evaporates leaving her branding beef un-snazzy un-sexy beef which she hasn't eaten in twenty years talk about false advertising owning a two hundred year old house in a one store hamlet is not the nirvana jill imagined even with the addition of a dog two needy goats and unexpected encounters with the town's most eligible and probably only bachelor peace of mind sold separately wondering how she sold herself on this new existence jill forms an unlikely bond with sarah watson a feisty twelve year old with an aversion to training bras makeup and all the trappings that supposedly make sixth grade worthwhile while sarah teaches jill the basics of home maintenance and animal husbandry jill helps sarah deal with impending womanhood and as men start to complicate matters every idea jill ever had about love and advertising gets turned on its head suddenly her life looks nothing like the picture on the box but it could turn out to be exactly what she didn't know she needed

real women run is an innovative feminist ethnography that consists of a series of linked essays and presentations about women who run at the intersections of queer feminist and running identities faulkner uses feminist grounded theory poetic inquiry and qualitative content analysis to examine women's embodied stories of running how they run how running fits into the context of their lives and relationships how they enact or challenge cultural scripts of women's activities and normative running bodies and what running means for their lives and identities during a two and a half year ethnography with women who run faulkner engaged in an intersectional qualitative content analysis of websites and blogs targeted to women runners a grounded theory poetic analysis of 41 interviews with women who run and participant observation at road races real women run speaks to the call for a more physical feminism this ethnography sees women's physical and mental strength developed through running as a way to embrace the contradictions between a deconstructed focus on the mind/body split and the focus on individuals' actual material bodies and their everyday interactions with their bodies and through their

bodies with the world around them

expansion was the fever of the early nineteenth century and women burned with it as surely as men although in a different way subscribing to the cult of true womanhood which valued domesticity piety and similar feminine virtues women championed expansion for the cause of civilization even while largely avoiding the masculine world of politics adrienne caughtfield mines the diaries and letters of some ninety texas women to uncover the ideas and enthusiasms they brought to the western frontier although there were a few notable exceptions most of them drew on their domestic skills and values to establish not only civilization but their own security caughtfield sheds light on women s activism the flip side of domesticity attitudes toward race and civilization the tie between a vision of a unified continent and a cultivated wilderness and republican values she offers a new understanding of not only gender roles in the west but also the impulse for expansionism itself in texas caughtfield demonstrates women never stopped arriving with more fuel for the flames of expansionism as their families tried to find a place to settle down some place with a little more room where national destiny and personal dreams merged into a glorious whole in doing so texas women expanded not only american borders but their own as well

reinvigorates discussion concerning the dynamics of film narrative and spectacle each contribution takes as its focus a central character from the hollywood blockbuster era examining in detail the motivations and implications of the fighting female in doing so the collection raises significant questions about the place of the fighting woman in contemporary media and the relationships she forges on and off screen with a strong appreciation of the mixed messages inherent in images of fighting women women willing to fight seeks to draw attention to the embodied forms physical intellectual and emotional through which female fighters are represented the anthology places particular emphasis on the emergence of the physically empowered woman a character for whom the body has become a weapon and a target while early cinematic representations allowed women to voice their fury and frustration today s female fighters not only speak up but muscle up putting aside the supernatural powers of many action heroines this volume focuses on the kinds of fighting skills abilities and desires that are engendered in characterisations of mortal women to this end the volume implicitly addresses complex and cross cultural notions of extra ordinary power by examining the embodied arsenal that these characters possess and develop through training conditioning and life experience it considers the representation of motivation and metamorphoses into the fighting woman how a woman fights holds implicit meaning and inevitably urges us to consider why and what she is fighting for

american feminism has always been about more than the struggle for individual rights and equal treatment under the law in this book the author retrieves an alternative tradition of women s reform that sought answers to questions increasingly pressing today how to balance work and family and how to address growing economic inequalities this book trace s the history of american social justice feminism from the 1930s into the present and to link that continuous tradition with the leadership of labor women back cover

pursuers and functioning feminists who broadly occupy positions across the pre and post thatcher eras and the changes brought about by the feminist movement as one of the first book length empirical studies to explore age related femininities in the context of what sexiness means today the authors develop a series of insights into various technologies of the self through analyses of space nostalgia and claims to authentic sexiness

traces the connection between slavery and the way in which black women fiction writers depict female characters and address gender issues particularly maternity

rituals have always been a focus of ethnographies of melanesia providing a ground for important theorizing in anthropology this is especially true of the male initiation rituals that until recently were held in papua new guinea for the most part these rituals have been understood as all male institutions intended to maintain and legitimate male domination women s exclusion from the forest space where men conducted most such rites has been taken as a sign of their exclusion from the entire ritual process women as unseen characters is the first book to examine the role of females in papua new guinea male rituals and the first systematic treatment of this issue for any part of the world in this volume leading melanesian scholars build on recent ethnographies that show how female kin had roles in male rituals that had previously gone unseen female seclusion and the enforcement of taboos were crucial elements of the ritual process forms of presence in their own right contributors here provide detailed accounts of the different kinds of female presence in various papua new guinea male rituals when these are restored to the picture the rituals can no longer be interpreted merely as an institution for reproducing male domination but must also be understood as a moment when the whole system of relations binding a male person to his kin is reorganized by dealing with the participation of women a totally neglected dimension of male rituals is added to our understanding

the second edition of women and crime is a carefully revised version of what has become the standard text on this subject it provides a comprehensive review of findings about female criminality women and criminal justice and the treatment of female offenders it also offers a clear analysis of theoretical perspectives of images of deviant women and women s experiences of social control a new section reviews developments during the past decade and outlines the shifts in social research and crime concerns the bibliography has been thoroughly revised and updated

heated debates about and insurgencies against female circumcision are symptoms of a disease emanating from a mindset that produced hierarchies of humans conquered colonies and built empires the loss of colonies and empires does not in any way mitigate the ideological underpinnings of empire building and the knowledge construction that subtends it the mindset finds its articulation at points of coalescence female circumcision provided a point of coalescence and impetus for this articulation insisting that the hierarchy on which the imperialist project rests is not bipolar but multi layered and more complex the contributions in this volume demonstrate how imperialist discourses complicate issues of gender race and history nnaemeka gives voice to the silenced and marginalized and creates space for them to participate in knowledge construction and

this book studies the representations of working class women in canonical and popular american fiction between 1820 and 1870 these representations have been invisible in nineteenth century american literary and cultural studies due to the general view that antebellum writers did not engage with their society's economic and social realities against this view and to highlight the cultural importance of working class women this study argues that in responding to industrialization middle class writers such as melville hawthorne fern davies and phelps used the figures of the factory worker and the seamstress to express their anxieties about unstable gender and class identities these fictional representations were influenced by and contributed to an important but understudied cultural debate about wage labor working women and class
