a growing body of evidence demonstrates that improvements in the status of women and girls however worthy and important in their own right also drive the prosperity stability and security of families communities and nations yet despite many indicators of progress women and girls everywhere including countries of the developed world continue to confront barriers to their full and equal participation in social economic and political life capturing voices and experiences from around the world this work documents the modern history of the global women s movement its many accomplishments and setbacks drawing together prominent pioneers and contemporary policymakers activists and scholars the volume interrogates where and why progress has met resistance and been slowed and examine the still unfinished agenda for change in national and international policy arenas this history and roadmap are especially critical for younger generations who need a better understanding of this rich feminist legacy and the intense opposition that women s movements have generated this book creates a clear and forceful narrative about women s agency and the central relevance of women s rights movements to global and national policy making it is essential reading for activists and policymakers students and scholars alike

producing women examines the ways femininity is produced through new media michele white considers how women are constructed produce themselves as subjects form vital production cultures on sites like etsy and deploy technological processes to reshape their identities and digital characteristics she studies the means through which women market traditional female roles are viewed and produce and restructure their gendered raced eroticized and sexual identities incorporating a range of examples across numerous forms of media including trash the dress wedding photography internet how to instructions about zombie walk brides nail polish blogging diy crafting and reborn doll production producing women elucidates women s production cultures online and the ways that individuals can critically study and engage with these practices

provides a timely review of gender equality in the boardroom and through interviews with mentors and mentees it illustrates how mentoring can play a part in helping women stay engaged in their career this book includes international comparisons and an examination of the uk and eu political environments

written by leading scholars from a wide range of countries this book advances the understanding of women s entrepreneurship by drawing attention to the contexts in which they operate with its impact on gendered institutions and gendered social forces it will be of interest for researchers faculty and students as well as policy makers and practitioners it is the fifth in the series of books produced in partnership with the diana international research network

while some have argued that we live in a postfeminist era that renders feminism irrelevant to people s contemporary lives this book takes feminism the source of eternal debate contestation and ambivalence and situates the term within the popular cultural practices of everyday life it explores the intimate connections between the politics of feminism and the representational practices of contemporary popular culture examining how feminism is made sensible through visual imagery and popular culture representations it investigates how popular culture is produced represented and consumed to reproduce the conditions in which feminism is valued or dismissed and asks whether antifeminism exists in commodity form and is commercially viable written in an accessible style and analysing a broad range of popular culture artefacts including commercial advertising printed and digital news related journalism and commentary music film television programming websites and social media this book will be of use to students researchers and practitioners of international relations international political economy and gender cultural and media studies

this book traces the evolution of organisational activism among muslim women in india it deconstructs the muslim woman as the monolith based on tropes like purdah polygamy and tin talaq and compels the reader to revisit the question of muslim women s individual and collective agency the book argues that the political field along with religion moulds the nature and scope of muslim women s activism in india it looks at the objectives of four muslim women s organisations the bazm e niswan the awaaz e niswaan the bharatiya muslim mahila andolan and the india international women s alliance iiwa in close interaction with the political landscape of muslim women s rights by muslim

women activists and challenges the dominant and reductionist stereotypes on muslim women community and absolutist ideas of islam it argues that muslim women are not passive victims of their culture and religion rather they can develop a critique of their marginality and subjugation from within the community revisiting muslim women s activism traces the evolution of a community centric approach in women s activism and records a fragmented view on women s rights from within the community and religious leadership it also delineates the distinctiveness of this activism that considers religion and culture as resources for empowerment and as sites of contestations moreover the book documents the narratives of muslim women s struggle and resistance from their location and lived experiences it will be of interest to students and researchers of women s studies gender studies political science sociology anthropology law and islamic studies

the gender gap in science technology engineering and mathematics stem varies greatly from country to country and the number of japanese women in these fields remains relatively few this prompts us to ask why the proportion of female scientists in japan is still remarkably low and what measures the government universities and research institutes are taking to address this issue this book sheds light on historical developments and the current gender equality situation in japan through the lens of women in stem it shows how a policy of gender equality in science and engineering has been introduced through the coordinated efforts of academia scientific societies and the government and how this has led to a slow but steady increase in female representation the book draws on extensive data including interviews with government officials scientists and educators in japan to provide a revealing case study on how the underrepresentation of women in the fields of science technology and engineering has been approached and dealt with by a national government it heralds a new era for female scientists by showcasing several programmes undertaken by government universities and national research institutions to support multiple career paths for and the progression of female scientists in japan tracing the historical development of japan s policies towards women in science and education this book will be welcomed by students and scholars interested in japanese studies comparative social policy gender studies employment and the history of science and technology

a number of women s issues serve to create novel policy problems that require creative and sometimes unique regulatory and legal responses this book embarks upon a comparative case study approach to explore uk policymaking in the areas of abortion rape prostitution and pornography in turn each chapter engages a different institutional perspective to explore the influence of a range of bodies such as the legal system medical profession civil society police force and mass media the analysis reveals a common thread that runs throughout decision making in these areas a constant balancing act between regulation that purports to protect women and regulation that supposedly reflects female liberation with a continual dance between the labels of criminal and victim being performed by policy actors largely reflective of a dogmatic approach to the status of women it is argued that different institutions retain strongholds over policymaking in these domains prohibiting a joined up approach this has served to perpetuate harmful and negative stereotyping of women s issues and create countless conundrums when the activities of women fall into more than one policy category

this book examines how women journalists in malaysia negotiated male power structures in particular structures determined by the keystone party of the ruling coalition the united malays national organisation through both oral histories and content analysis it looks at how women journalists in the women s pages of the newspapers found spaces to advocate for their readers it is thus the first work to look at the importance of the women s pages in the malay language newspapers and how apparently monolithic institutions of the authoritarian state hid diverse contests for resources and prestige in this contest the concept of news values the perception of the reader and the ways in which women constructed themselves as journalists all come into play and are examined here the book contributes to the field of feminist media studies by examining how gendered newsroom practices paradoxically allowed women journalists in the women s pages more editorial freedom than those in the malestream press

having been spared the constraints imposed on intellectual discourse by the totalitarian regime of the past young ukrainian scholars now engage with many western ideological theories and practices in an atmosphere of intellectual freedom and uncensored scholarship displacing the soviet legacy of prescribed thought and practices this volume s female contributors have infused their work with western elements although vestiges of soviet style ideas research methodology and writing linger the result is the articulation of a new imaginaries neither soviet nor western that offers a unique approach to the study of gender by presenting a portrait of ukrainian society as seen through the eyes of a new generation of feminist scholars

drawing on family materials historical records and eyewitness accounts this book shows the impact of war on individual women caught up in diverse and often treacherous situations it relates stories of partisans in holland an italian woman carrying guns and provisions in the face of hostile soldiers and kikuyu women involved in the mau mau insurrection in kenya a woman displaced from silesia recalls fleeing with children across war torn germany and women caught up in conflicts in burma and in rwanda share their tales war s aftermath can be traumatic as shown by journalists in libya and by a midwife on the cambodian border who helps refugees to give birth and regain hope finally british women on active service in afghanistan and at nato headquarters also speak

the contributors to this book examine the conceptual issues relating to the link between conflict and poverty as well as presenting case studies of countries often regarded as hot spots for conflict in africa they also explore the roles of regional and sub regional bodies and institutions in addressing the causes of poverty and mitigating the impacts of conflict on vulnerable and marginalized groups africa is often regarded as the epicentre of conflicts worldwide virtually every part of the continent is currently engulfed in one form of conflict or another beyond the loss of life conflicts have brought untold hardship to millions and have derailed social and economic development on the continent written by african academics this book is divided into three sections the first of which discusses the factors that fuel conflicts and the nature and impacts of conflicts on vulnerable groups the second section comprises case studies of south sudan central african republic nigeria ethiopia south africa uganda and cameroon these countries are representative of the sub regional dynamics of africa west east central and south reflecting the diversity of the continent the final section examines the role of key institutions and bodies in africa in mitigating the impact of conflict on the socioeconomic lives of the people in the region bodies discussed include the african union economic community of west african states southern african development community and the east african community the book will be an invaluable resource for researchers academics and policymakers working in the areas of law political science human rights peace studies development studies and african studies

the end of formal hostilities in any given conflict provides an opportunity to transform society in order to secure a stable peace this

book builds on the existing feminist international relations literature as well as lessons of past cases that reinforce the importance of including women in the post conflict transition process and are important to our general understanding of gender relations in the conflict and post conflict periods post conflict transformation processes including disarmament demobilization and reintegration ddr programs transitional justice mechanisms reconciliation measures and legal and political reforms which emerge after the formal hostilities end demonstrate that war and peace impact and are impacted by women and men differently by drawing on a strong theoretical framework and a number of cases this volume provides important insight into questions pertaining to the end of conflict and the challenges inherent in the post conflict transition period that are relevant to students and practitioners alike

the last ten years have seen a shift in television storytelling toward increasingly complex storylines and characters in this study hagelin and silverman zoom in on a key figure in this transformation the archetype of the female antihero across genres these female protagonists eschew the part of good girl or role model in their rejection of social responsibility

this book provides a unique investigation into the gender dynamics of the arab spring as it unfolded in north africa it covers issues such as gender legislation in the post revolution period sexual harassment gender activism politics and the female body women and islamist movements state feminism women and political economy and women s rights in the context of political transitions chapters on morocco tunisia algeria libya and egypt are written by specialist and activists from those countries it includes a rare first hand insight into the gender debates human rights violations and politics of post qaddafi libya written by a libyan scholar directly engaged in these developments an analysis of post mubarak gender debates in egypt is detailed by a gender activist and scholar currently engaged in these debates in favour of gender equitable legislation and human rights in egypt two former ministers of women s affairs from tunisia and algeria who are also prolific scholars provide analysis on the situation of women s rights in the context of islamism and freedom of artistic expression in tunisia and algeria in addition to these first hand accounts written by north african political and civil society actors the book provides a comprehensive theoretical background that allows for readers to understand the historical and deeper cultural contexts of gender struggles the foreword frames the larger debate about gender equality and democratisation in the north africa middle eat region and clearly presents the lines of investigation of the chapters each chapter contains a clear framing of the subject that will orient educate and intelligently inform the general reader about the history current developments and stakes of women s struggles that have intensified and shifted since the beginning of the arab spring this book was published as a special issue of the journal of north african studies

the government s progressive work on tackling violence against women and girls abroad is not translating into its domestic policy despite its violence against women and girls action strategy and the home secretary s personal commitment to the issue the committee warns that failure to provide adequate refuge spaces and specialist services for victims of violence against women and girls demonstrates the difficulty for the government in fulfilling its international obligations under the convention when decisions over commissioning of certain services has been devolved the committee also expresses alarm at the prevalence of violence against women and girls across many cultures in the uk today and heard troubling evidence from many minority groups that represent women with particular needs the portrayal of women are treated in the asylum system this has to stop the committee s recommendations include that schools should play a greater role and include issues of violence against women and girls within the pshe curriculum whilst the government has taken steps to engage with the media and with public awareness campaigns to counteract the sexualised portrayal of women noting that the bbc declined invitations to give evidence to this inquiry the media themselves should do more the government look again at the payment of universal credit to couples because of its concerns that it could put women subject to domestic violence at risk

since the 1960s and 1970s century the women s movements and women s studies have been beginning to rise throughout the world in the past several decades the status of women has been greatly improved all the writings contain valuable insights highlighting the idea of feminism and trace the different forms it has taken in the countries under consideration the book specially has the concerns on various aspects of feminism and queries of paradigm shift in women studies the comprehensive coverage of the activities of women in numerous sectors and also hints at feminization of labour as well as household activities conflict zones and environment in our society a book to further reading in the light of the documents consulted and used in the chapters which may be a foundation for any serious researcher on women in the development process
