identifying illuminating and enhancing understanding of key aspects of women and girls faith lives the faith lives of women and girls represents a significant body of original qualitative research from practitioners and researchers across the uk contributors include new and upcoming researchers as well as more established feminist practical theologians chapters provide perspectives on different ages and stages of faith across the life cycle from a range of different cultural and religious contexts diverse spiritual practices beliefs and attachments are explored including a variety of experiences of liminality in women s faith lives a range of approaches ethnographic oral history action research interview studies case studies and documentary analysis combine to offer a deeper understanding of women s and girls faith lives as well as being of interest to researchers this book presents resources to enhance ministry to and with women and girls in a variety of settings

growing up in a family with six daughters the gardiner sisters know a thing or two about sisterhood as musicians and creators they have come to know that we as women share a common divine identity and face similar challenges in this book they invite all women to join them in their journey to increase our capacity to love navigate life s challenges together and draw closer to god

the laurence and lynne brown democracy medal presented by the mccourtney institute for democracy at penn state recognizes outstanding individuals groups and organizations that produce innovations to further democracy in the united states or around the world nasrin sotoudeh is an iranian lawyer and human rights activist who has been called iran s nelson mandela sotoudeh is a longtime opponent of the death penalty advocate of improving imprisonment health conditions and an activist dedicated to fighting for the rights of women children religious and ethnic minorities journalists and artists and those facing execution as a result of her advocacy sotoudeh has been repeatedly imprisoned by the iranian government for crimes against the state she served one sentence from 2010 to 2013 and was sentenced again in 2018 to thirty eight years and six months in prison and 148 lashes her work has been featured in the 2020 documentary nasrin by filmmakers jeff kaufman and marcia s ross for this important work she is the recipient of the 2023 brown democracy medal from the mccourtney institute for democracy marking the award s tenth year

juxtaposing life writing and romance this study offers the first book length exploration of the dynamic and complex relationship between the two genres in so doing it operates at the intersection of several recent trends interest in women s contributions to autobiography greater awareness of the diversity and flexibility of auto biographical forms in the early modern period and the use of manuscripts and other material evidence to trace literacy practices through analysis of a wide variety of life writings by early modern englishwomen including elizabeth delaval dorothy calthorpe ann fanshawe and anne halkett julie a eckerle demonstrates that these women were not only familiar with the controversial romance genre but also deeply influenced by it romance she argues with its unending tales of unsatisfying love spoke to something in women s experience offered a model by which they could recount their own disappointments in a world where arranged marriage and often loveless matches ruled the day and exerted a powerful pervasive pressure on their textual self formations romancing the self in early modern englishwomen s life writing documents a vibrant secular form of auto biographical writing that coexisted alongside numerous spiritual forms providing a much more nuanced and complete understanding of sixteenth and seventeenth century women s reading and writing literacies

this book analyzes the impact of abusive regimes of power on women s lives and on their self expression through close readings of life writing by women in communist romania in particular it examines the forms of agency and privacy available to women under totalitarianism and the modes of relationships in which their lives were embedded the self expression and self reflexive processes that are to be found in the body of romanian women s autobiographical writings this study presents create complex private narratives that underpin the creative development of inclusive memories of the past through shared responsibility and shared agency at the same time however the way these private personal narratives intertwined with collective and official historical narratives exemplifies the multidimensional nature of privacy as well as the radical redefinition of agency in this period this book argues for a broader understanding of the narratives of the communist past one that reflects the complexity of individual and social interactions and allows a deep exploration of the interconnected relations between memory trauma nostalgia agency and privacy

social changes including an increase in dual earner families declining fertility and growing problems of work life balance are underway as more women particularly mothers enter and remain in paid employment the authors explore this in a number of european countries britain france the netherlands finland norway sweden and portugal

women s life writing and early modern ireland provides an original perspective on both new and familiar texts in this first critical collection to focus on seventeenth century women s life writing in a specifically irish context by shifting the focus away from england even though many of these writers would have identified themselves as english and making ireland and irishness the focus of their essays the contributors resituate women s narratives in a powerful and revealing landscape this volume addresses a range of genres from letters to book marginalia and a number of different women from now canonical life writers such as mary rich and ann fanshawe to far less familiar figures such as eliza blennerhassett and the correspondents and supplicants of william king archbishop of dublin the writings of the boyle sisters and the duchess of ormonde women from the two most important families in seventeenth century ireland also receive a thorough analysis these innovative and nuanced scholarly considerations of the powerful influence of ireland on these writers construction of self provide fresh illuminating insights into both their writing and their broader cultural context

the lives of migrant muslim women in divided post conflict northern ireland both before and after the pandemic are full of diverse stories and experiences of belonging this book explores how women strive to belong and create a home despite pervasive hatred sexism and racism under these circumstances women employ various strategies to connect with people and places around them using personal stories this book considers the relationships migrant muslim women develop the places they spend time and the activities they engage with these stories are used to demonstrate the interconnectedness of gender visibility movement and placemaking as analytical concepts

hiv treatment as prevention primer for behavior based implementation provides the first practical guide to integrating behavioral prevention with antiretroviral therapies for people living with hiv infection this brief book discusses the historical and social context embedding the shifting landscape in hiv prevention where the use of effective treatments have become the focus of hiv prevention while using treatments for prevention is promising the history of hiv prevention offers several important pitfalls that must be avoided if hiv treatments are to ultimately succeed in preventing new hiv infections lessons learned from the successes and failures of other biomedical technologies used in hiv prevention specifically syringes condoms and hiv testing are critical to the success of using hiv treatments for prevention hiv treatment as prevention primer for behavior based implementation summarizes the scientific evidence for advancing the use of antiretroviral therapies for hiv prevention the evidence makes clear that hiv treatments can prevent hiv transmission but will fail if behavioral aspects of treatment and hiv transmission are ignored of greatest concern are medication adherence and risks for contracting other sexually transmitted infections placing hiv treatment within the context of behavioral interventions for maintaining medication adherence and reducing sexual risk behaviors is therefore essential to the future of hiv prevention hiv treatment as prevention primer for behavior based implementation highlights two pioneering behavioral interventions aimed at maximizing the effects of antiretroviral therapies for preventing hiv transmission one of the interventions developed by the author's research team is discussed in detail and the intervention manual is included as an appendix

as the first comprehensive volume devoted entirely to women of both the spanish and austrian habsburg royal dynasties spanning the sixteenth and the seventeenth centuries this interdisciplinary collection illuminates their complex and often contradictory political functions and their interrelations across early modern national borders the essays in this volume investigate the lives of six habsburg women who as queens consort and queen regent duchesses a vicereine and a nun left an indelible mark on the diplomatic and cultural map of early modern europe contributors examine the national and transnational impact of these notable women through their biographies and explore how they transferred their cultural religious and political traditions as the women moved from one court to another early modern habsburg women investigates the complex lives of philip ii s daughter the infanta catalina micaela 1567 1597 her daughter margherita of savoy vicereine of portugal 1589 1655 and maria maddalena of austria grand duchess of florence 1589 1631 the second generation of habsburg women that the volume addresses includes philip iv s first wife isabel of borbón 1602 1644 who became a habsburg by marriage rudolph ii s daughter sor ana dorotea 1611 1694 the only habsburg nun in the collection and philip iv s second wife mariana of austria 1634 1696 queen regent and mother to the last spanish habsburg through archival documents pictorial and historical accounts literature and correspondence as well as cultural artifacts such as paintings jewelry and garments this volume brings to light the impact of habsburg women in the broader historical political and cultural contexts the essays fill a scholarly need by covering various phases of the lives of early modern royal women who often struggled to sustain their family loyalty while at the service of a foreign court even when protecting and preparing their heirs for rule at that same court

the denial of equal educational opportunities to women is arguably one of the great injustices in british history in willingly to school mary cathcart borer charts the gradual reversal of this inequality and the revolutionary effect it has had on social structures from the anglo saxons to the twentieth century always mindful of the historical context of each period borer explores the significant early role of the church the opportunities afforded to royal and noble girls the origins of the various forms of privately and charitably funded school and the emergence of the modern school system along the way particular significant institutions and individuals such as christ's hospital cheltenham ladies college the bronte sisters and fanny burney are examined in depth writing in 1975 borer described the mid twentieth century as having seen the culmination of women's demands for full equality in society while the intervening years have shown that there is still much work to be done in the pursuit of equality borer's analysis of the progress that has been made in women's education remains as pertinent as ever
