biographic memoirs volume 77 contains the biographies of deceased members of the national academy of sciences and bibliographies of their published works each biographical essay was written by a member of the academy familiar with the professional career of the deceased for historical and bibliographical purposes these volumes are worth returning to time and again

ok2bg is narrative nonfiction a memoir about a guy who wants to be a mentor preferably to a teenager so they can have a decent meaningful conversation about stuff preferably with a kid at risk or just otherwise lost in order to help both the teenager as well as the determined subject of this story realize their unique potential find or reinforce their place in the world overall a chronicle about the author s attempt over several years to understand the question of why do i want to be a mentor which eventually helps him become a more insightful person subsequently in september 2010 after a plague of teen suicides jack turns his attention to researching gay biographies into optimistically appropriate groups of books for gay kids at risk from bullying after 5 years jack has categorized 2 000 books in the form of memoirs biographies autobiographies written by or about 1 000 allegedly gay men the primary message in ok2bg is to read reassess before you run asunder

a fascinating account of a defining year for david bowie bruce springsteen pink floyd elton john the rolling stones the former beatles and others 1973 was the year rock hit its peak while splintering just like the rest of the world ziggy stardust travelled to america in david bowie s aladdin sane the dark side of the moon began its epic run on the billboard charts inspired by the madness of pink floyd s founder while all four former beatles scored top ten albums two hitting 1 fm battled am and motown battled philly on the charts as the era of protest soul gave way to disco while dj kool herc gave birth to hip hop in the bronx the glam rock of the new york dolls and alice cooper split into glam metal and punk hippies and rednecks made peace in austin thanks to willie nelson the allman brothers grateful dead and the band played the largest rock concert to date at watkins glen led zep s houses of the holy reflected the rise of funk and reggae the singer songwriter movement led by bob dylan neil young and joni mitchell flourished at the troubadour and max s kansas city where bruce springsteen and bob marley shared bill elton john s albums dominated the number one spot for two and a half months just as us involvement in vietnam drew to a close roe v wade ignited a new phase in the culture war while the oil crisis imploded the american dream of endless prosperity and watergate s walls closed in on nixon the music of 1973 both reflected a shattered world and brought us together

the stories we read as children are the ones that stay with us the longest and from the nineteenth century until the 1950s stories about schools held a particular fascination many will remember the goings on at such earnest establishments as tom brown s rugby st dominic s greyfriars the chalet school malory towers and linbury court in the second part of the twentieth century with more liberal social attitudes and the advent of secondary education for all these moral tales lost their appeal and the school story very nearly died out more recently however a new generation of compromised schoolboy and schoolgirl heroes pennington tyke tiler harry potter and millie roads have given it a new and challenging relevance focusing mainly on novels written for young people from morality to mayhem charts the fall and rise of the school story from the grim accounts of victorian times to the magic and mayhem of our own age in doing so it considers how fictional schools not only reflect but sometimes influence real life this captivating study will appeal to those interested in children's literature and education both students and the general reader taking us on a not altogether comfortable trip down memory lane

on solid ground illustrates what geologists know about the earth by telling the stories of the people who made major geological discoveries it also chronicles the doubters and nay sayers who have worked so hard to undermine our understanding of the earth each chapter of this book contains three things the human story of a geologic controversy an explanation of why geologists are so sure about the right answer to that controversy and a short discussion of the logical fallacies being used by those still unwilling to accept geologic expertise

oklahoma in the 1980s transformed the movie business worldwide punctuated with photographs and including a filmography of more than one hundred productions filmed in the state shot in oklahoma offers movie lovers and historians alike an engaging ride through untold cinematic history
