What are some examples of vertical lines in nature? Tall trees, mountain ranges, and waterfalls are some examples of natural formations that visually approximate vertical lines. 5. How does the concept of a vertical line differ in different coordinate systems? While the fundamental concept remains the same (perpendicular to a horizontal line), the way it's represented mathematically changes. In Cartesian coordinates, it's  $x = \text{constant}$ , while in polar coordinates, it's  $\theta = \text{constant}$ . The "vertical" direction itself might also change based on the orientation of the coordinate system.
