilanguage bibliography more than one hundred musical examples and stage illustrations this authoritative one volume survey will be invaluable to students and serious opera buffs new fans will also find it highly accessible and informative extremely thorough in its coverage a short history of opera is now more than ever the book to turn to for anyone who wants to know about the history of this art form

in staging scenes from the operas of mozart a guide for teachers and singers opera director william ferrara offers the perfect resource for the dramatic preparation of opera scenes for directors and student performers topics include study and research rehearsal planning blocking characterization and costuming for four of mozart s most popular operas he surveys basic concepts of opera acting and directing and provides a step by step guide to the rehearsal process while much has appeared on the history and musical performance practice of the operas of mozart no guide to the directing and acting of his operas with simple concise staging instructions and practical information concerning casting props and costumes has yet seen publication featuring over one hundred illustrations including costume designs by martha ferrara the author breaks new ground for student performers and directors alike as he walks readers through the process of staging scenes from mozart s operas the first part of the guide which focuses on study

tells the forgotten story of post rossinian opera buffa with attention to masterpieces by donizetti and fascinating comic works by luigi ricci the young verdi and other composers this study represents the first substantial assessment of italian comic operas composed during the central years of the risorgimento the period during which upheavals revolutions and wars ultimately led to the liberation and unification of italy music historians often view the period as one during which serious romantic opera flourished in italy while opera buffa inexorably declined laughter between two revolutions revises this widespread notion by viewing well known comic masterpieces such as donizetti s l elisir d amore 1832 and don pasquale 1843 as part of a still thriving tradition also examined are opere buffe by luigiricci lauro rossi verdi un giorno di regno and others many of which circulated widely at the time francesco izzo s pathbreaking study argues that in the realm

of seriousness of mid nineteenth century italy comedy was not an anachronistic intruder but a significant and vital cultural presence this important volume offers new insights into opera history and theories of comedy in the arts it will be of interest to opera lovers everywhere and to students in music philosophy comparative literature and italian cultural studies francesco izzo is senior lecturer in music at the university of southampton

demonstrates that the concept of genius is as vitally needed as ever and can illuminate the workings of mozart s creative imagination much recent distinguished mozart criticism has set out a critique of the concept of genius whether following the scientist seeking greater objectivity the postmodernist proclaiming the death of the author the historian concerned about anachronism or the critic who warns about making despotic claims this demystifying literature has taken the weakening of genius s accumulated cultural authority as an indispensable step in arriving at a clarified mozart mozart genius and the possibilities of art advances a contrary claim it proposes that anti romantic accounts of mozart s genius themselves get lost in both the infinitely big in utopianism and millenarianism and the infinitesimally small in materialism and process throughout the book buttresses this argument with probing readings from contemporary documents ranging from ephemeral periodical literature to kant s third critique along with original analyses of the music itself goehring s book goes on to detail a contrasting romantic portrait of mozart s genius one that allowed for ambiguity embraced experience and did not scorn reason in mozart s day the term genius spoke to the unquantifiable and unpredictable in human inventiveness and it continues to do so today goehring shows how the persisting fascination with an ingenious mozart wells up from the middle of things from the particularity of human beings their genie and the visible yet complex world of human intention and action

while kierkegaard is perhaps known best as a religious thinker and philosopher there is an unmistakable literary element in his writings he often explains complex concepts and ideas by using literary figures and motifs that he could assume his readers would have some familiarity with this dimension of his thought has served to make his writings far more popular than those of other philosophers and theologians but at the same time it has made their interpretation more complex kierkegaard readers are generally aware of his interest in figures such as faust or the wandering jew but they rarely have a full appreciation of the vast extent of his use of characters from different literary periods and traditions the present volume is dedicated to the treatment of the variety of literary figures and motifs used by kierkegaard the volume is arranged alphabetically by name with tome i covering figures and motifs from agamemnon to guadalquivir

the oxford handbook of the british musical provides a comprehensive academic survey of british musical theatre offering both a historical account of the musical s development from 1728 and a range of in depth critical analyses of the unique forms and features of british musicals which explore the aesthetic values and sociocultural meanings of a tradition that initially gave rise to the american musical and later challenged its modern pre eminence after a consideration of how john gay s the beggar s opera 1728 created a prototype for eighteenth century ballad opera the book focuses on the use of song in early nineteenth century theatre followed by a sociocultural analysis of the comic operas of gilbert and sullivan it then examines edwardian and interwar musical comedies and revues as well as the impact of rodgers and hammerstein on the west end before analysing the new forms of the postwar british musical from the boy friend 1953 to oliver

1960 one section of the book examines the contributions of key twentieth century figures including noel coward ivor novello tim rice andrew lloyd webber director joan littlewood and producer cameron macintosh while a number of essays discuss both mainstream and alternative musicals of the 1960s and 1970s and the influence of the pop industry on the creation of concept recordings such as jesus christ superstar 1970 and les misérables 1980 there is a consideration of jukebox musicals such as mamma mia 1999 while essays on overtly political shows such as billy elliot 2005 are complemented by those on experimental musicals like jerry springer the opera 2003 and london road 2011 and on the burgeoning of black and asian british musicals in both the west end and subsidized venues the oxford handbook of the british musical demonstrates not only the unique qualities of british musical theatre but also the vitality and variety of british musicals today

edward t cone was one of the most important and influential music critics of the twentieth century he was also a master lecturer skilled at conveying his ideas to broad audiences hearing and knowing music collects fourteen essays that cone gave as talks in his later years and that were left unpublished at his death edited and introduced by robert morgan these essays cover a broad range of topics including music s position in culture musical aesthetics the significance of opera as an art setting text to music the nature of twentieth century harmony and form and the practice of musical analysis fully matching the quality and style of cone s published writings these essays mark a critical addition to his work developing new ideas such as the composer as critic clarifying and modifying older positions especially regarding opera and the nature of sung utterance and adding new and often unexpected insights on composers and ideas previously discussed by cone in addition there are essays such as one on debussy that lead cone into areas he had not previously examined hearing and knowing music represents the final testament of one of our most important writers on music

a study of the prague italian opera company and its role in performing mozart s works in the late eighteenth century

mozart s ghosts traces the many lives of this great composer that emerged following his early death in 1791 crossing national boundaries and traversing two hundred years worth of interpretation and reception author mark everist investigates how mozart s past status can be understood as part of today s veneration everist forges new paths to reach the composer examining a number of ways in which western culture has absorbed the idea of mozart how various cultural agents have appropriated deployed and exploited mozart toward both authoritarian and subversive ends and how the figure of mozart and his impact illuminate the cultural history of the last two centuries in europe england and america modern reverence for the composer is conditioned by earlier responses to his music and everist argues that such earlier responses are more complex than allowed by a simple reception studies model closely linking nine case studies in an innovative cultural and theoretical framework the book approaches the developing reputation of the composer from death to the present day along three paths phantoms of the opera deals with stage music holy spirits addresses the trope of the sacred and specters at the feast considers the impact of mozart s music in literature and film mozart s ghosts adeptly moves the study of mozart reception away from hagiography and closer to cultural and historical criticism and will be avidly read by mozart scholars and students of eighteenth century music history as well as literary critics historians of philosophy and aesthetics and

cultural historians in general

although books have been written about various opera houses throughout the world no one work has covered more than a relatively small number of the larger well known companies and houses and none have made more than brief mention of the smaller houses no book has comprehensively listed opera repertoires little in sum has been written about any of the smaller companies and houses located in non english speaking countries this is the most comprehensive reference book ever written on opera companies and houses in western europe canada australia and new zealand over 300 from the well known to the smaller each entry includes a history of the opera house or company the works title and composer and type of productions offered company staff world and country premieres repertory and practical information on the theater s address nearby hotel accommodations and how to order tickets most entries conclude with a bibliography
